1. INTRODUCTION

The GoSports Range Cage Elite Golf Hitting Net is designed to provide a professional-style enclosure for golf practice and simulator setups. This unit features a durable powder-coated steel frame, comprehensive netting on the top and sides, and a high-definition impact screen. It is engineered to withstand high-speed swings and accommodate various golf shots, including high-lofted clubs. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective setup, operation, and maintenance of your Range Cage Elite.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembling or using the GoSports Range Cage Elite. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Adult Supervision:** Always ensure adult supervision when children are near or using the hitting net.
- **Clearance Area:** Maintain a safe distance around the hitting net to prevent accidental impact with surrounding objects or persons. Ensure adequate space for full golf swings.
- **Stable Surface:** Assemble and use the net on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent tipping.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Before each use, inspect the frame, netting, and impact screen for any signs of damage, wear, or loose connections. Do not use if any components are compromised.
- **Proper Ball Use:** Use only standard golf balls with the impact screen. Avoid using damaged or modified golf balls.
- **Weather Conditions:** If used outdoors, ensure the net is secured against wind. Do not use during strong winds or severe weather conditions. Prolonged exposure to harsh weather may reduce product lifespan.
- **Assembly:** Follow all assembly instructions carefully. Ensure all connections are secure before use.

- **No Climbing:** Do not climb on or hang from the frame of the hitting net.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The GoSports Range Cage Elite is designed for straightforward assembly. It is recommended to have at least two adults for efficient setup. Refer to the included assembly guide for detailed diagrams.

3.1 Unpacking and Component Check

Carefully unpack all components from the box. Verify that all parts listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact GoSports customer support before proceeding.

3.2 Frame Assembly

Assemble the powder-coated steel frame according to the provided instructions. Ensure all poles are correctly oriented and securely connected. The fixed cage-style frame is designed to prevent net sag and provide stability.

3.3 Netting Installation

Attach the durable netting to the assembled frame. The netting covers the top and sides of the enclosure, offering comprehensive protection for various shot types.

3.4 Impact Screen Attachment

The 95 x 93 inch HD impact screen attaches in front of the netting. This offset design minimizes ricochets from mishits. Ensure the screen is taut and securely fastened to the frame for optimal projection and impact absorption.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The GoSports Range Cage Elite is designed for use with golf simulators and for general golf practice. Follow these guidelines for optimal performance and safety.

4.1 Recommended Room Size

For the 10 L x 8.5 H x 5 D ft frame size (8 x 8 ft screen area), a minimum ceiling height of 9 ft is recommended.

Ensure sufficient space for your desired hitting distance and full swing motion, accommodating both right and left-handed golfers.

4.2 Using with Launch Monitors and Projectors

The enclosure is compatible with all major launch monitors and projectors. Position your launch monitor and projector according to their respective manufacturer's instructions. The high-density woven polyester impact screen is suitable for projection and designed to withstand impacts from real golf balls.

4.3 General Practice

When using the net for general practice without a simulator, ensure you are hitting directly into the impact screen. The surrounding netting provides additional safety for mishits, including high-lofted shots.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your GoSports Range Cage Elite.

- **Cleaning:**

- **Frame:** Wipe the powder-coated steel frame with a damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

- **Netting:** The netting can be gently hosed down if used outdoors. Ensure it is completely dry before storage to prevent mildew.
- **Impact Screen:** The impact screen can be spot cleaned with a mild detergent and water. Do not machine wash or tumble dry. Allow to air dry completely.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all frame connections to ensure they remain tight and secure. Inspect the netting and impact screen for any tears, fraying, or excessive wear. Replace damaged components as necessary.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit, disassemble it carefully and store all components in a dry, protected area away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Range Cage Elite.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Netting or screen appears saggy.	Improper assembly or loose connections.	Ensure all frame poles are fully connected and the netting/screen is properly tensioned according to assembly instructions. The fixed frame design is intended to prevent sag.
Excessive ball ricochet from the impact screen.	Impact screen not properly tensioned or incorrect ball type.	Verify the impact screen is taut and correctly offset from the back netting. Ensure you are using standard golf balls.
Damage to netting or screen after use.	Extreme impact, sharp objects, or prolonged exposure to elements.	Inspect for tears. Small tears in netting may be repaired with netting repair kits. Significant damage to the screen or netting may require replacement. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
Frame instability.	Loose frame connections or uneven ground.	Check all frame connections and tighten if necessary. Ensure the unit is placed on a flat, level surface.
