3. SETUP

3.1 Attaching the Stand

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align the TV stand with the mounting holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stand using the provided screws. Ensure the stand is firmly attached.

3.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)

If you prefer to wall mount your TV, ensure you use a VESA compatible wall mount (not included). The TV supports VESA 200mm x 100mm with M4x10mm screws (4PCS).

3.3 Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the TV's power input and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet.

3.4 Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, the TV will guide you through the initial setup process, including language selection, network connection (Wi-Fi or Ethernet), and channel scanning. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the setup.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic TV Functions

- **Power On/Off:** Press the Power button on the remote control.

- **Volume Control:** Use the Volume Up/Down buttons on the remote.
- **Channel Selection:** Use the Channel Up/Down buttons or the number pad.
- **Input Selection:** Press the Input button to switch between connected devices (HDMI, USB, etc.).

5. CONNECTIVITY

5.1 Input/Output Ports

Your TV is equipped with a variety of ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI (x3):** Connect Blu-ray players, game consoles, cable boxes, and other HDMI-enabled devices. HDMI 2 supports ARC (Audio Return Channel).
- **USB (x1):** For connecting USB storage devices to play media files.
- **Composite Video (CVBS):** For older devices using RCA cables.
- **Optical Digital Audio:** For connecting to soundbars or home theater systems for high-quality audio.
- **Headphone Output:** For connecting headphones.
- **LAN (Ethernet):** For a wired internet connection.
- **RF IN (Antenna):** For connecting an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts.

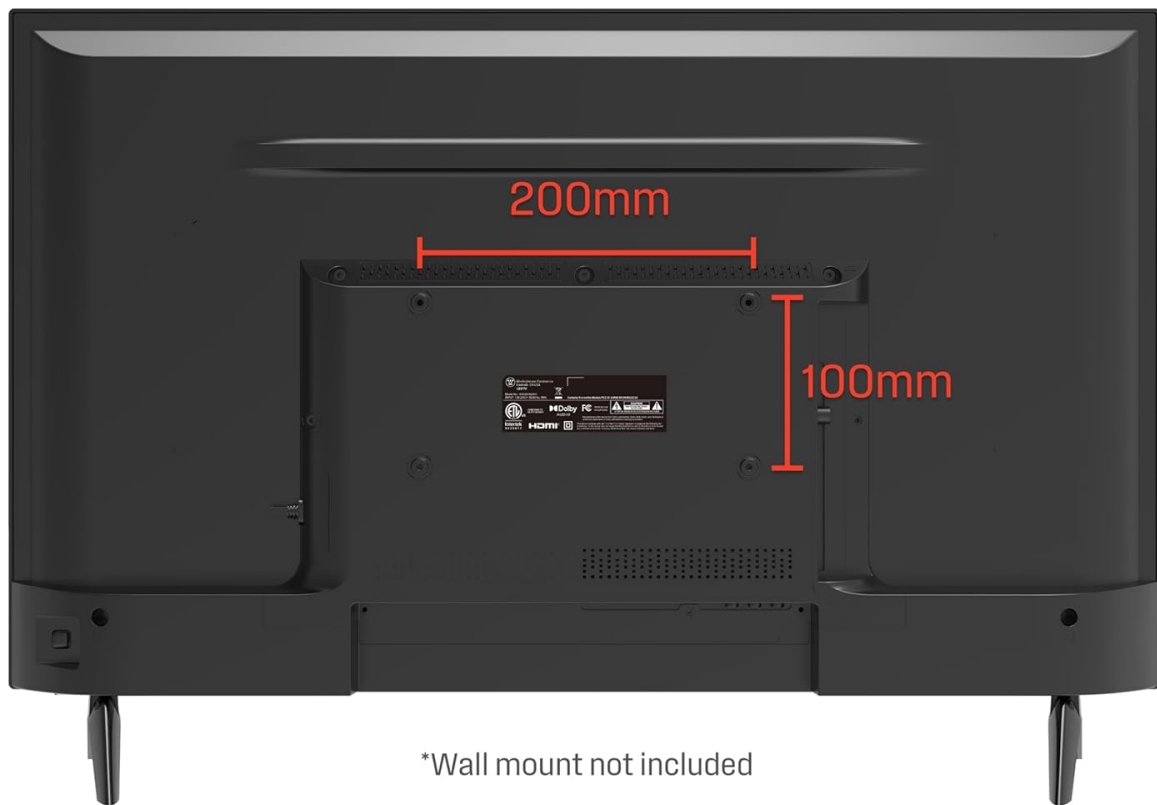
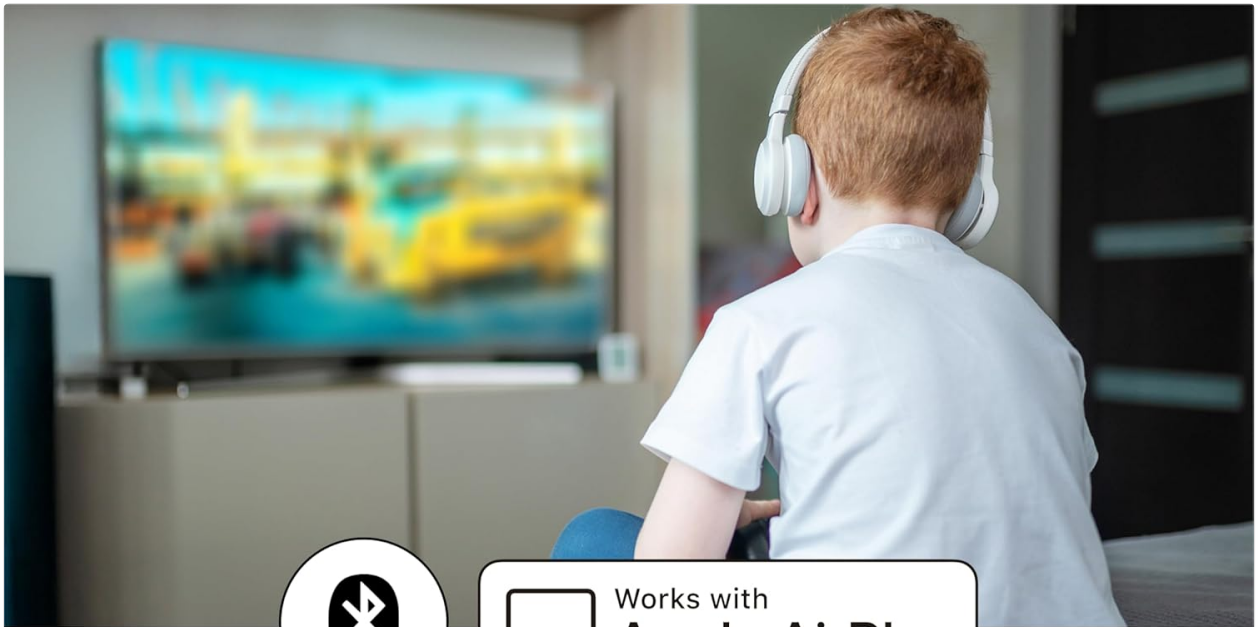


Figure 5.1: TV Connectivity Ports

5.2 Wireless Connectivity

- **Apple AirPlay:** Stream or mirror content directly from your iPhone, iPad, or Mac to the TV. This includes music, photos, and video.

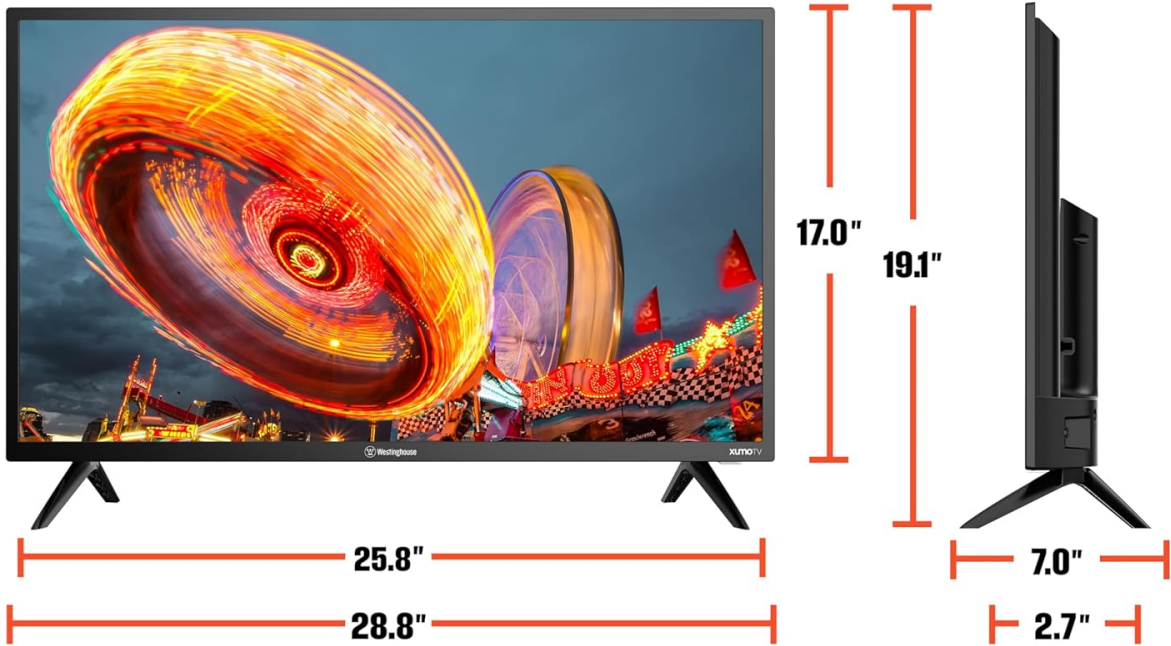

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the TV

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for electronics.
- Do not spray cleaners directly onto the TV.

6.2 Software Updates

Your Smart TV may receive periodic software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates automatically or check for them manually through the TV's settings menu.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause / Solution |
|-------------------------------------|--|
| No Power | Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and a working electrical outlet. Check if the outlet has power. |
| No Picture, but Sound is Present | Check the input source. Ensure the connected device is powered on and functioning correctly. Try a different HDMI cable. |
| No Sound, but Picture is Present | Check the volume level. Ensure Mute is not activated. Check audio output settings (e.g., internal speakers vs. external sound system). |
| Remote Control Not Working | Replace the batteries in the remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor. |
| Cannot Connect to Wi-Fi | Ensure your Wi-Fi router is on and working. Re-enter the Wi-Fi password. Try restarting both the TV and the router. |
| Apps Not Loading / Slow Performance | Check your internet connection speed. Try restarting the TV. Ensure the TV's software is up to date. |

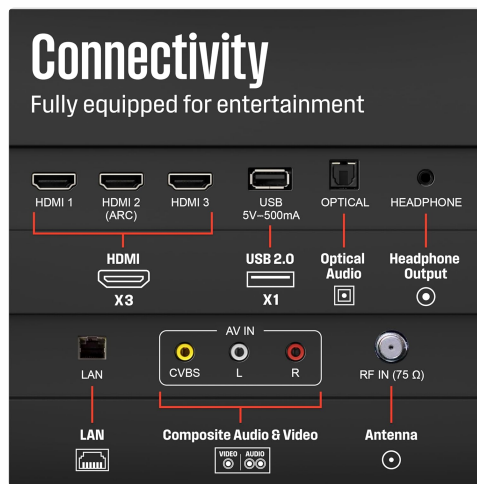


Figure 8.1: Energy Guide Information
