## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for purchasing the DWVO Large Bakers Rack with Power Outlets and Wine Rack. This versatile 5-tier storage unit is designed to enhance organization and functionality in your kitchen, living room, or office. It features integrated power outlets, a wine rack, and glass holders, making it ideal for various uses such as a microwave stand, coffee bar, or general storage shelf. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper operation.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please observe the following safety precautions to prevent injury or damage to the product:

- **Read all instructions:** Before assembly and use, carefully read and understand all instructions.
- **Keep children away:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- **Use appropriate tools:** Use only the tools specified in the assembly instructions.
- **Assemble on a soft surface:** Assemble the unit on a soft, non-abrasive surface (e.g., carpet or cardboard) to prevent scratching.
- **Do not overtighten:** Do not overtighten screws or bolts, as this may damage the material.
- **Check stability:** Ensure the rack is stable and level before placing items on it. Use the adjustable feet to compensate for uneven floors.
- **Weight limits:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limits for each shelf. Distribute weight evenly.
- **Electrical safety:** When using the power outlets, ensure appliances are within the specified voltage and current ratings. Do not overload the outlets. Keep liquids away from electrical components.
- **Tip-over prevention:** For added safety, consider securing the rack to a wall, especially if it will hold heavy items or is in an area accessible to children.

## 4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a spacious area and lay out all parts on a soft surface to prevent scratches. Identify all components using the letter/number codes.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:** Begin by connecting the lower side frames using the designated crossbars and screws. Ensure all connections are snug but do not fully tighten yet.
3. **Install Lower Shelves:** Attach the bottom shelf and any other lower shelves to the assembled base frame.
4. **Attach Wine Rack:** Insert the wine rack components into their designated slots on the lower section of the frame.
5. **Assemble Upper Frame:** Connect the upper side frames and attach them to the lower section. Secure the middle and top shelves.
6. **Install Goblet Holders and Hooks:** Attach the goblet holders to the underside of the appropriate shelf. Secure the S-shaped hooks to the side rail.
7. **Integrate Power Outlets:** Mount the power outlet unit into its designated position on the rack. Ensure the power cord is routed safely and not pinched.
8. **Install Back Panels (if applicable):** Secure any back panels to the rear of the unit.
9. **Final Tightening and Leveling:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all screws and bolts. Place the rack in its desired location and adjust the foot pads to ensure stability and levelness.

10. **Safety Check:** Gently shake the assembled rack to confirm stability. If an anti-tip kit is provided, install it according to its instructions to secure the rack to the wall.

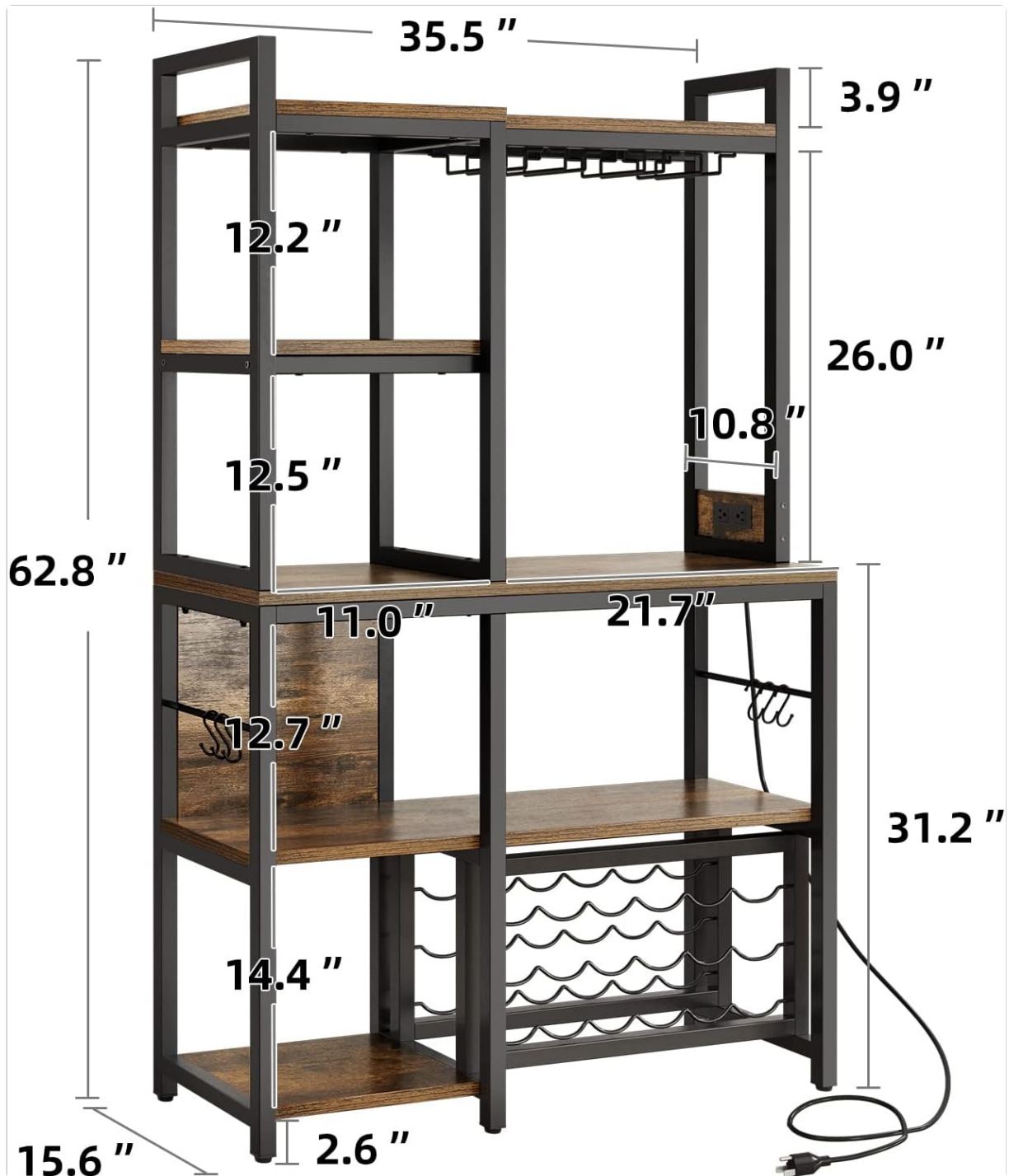


Figure 2: Detailed dimensions of the bakers rack. This image provides measurements for various sections, aiding in planning placement and understanding capacity.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The DWVO Bakers Rack is designed for versatile storage and utility. Here's how to best utilize its features:

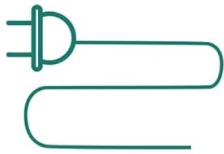
- **General Storage:** Use the multiple shelves to store kitchen appliances, pantry items, cookbooks, or decorative pieces. Distribute weight evenly across shelves.
- **Power Outlets:** The integrated power outlets (2 AC outlets with a 6.56FT cord) allow you to conveniently power small kitchen appliances like coffee makers, toasters, or blenders directly on the rack. Ensure the total wattage of connected devices does not exceed the outlet's capacity.
- **Wine Rack:** The dedicated wine rack section can hold up to 18 wine bottles, keeping them organized and easily accessible.
- **Goblet Holders:** Hang wine glasses or other stemmed glassware from the goblet holders for convenient storage and display.
- **S-Shaped Hooks:** Utilize the 6 S-shaped hooks for hanging utensils, oven mitts, towels, or other small kitchen accessories.

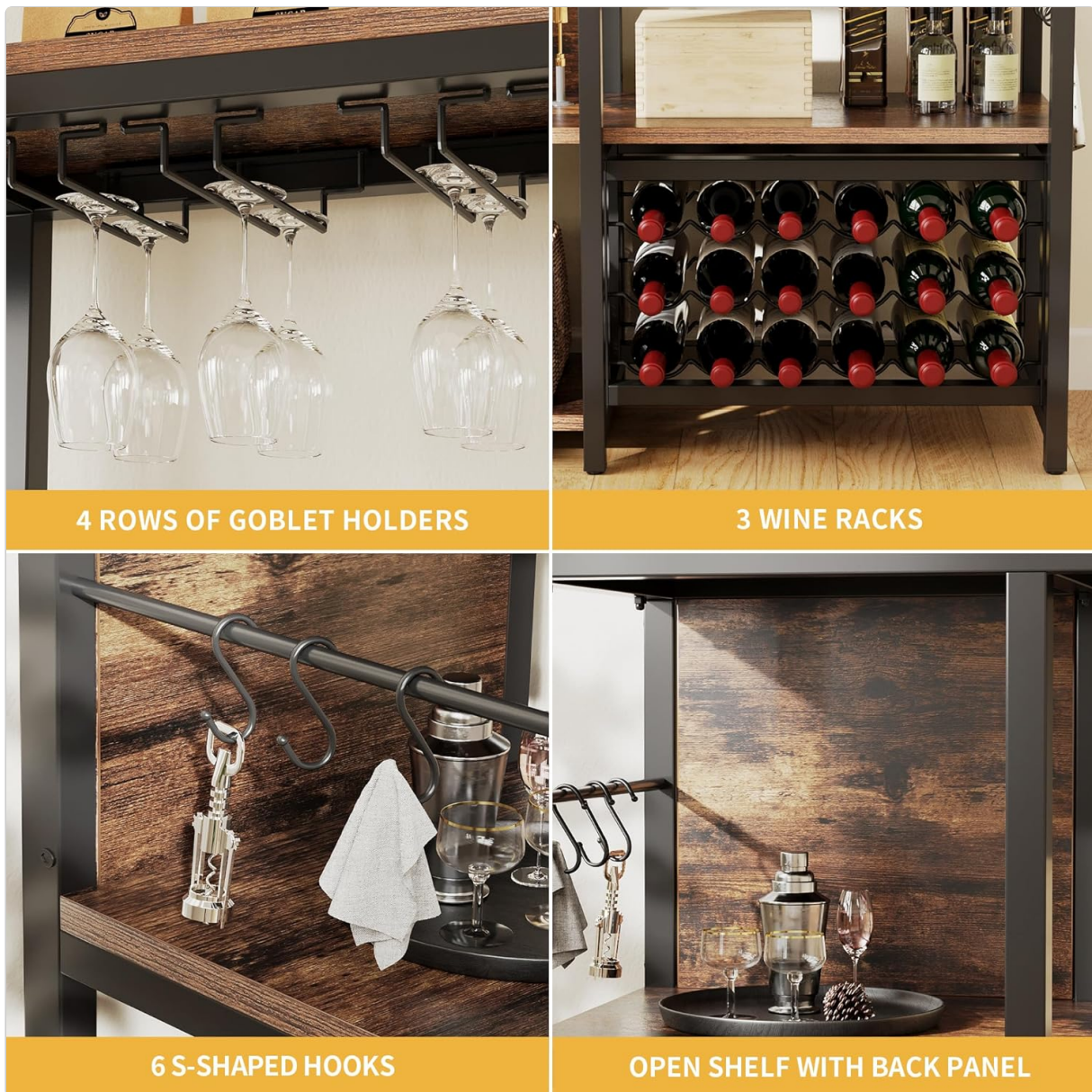


Figure 6: Close-up showing the 4 rows of goblet holders, 3 wine racks for bottles, and 6 S-shaped hooks for hanging accessories. This illustrates the specialized storage features.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your bakers rack:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining, especially on the engineered wood surfaces.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Do not expose the rack to excessive moisture or humidity, as this can cause warping or damage to the wood.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged direct sunlight exposure to prevent fading of the finish.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Rack is wobbly/unstable	Loose screws; uneven floor	Ensure all screws are tightened. Adjust the foot pads to level the rack on uneven surfaces.
Parts do not fit together	Incorrect orientation; wrong parts used	Double-check the assembly diagram and part numbers. Ensure parts are oriented correctly. Do not force parts.
Power outlets not working	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; faulty appliance	Ensure the rack's power cord is securely plugged into a working wall outlet. Check your home's circuit breaker. Test the appliance in another outlet. Do not overload the rack's outlets.
Missing hardware/parts	Packaging error	Contact DWVO customer support with your purchase details and the specific missing items.
