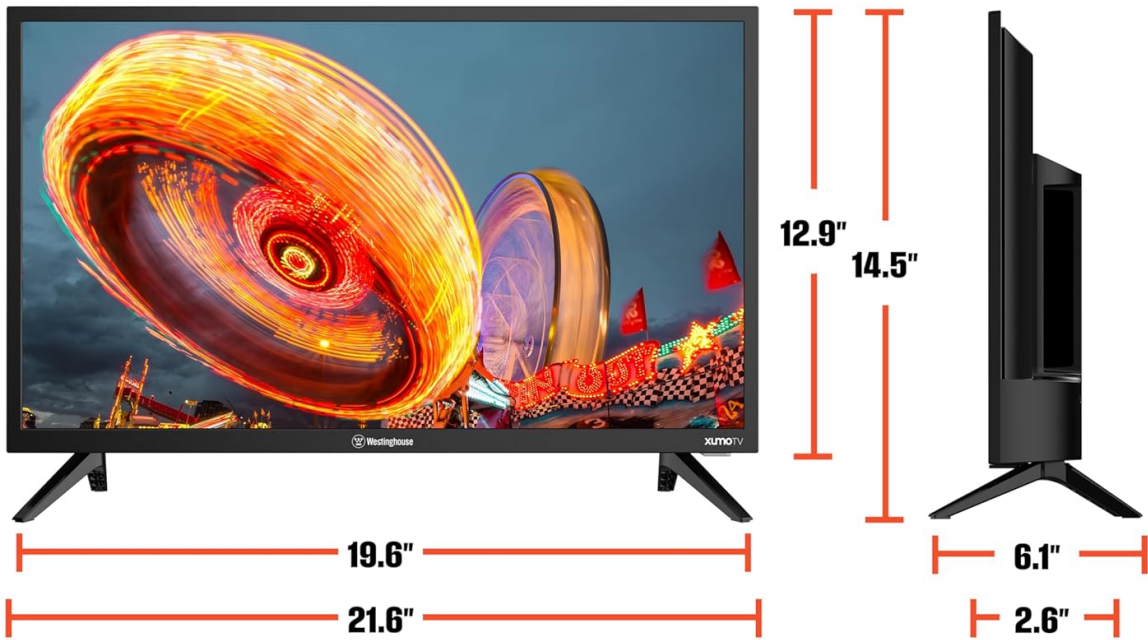
INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Attaching the TV Stand

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align the stand bases with the screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

2. Power Connection

- Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then to a wall outlet.

3. Initial Setup and Network Connection

- Turn on the TV using the power button on the remote control.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, country, and connect to your Wi-Fi network.

- The Xumo TV platform will guide you through the remaining setup steps, including signing into your streaming accounts.

4. Voice Remote Pairing

- Insert the included AAA batteries into the voice remote.
- The remote should automatically pair with your TV. If not, follow the on-screen prompts or refer to the Quick Start Guide for manual pairing instructions.

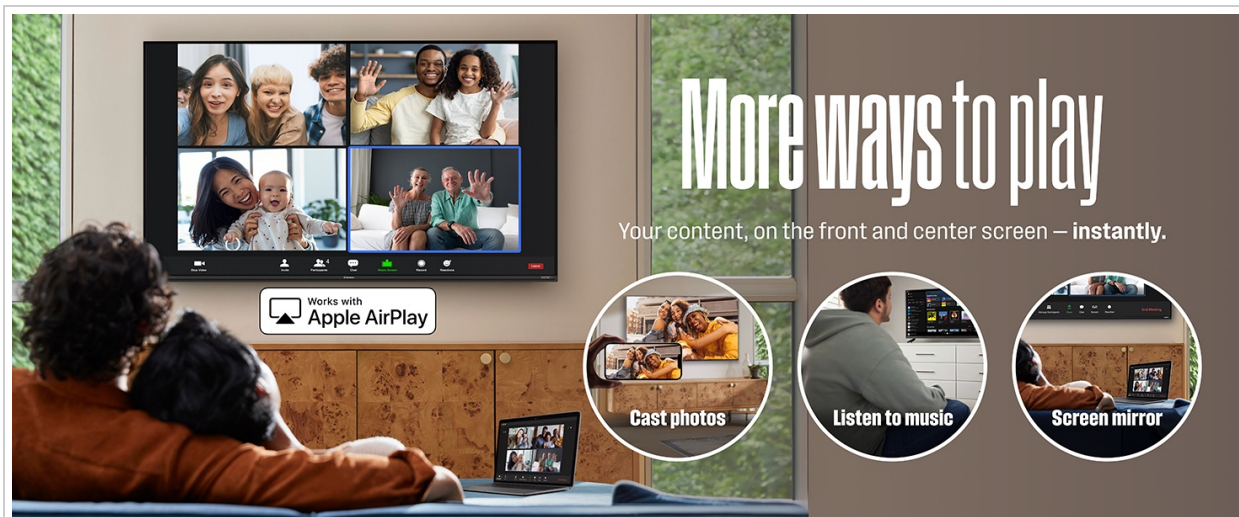
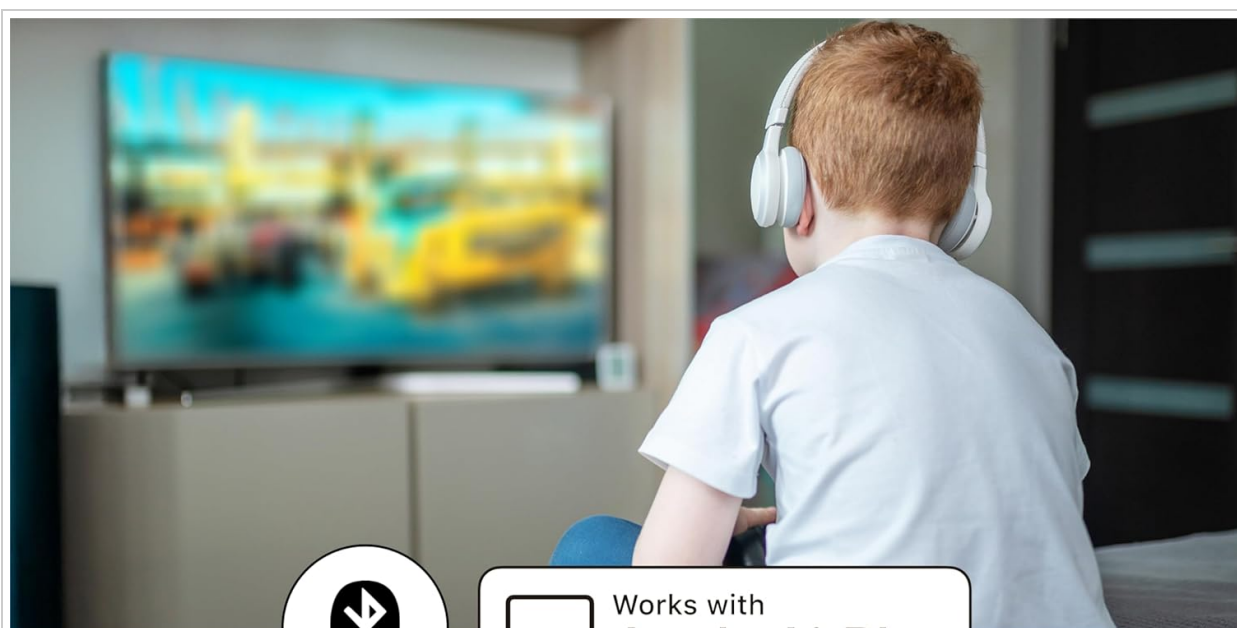

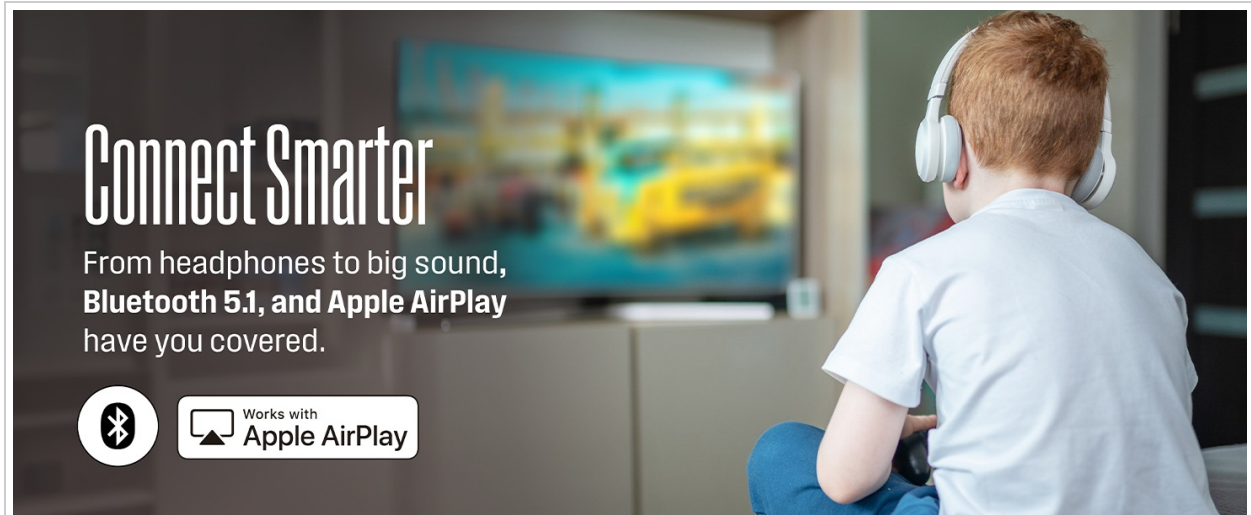

CONNECTIVITY

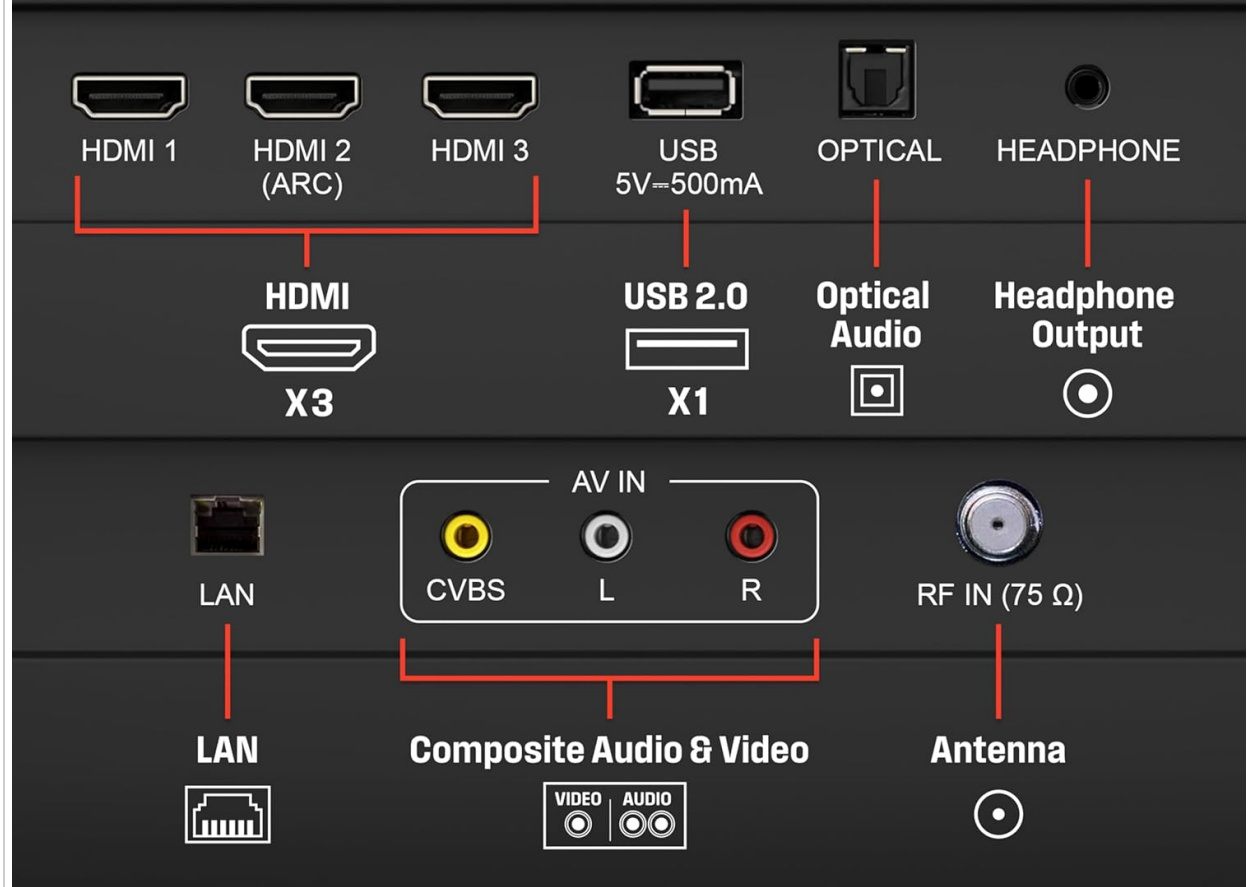

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner.

- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they can damage the TV's finish.

General Care

- Do not block ventilation openings on the back of the TV.
- Keep the TV away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive moisture.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the TV.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, try the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
No power	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
No picture/sound	Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, etc.). Ensure the correct input source is selected on the TV.
Remote control not working	Check and replace batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV. Re-pair the remote if necessary.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Verify your Wi-Fi password. Restart your router and modem. Ensure the TV is within range of your Wi-Fi signal.
Poor picture quality	Check cable connections. Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness). Ensure the content source is high quality.

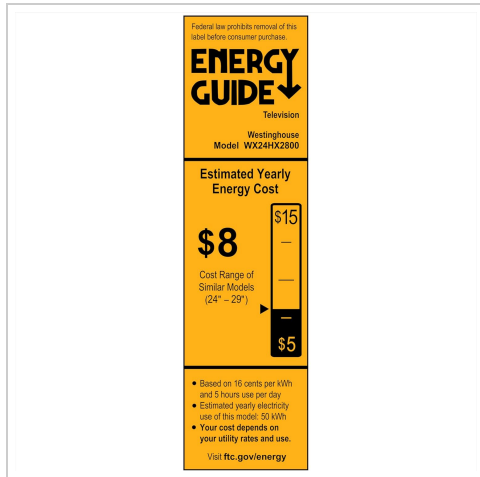
