1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY WARNINGS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required. Never use in roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water. Always wear shoes,

and never allow more than 2 riders.

- Always supervise children while using this ride-on car.
- Ensure the safety belt is fastened and doors are locked.
- Use only on flat, stable surfaces.
- Regularly check for any damage and discontinue use if any issues are found.
- Recommended age: 3 years and up.
- Maximum weight capacity: 132 lbs.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The vehicle arrives approximately 70% pre-assembled. Follow these steps to complete the assembly:

1. **Install Wheels:** Attach the front and rear wheels to their respective axles. Secure them with the provided hardware and hubcaps.
2. **Connect Battery:** Locate the battery compartment and connect the power cables as instructed.
3. **Install Steering Wheel:** Secure the steering wheel to the steering column. Ensure it is firmly attached.
4. **Install Seats:** Place the seats into the designated slots and secure them with the provided screws.
5. **Attach Mirrors and Roll Bar:** Snap on the side mirrors and attach the roll bar with the integrated lights.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Driving Modes

- **Manual Operation:** Children can drive independently using the power pedal and steering wheel.
- **Parental Remote Control:** For younger children or added safety, parents can take control using the 2.4GHz remote. The remote features 3 speed settings (2.1-3.5-5.0 mph) and a one-touch emergency brake with priority override.

Features

- **LED Lights:** Bright LED headlights for enhanced visibility and realistic play.
- **Entertainment System:** Includes Bluetooth audio, FM radio, realistic engine sounds, and a working horn for an immersive driving experience.
- **Truck Bed Storage:** A rear storage trunk is available for snacks and small toys.
- **Dual Seating:** The 20-inch wide seat comfortably accommodates two children.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Charging:** Use the provided charging box and charger. Smart charging technology helps extend battery life. Ensure the vehicle is turned off during charging.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight when not in use.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check for any loose parts, damaged wires, or worn tires. Address any issues promptly to ensure safe operation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Vehicle Not Moving:** Check if the battery is charged and properly connected. Ensure the power switch is in the 'ON' position. Verify that the remote control is paired correctly if using parental mode.
- **Reduced Power/Speed:** This may indicate a low battery charge. Recharge the vehicle fully. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
- **Lights/Sounds Not Working:** Check all connections. Ensure the vehicle is powered on. If the steering wheel horn is not working, check the AA batteries inside the steering wheel.
