1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the KoolMore Microwave Oven. This appliance is designed for efficient and convenient cooking, reheating, and defrosting of various food items. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your new microwave oven to ensure safe and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should be followed, including the following:

- **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of burns, electric shock, fire, exposure to excessive microwave energy, or injury to persons:
 - Read all instructions before using the appliance.
 - Read and follow the specific "PRECAUTIONS TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO EXCESSIVE MICROWAVE ENERGY" found on page 3 (*hypothetical page number*).
 - This appliance must be grounded. Connect only to properly grounded outlets. See "GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS" on page 4 (*hypothetical page number*).
 - Install or locate this appliance only in accordance with the provided installation instructions.
 - Do not heat liquids or other foods in sealed containers since they are liable to explode.
 - Do not operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been damaged or dropped.
 - Do not cover or block any openings on the appliance.
 - Do not store this appliance outdoors. Do not use this product near water – for example, near a kitchen sink, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool, or similar locations.
 - Do not immerse cord or plug in water.
 - Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
 - Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- Use this appliance only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in

this appliance.

- As with any appliance, close supervision is necessary when used by children.
- Do not operate this appliance without food in the cavity.
- This appliance should be serviced only by qualified service personnel. Contact the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the microwave oven from its packaging. Retain the packaging materials for future transport or storage. Check for any damage during transit. If the appliance appears damaged, do not operate it and contact customer support immediately.

3.2 Placement

Place the microwave oven on a flat, stable surface that can support its weight and the heaviest food item likely to be cooked in it. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Maintain a minimum clearance of 4 inches (10 cm) from the top, sides, and rear of the oven to allow for proper airflow.

3.3 Electrical Connection

Ensure the electrical outlet matches the voltage and frequency requirements specified on the appliance's rating label. Plug the microwave oven into a dedicated, grounded 3-prong outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel features a digital display, various function buttons, and a dial for setting time and power levels. Familiarize yourself with the layout before operation.

4.2 Basic Operation

1. Place food in a microwave-safe container inside the oven.
2. Close the oven door securely.
3. **Setting Cook Time:** Use the time dial or number pad to enter the desired cooking duration.
4. **Setting Power Level:** Press the "Power Level" button repeatedly to cycle through different power settings (e.g., P100 for full power, P80 for 80% power, etc.).
5. Press "Start" to begin cooking.

4.3 Auto Cook Menus

The microwave oven comes with pre-programmed auto cook menus for common food items. To use:

- Press the "Auto Cook" button.

- Select the desired food category (e.g., Popcorn, Potato, Pizza) using the dial or specific menu buttons.
- Enter the quantity or weight if prompted.
- Press "Start".

4.4 Reheat Function

The Reheat function is designed to warm up leftovers efficiently.

- Place food in a microwave-safe dish.
- Press the "Reheat" button.
- Select the appropriate reheat setting or enter the weight.
- Press "Start".

4.5 Weight Defrost

This feature allows you to defrost food based on its weight.

- Place frozen food in the oven.
- Press the "Weight Defrost" button.
- Enter the weight of the food using the dial or number pad.
- Press "Start". The oven will automatically calculate the defrosting time.

4.6 Oven Lamp and Recirculation Vent Hood Function

The oven is equipped with an internal lamp for visibility and a recirculation vent hood function to help manage cooking odors and steam.

- **Oven Lamp:** The lamp illuminates automatically when the door is opened or during operation.
- **Recirculation Vent Hood:** This function activates automatically or can be manually turned on/off via a dedicated button (if available on your model) to filter and recirculate air within your kitchen space. Refer to the control panel for specific button functionality.

5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Oven Interior

Regularly clean the oven cavity, door seals, and turntable. Use a mild detergent and a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and heat for a few minutes to loosen residue.

5.2 Cleaning the Exterior

Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid spraying cleaners directly onto the control panel.

5.3 Turntable Care

The glass turntable and roller ring can be removed for cleaning. Wash them in warm, soapy water or in the dishwasher. Ensure they are completely dry before placing them back in the oven.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your microwave oven, please consult the following table before contacting customer service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	Door not closed properly; Plug not inserted firmly; Fuse blown or circuit breaker tripped.	Close door completely; Ensure plug is firmly in outlet; Check household fuse/circuit breaker.
Food not cooking evenly	Food not stirred or turned; Incorrect power level or cooking time.	Stir or turn food halfway through cooking; Adjust power level and time as needed.
Light not working	Bulb needs replacement.	Contact qualified service personnel for bulb replacement.
Excessive steam from door	Normal during cooking, especially high-moisture foods.	This is normal and not a fault. Ensure proper ventilation.
