1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Epson EcoTank ET-3950 Wireless All-in-One Color Supertank Printer. The ET-3950 is designed for home office use, featuring refillable ink tanks, wireless connectivity, and multi-function capabilities including printing, scanning, and copying.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and Initial Placement

Carefully remove the printer from its packaging. Ensure all protective tapes and materials are removed. Place the printer on a stable, flat surface with adequate space for paper loading and output.

2.2 Filling the Ink Tanks

The EcoTank ET-3950 uses refillable ink tanks. Follow these steps to fill them:

1. Open the ink tank unit cover.
2. Open the cap for the ink tank you wish to fill.
3. Uncap the corresponding EcoFit ink bottle and insert it into the filling port. The ink will automatically stop flowing when the tank is full.
4. Remove the bottle, recap the ink tank, and close the ink tank unit cover.
5. Repeat for all colors.

2.3 Powering On and Initial Configuration

Connect the power cord and press the power button. Follow the on-screen instructions on the 2.4" color display to complete the initial setup, including language selection and ink initialization.

3. OPERATING THE PRINTER

3.1 Loading Paper

Open the paper cassette and load paper face down. Adjust the paper guides to fit the paper size. The printer supports a 250-sheet paper capacity.

3.2 Printing Documents

To print, send a print job from your computer or mobile device. The printer supports up to 18 ISO ppm for black and 9 ISO ppm for color. Auto duplex printing is available for two-sided documents.

3.3 Scanning Documents

Place documents on the scanner glass or in the Auto Document Feeder (ADF). Use the printer's control panel or the Epson Smart Panel app to initiate a scan. The scanner supports both flatbed and sheetfed scanning.

3.4 Copying Documents

Place the original document on the scanner glass or in the ADF. Use the printer's control panel to select copy settings (e.g., number of copies, color/black & white, size) and start the copying process. The printer can make up to 99 copies per run.

3.5 Wireless Connectivity

The ET-3950 supports Wi-Fi and Ethernet connectivity. To connect wirelessly, navigate to the network settings on the printer's display and follow the instructions to connect to your Wi-Fi network. Mobile printing is supported via the Epson Smart Panel app and Apple AirPrint.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Ink Refilling

Monitor ink levels through the transparent ink tanks or the printer's display. When an ink tank is low, refill it using genuine Epson 502 ink bottles. Refer to section 2.2 for detailed refilling instructions.

4.2 Cleaning the Printer

Regularly clean the exterior of the printer with a soft, damp cloth. For print quality issues, perform a nozzle check and head cleaning from the printer's maintenance menu. Consult the on-screen guide for specific cleaning procedures.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Common Issues and Solutions

- **Printer Not Responding:** Check power connection, USB/Ethernet cable, and Wi-Fi status. Restart the printer and computer.
- **Poor Print Quality:** Perform a nozzle check and head cleaning. Ensure genuine Epson ink is used and ink tanks are not empty.
- **Paper Jams:** Open covers and carefully remove any jammed paper. Refer to the printer's display for specific jam locations.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Verify Wi-Fi password and network stability. Restart your router and printer.


