## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the VIVOHOME Heated Rocking Camping Chair. Retain this manual for future reference.

### General Safety

- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 300 lbs (136 kg).
- Ensure the chair is fully unfolded and stable on a flat surface before use.
- Keep children and pets away from the chair during heating operation.
- Avoid placing sharp objects on the chair fabric to prevent damage.
- Do not use the chair if any part is damaged or broken.

### Electrical and Battery Safety

- Use only the provided 27,000mAh PD 45W power bank or a compatible power source with similar specifications.
- Do not expose the power bank or heating elements to water or extreme moisture.
- Unplug the power bank from the chair when not in use or during cleaning.
- The built-in thermistor provides overheat protection. If the chair feels excessively hot, turn off the heating function immediately.
- Do not puncture, disassemble, or modify the power bank.
- Charge the power bank in a well-ventilated area, away from flammable materials.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The VIVOHOME Heated Rocking Camping Chair is designed for comfort and warmth in outdoor settings. It features integrated heating pads, a robust frame, and convenient storage options.

- **27,000mAh Power Bank:** Provides extended heating time and features 2 USB ports and 1 Type-C port for charging other devices.

## 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The VIVOHOME Heated Rocking Camping Chair is designed for quick and easy setup. No assembly is required.

### Unfolding the Chair

1. Remove the chair from its carrying bag.
2. Stand the folded chair upright.



3. Gently lower the rocking legs to the ground.
4. Lift the bottom fabric of the seat to prevent snagging.
5. Pull the opposite corners of the chair frame outwards until it fully opens and locks into place.

## Folding the Chair

1. Ensure the heating function is off and the power bank is disconnected.
2. Hold the middle of the seat and the backrest, then push them inward to begin folding.
3. Continue to fold the legs upwards until the chair is compact.
4. Secure the folded chair and place it into the carrying bag for transport or storage.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## Power Bank Operation

- **Charging the Power Bank:** Use the provided USB-C cable to connect the power bank to a compatible wall adapter (not included). The indicator lights will show charging progress.
- **Checking Battery Status:** Press the power button on the power bank once to see the battery level indicated by the LED lights (each light represents approximately 25% charge).
- **Connecting to Chair:** Locate the Type-C port on the chair's control panel. Connect the power bank to this port using the USB-C cable. Ensure a secure connection.
- **Charging External Devices:** The power bank features 2 USB-A ports and 1 USB-C port, allowing you to charge phones, tablets, or laptops while the chair is in use or independently.

## Heating Function

- **Powering On/Off:** Press and hold the desired heating zone button (back or seat) for 3 seconds to turn the heating on or off.
- **Adjusting Heat Levels:** Once a heating zone is on, press the corresponding button once to cycle through the three temperature settings: Low (122°F), Medium (140°F), and High (158°F). The LED indicator on the

button will change color to reflect the selected level.

- **Independent Control:** The back and seat heating zones can be operated independently, allowing for personalized comfort.
- **Rapid Heating:** The heating pads warm up in approximately 5 seconds.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning

- Ensure the chair is unplugged from the power bank before cleaning.
- Wipe clean the fabric surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Allow the chair to air dry completely before folding or storing.
- For the steel frame, wipe with a damp cloth as needed.

### Storage

- Fold the chair as instructed in Section 4.
- Store the chair in its carrying bag in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Ensure the power bank is fully charged before long-term storage to maintain battery health.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heating not working	Power bank not connected or low battery. Heating zone not activated. Overheat protection engaged.	Ensure power bank is connected and charged. Press and hold the heating button for 3 seconds. Allow chair to cool down, then restart.
Power bank not charging	Charging cable or adapter faulty. Power bank fully charged.	Try a different USB-C cable and wall adapter. Check battery indicator lights; if full, no further charging is needed.
Chair is unstable	Not fully unfolded or on uneven ground.	Ensure chair is fully locked into position. Move to a flat, stable surface.
