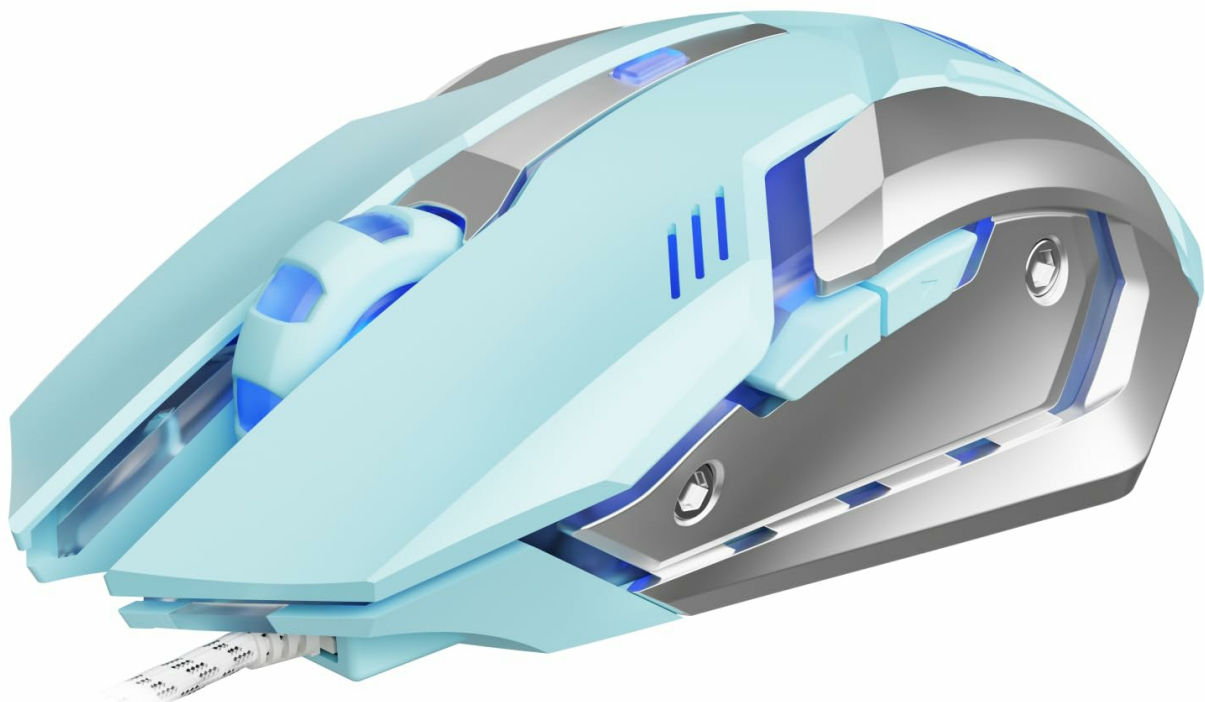


Image 1: EWEADN G3 Wired Gaming Mouse, showcasing its ergonomic design and wired connection.

- **Dynamic 4-Color Breathing Light:** Features an automatic cycle of blue, pink, red, and purple lighting, with an option to turn off the lights.
- **Durable Design:** Engineered for 3 million clicks durability with a metal base.
- **Ergonomic Comfort:** Designed for a comfortable grip during extended use.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Connecting Your Mouse

1. Locate an available USB-A port on your computer (PC or Laptop).
2. Plug the USB connector of the EWEADN G3 mouse into the USB-A port.
3. The mouse is designed for plug-and-play functionality and should be recognized automatically by your operating system (Windows, Mac OS, Chrome OS, Linux). No additional drivers are typically required for basic functionality.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 DPI Adjustment

The EWEADN G3 mouse features a dedicated DPI button to quickly adjust tracking sensitivity. Press the DPI button (located near the scroll wheel) to cycle through four preset DPI levels: 800, 1200, 1600, and 2400. This allows you to adapt the mouse speed to different tasks, from precise editing to fast-paced gaming.

4.2 Programmable Buttons

Your mouse is equipped with 6 buttons: Left Click, Right Click, Scroll Wheel (clickable), DPI Button, Forward Button, and Backward Button. The Forward and Backward buttons are typically located on the side of the mouse. These buttons can be programmed using the optional software to execute macros, shortcuts, or specific game commands, providing a personalized control experience.

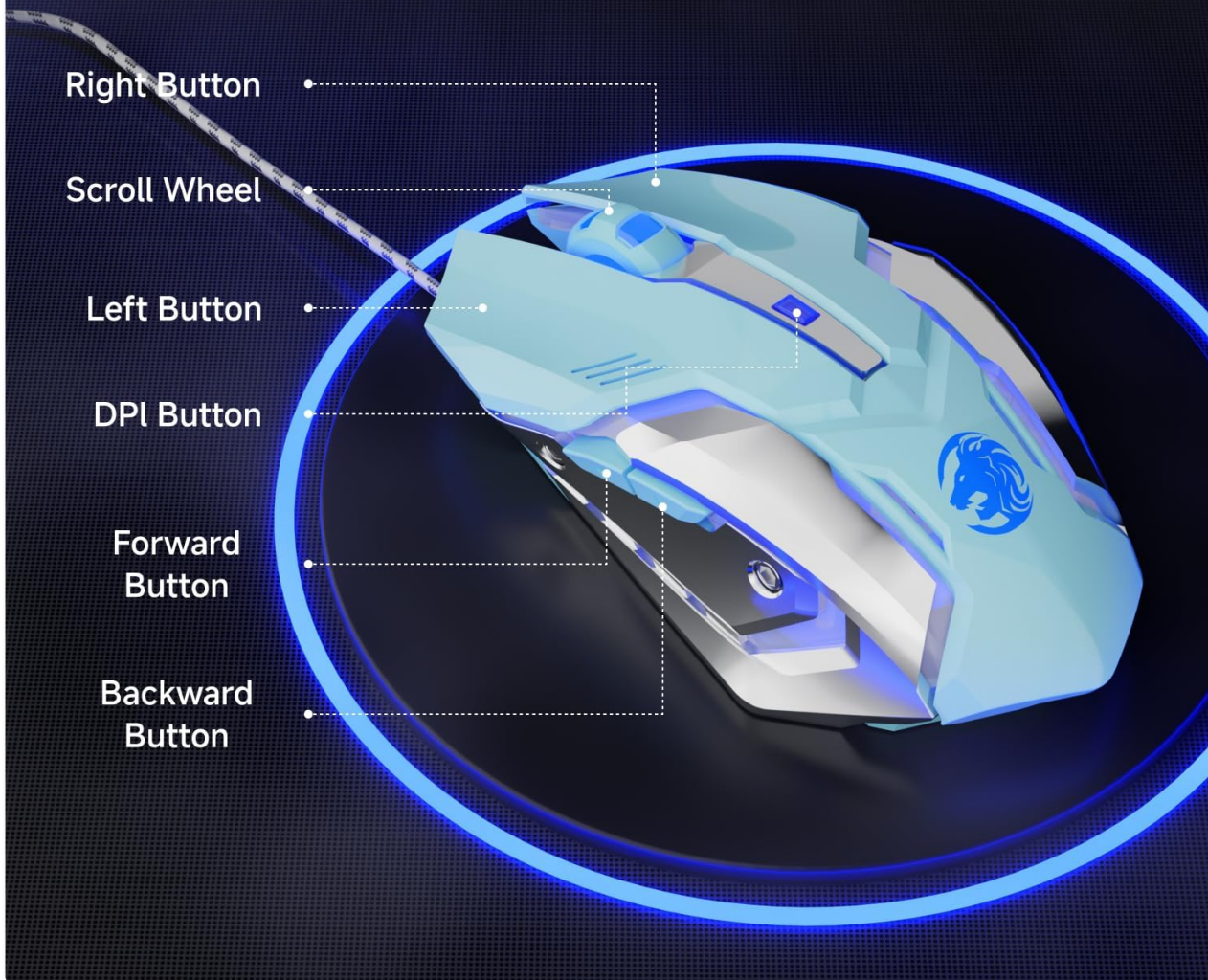


Image 5: Diagram showing the location of the 6 buttons on the EWEADN G3 mouse.

4.3 Dynamic RGB Lighting

The EWEADN G3 mouse features a dynamic four-color breathing light effect, cycling through blue, pink, red, and purple. The lighting automatically breathes and switches. To turn off the lighting, refer to the optional software or specific button combinations if available (not specified in basic features).

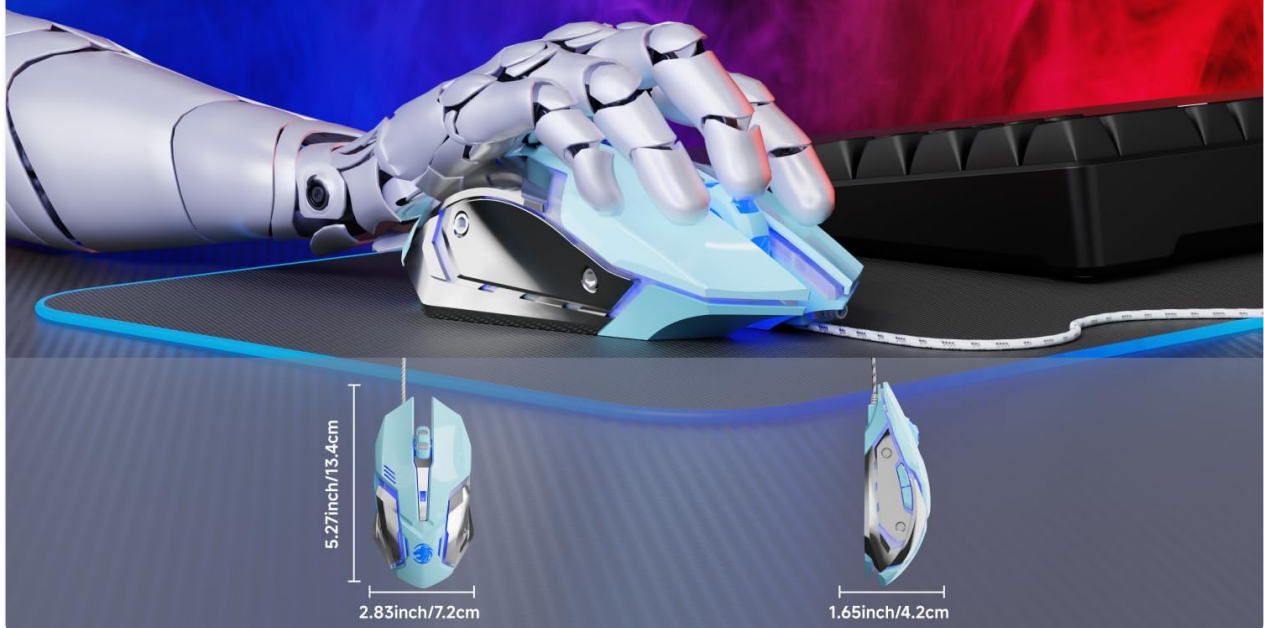


Image 7: A hand comfortably gripping the EWEADN G3 mouse, highlighting its ergonomic design.

4.5 Silent Click Feature

The EWEADN G3 mouse incorporates an upgraded mute button design, offering a quieter clicking experience compared to standard mice. This feature is beneficial in environments where noise reduction is desired.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- Disconnect the mouse from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the mouse.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the mouse.
- For the optical sensor, use a cotton swab to gently clean any dust or debris.

5.2 Storage

When not in use, store the mouse in a clean, dry environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid coiling the cable too tightly to prevent damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Mouse not responding:** Ensure the USB connector is securely plugged into a working USB-A port. Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port or another computer to rule out port or computer issues.

- **Cursor movement is erratic or slow:** Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse. Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface (e.g., a mouse pad) and not on reflective or uneven surfaces. Adjust the DPI settings using the DPI button.
- **Buttons not working:** Check if the buttons are physically obstructed. If using custom software, ensure the button assignments are correct.
- **RGB lighting not working:** Verify the mouse is properly connected. If using custom software, check the lighting settings.
