3. KEY FEATURES

The SYNCO XTALK XPRO5 system incorporates several advanced features for enhanced communication:

- **Expanded Communication Range:** Reliable 500m (1640ft) connection range with 2 high-gain external antennas.
- **Advanced Noise Cancellation:** 2.0 AEC technology eliminates echoes and ambient noise for clear voice recognition (150Hz to 7KHz).
- **Boost Mode:** Enhances signal strength for stable communication.
- **MasterFree Algorithm:** Allows any headset to function as the master unit, supporting group chats for 2–13 people.
- **All-Day Battery:** Over 24 hours of use with rechargeable and replaceable batteries.
- **Real-Time Monitoring:** 3.5mm monitoring jack for simultaneous communication and device audio monitoring.
- **Lightweight Comfort:** Crafted from ABS and leather for extended wear.
- **Easy Pairing:** SYNCO EasyGo software for one-click pairing and OTA firmware updates.

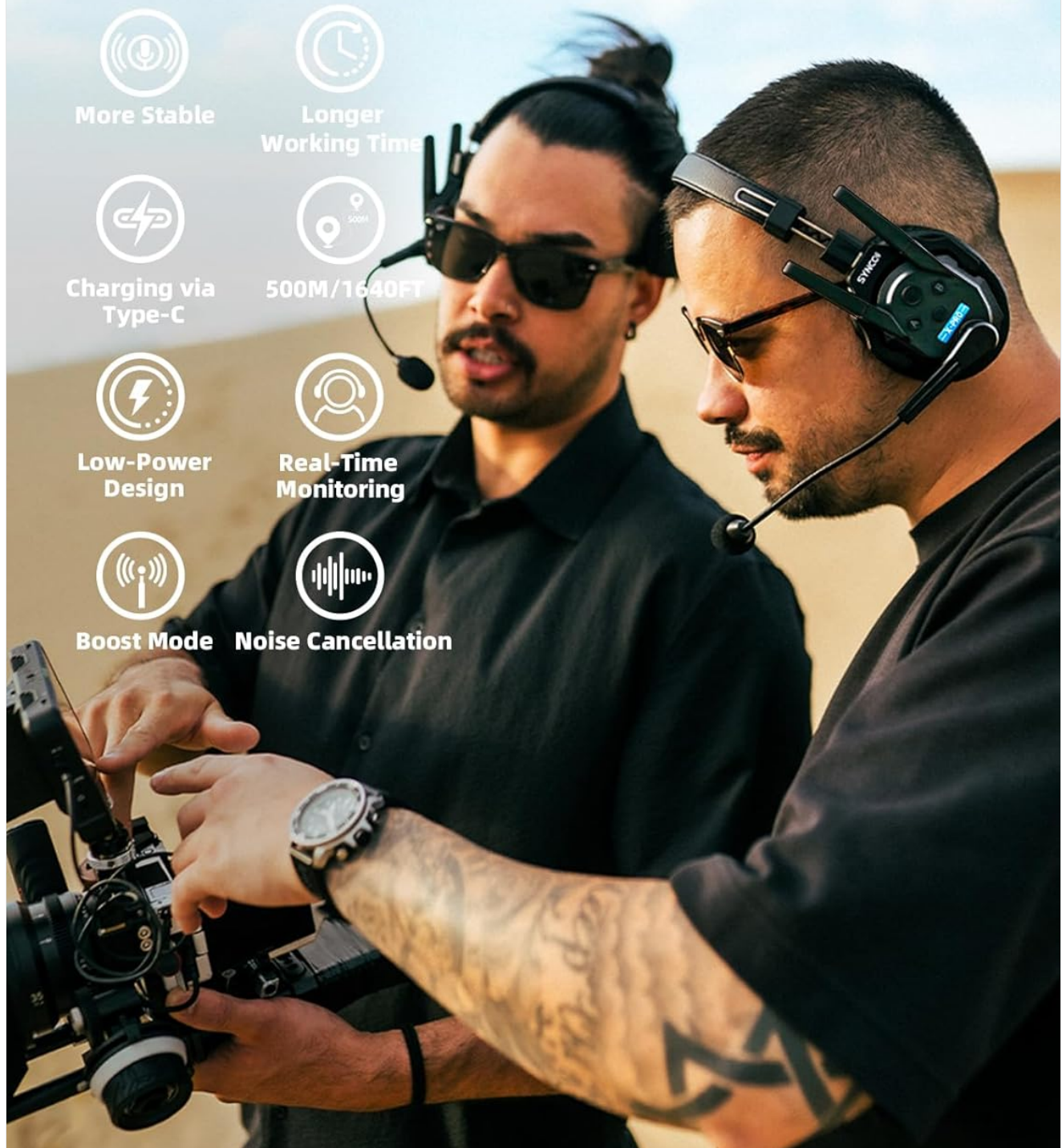

4. SETUP

4.1. Charging the Batteries

1. Insert the rechargeable batteries into the provided 2-slot charging station.
2. Connect the charging station to a power source using the supplied USB-C cable.
3. The indicator lights on the charging station will show the charging status. Ensure batteries are fully charged before first use.

4.2. Headset Assembly

1. Attach the mic windshield to the microphone boom for reduced plosives and wind noise.
2. If desired, replace the existing ear cushions with the one-ear foam cushions for alternative comfort.
3. Insert a charged battery into the designated battery compartment on the headset.

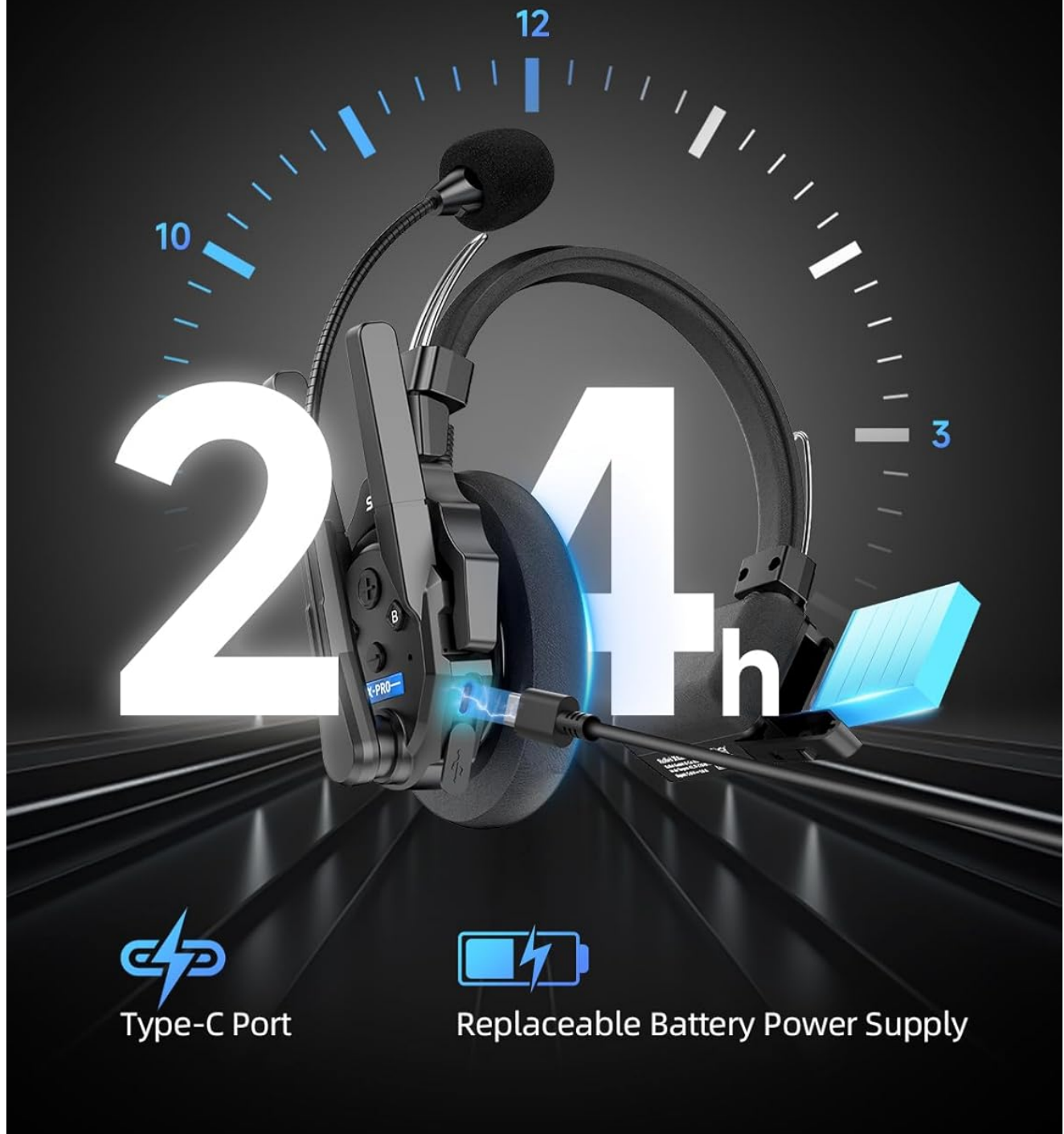

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Powering On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the power button until the indicator light illuminates.
- To power off, press and hold the power button until the indicator light turns off.

5.2. Pairing Headsets

The SYNCO EasyGo software facilitates one-click pairing. Refer to the software's instructions for detailed pairing procedures. Ensure all headsets are within range during the pairing process.

5.3. Volume Adjustment

Use the volume up (+) and volume down (-) buttons located on the headset to adjust the listening volume.

5.4. Noise Cancellation

Activate the noise reduction feature with a single click of the dedicated noise cancellation button for clearer communication in noisy environments.

5.5. Boost Mode

Engage Boost Mode to enhance signal strength, particularly useful in areas with potential signal interference or at the edge of the communication range.

5.6. Master Selection (MasterFree Algorithm)

The MasterFree Algorithm allows any headset in the system to function as the master unit. This provides flexibility in group configurations (2-13 people) and ensures continuous operation even if a designated master unit is removed or loses power.

5.7. Real-Time Monitoring

Connect an external audio device (e.g., headphones) to the 3.5mm monitoring jack to simultaneously monitor communication audio and device audio. This is beneficial for directors or field controllers.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning

- Wipe the headset and charging station with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Ensure no moisture enters the ports or battery compartments.

6.2. Battery Care

- Store batteries in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Avoid fully discharging batteries frequently to prolong their lifespan.
- Replace batteries when their capacity significantly diminishes.

6.3. Storage

When not in use, store the headsets and accessories in the provided storage and carrying bags to protect them from dust and physical damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Battery depleted or improperly inserted.	Charge the battery or ensure it is correctly inserted.
No audio / Poor audio quality	Volume too low, headset out of range, or interference.	Adjust volume, move closer to other headsets, or activate Boost Mode.
Headsets not pairing	Incorrect pairing procedure or software issue.	Refer to the SYNCO EasyGo software for pairing instructions. Ensure headsets are powered on and close to each other.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Short battery life	Battery degradation or frequent use of power-intensive features.	Replace battery if necessary. Ensure full charge before use.


