IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Whuto Cold Press Juicer. Retain this manual for future reference.

- Always ensure the juicer is placed on a stable, flat, and dry surface during operation.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or any other liquid. Clean only with a damp cloth.
- Keep hands and utensils away from the feed chute during operation to prevent injury. Always use the food pusher provided.
- Unplug the juicer from the power outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Do not operate the juicer if the power cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Contact customer support for assistance.
- Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and the safety lock is engaged before turning on the appliance. The juicer is designed with a safety lock that prevents operation if the feed chute lid is not properly closed.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not process frozen fruits or vegetables, as this can damage the machine's plastic components.

SAFETY LOCK DESIGN

Savor your juicing moments, with peace of mind



Prevent accidental hand injuries:
Pauses working when the feed chute lid is open.



Avoid unintentional disassembly during use:
Disassembly by rotation is locked when the lid is closed.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Whuto Cold Press Juicer:

1. **Motor Base:** Contains the motor and control panel.
2. **Juicing Bowl:** Collects juice and pulp.
3. **Auger (Black Auger):** The spiral component that crushes and presses ingredients.
4. **Filter Screen:** Separates juice from pulp.
5. **Feed Chute Lid:** Covers the feed chute and includes the safety lock mechanism.
6. **Food Pusher:** Used to guide ingredients into the feed chute.
7. **Pulp Container:** Collects expelled pulp.
8. **Juice Container:** Collects extracted juice.
9. **Cleaning Brush:** For easy cleaning of components.

SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your juicer before first use:

1. Place the motor base on a clean, stable, and dry countertop.
2. Align the juicing bowl with the motor base and rotate it clockwise until it locks securely into place.
3. Insert the filter screen into the juicing bowl, ensuring it sits firmly.
4. Place the auger into the center of the filter screen, pressing down gently until it is seated.
5. Attach the feed chute lid by aligning it with the juicing bowl and rotating it clockwise until it clicks into the safety lock position. Ensure it is fully locked to allow operation.
6. Position the pulp container under the pulp outlet and the juice container under the juice outlet.
7. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for efficient juicing:

- 1. Prepare Ingredients:** Wash all fruits and vegetables thoroughly. For most items, the wide feed chute allows for whole produce. For very large or fibrous items, cut them into smaller pieces that fit comfortably into the chute. Remove hard pits from fruits like peaches or plums.
- 2. Start Juicing:** Turn the control dial to the 'ON' position.
- 3. Feed Ingredients:** Slowly feed the prepared ingredients into the feed chute. Use the food pusher to gently guide them down. Do not force ingredients into the chute.
- 4. Reverse Function:** If ingredients become jammed or the juicer clogs, turn the dial to the 'REV' (Reverse) position for a few seconds to clear the blockage, then return to 'ON' to resume juicing.
- 5. Continuous Operation:** The juicer is designed for continuous operation. However, for optimal performance and motor longevity, it is recommended to operate for no more than 20 minutes at a time, allowing a short break if needed.
- 6. Beyond Juicing:** This machine can also be used to create nut milk or ice cream. Refer to specific recipes

for these applications.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your juicer:

1. **Disassembly:** Unplug the juicer. Disassemble the parts in reverse order of assembly: remove the feed chute lid, then the auger, filter screen, and juicing bowl from the motor base.
2. **Rinsing:** Rinse all detachable parts (juicing bowl, auger, filter screen, feed chute lid, pulp container, juice container) under running water immediately after use. This prevents pulp from drying and sticking.
3. **Brush Cleaning:** Use the included cleaning brush to remove any stubborn pulp residue from the filter screen and other components.
4. **Dishwasher Safe:** Most detachable parts are dishwasher safe for convenience. Refer to the

'Specifications' section for details.

5. **Motor Base Cleaning:** Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Never submerge it in water.
6. **Drying and Storage:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing the juicer. Store in a clean, dry place.



CLEAN UP IS A CINCH

Rinse with water, or use the included brush as needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for common issues and their solutions:

- **Machine Not Turning On:**
 - Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
 - Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and the feed chute lid is fully locked into place. The safety lock prevents operation if not properly secured.
- **Clogging During Operation:**
 - If the juicer slows down or stops, switch to the 'REV' (Reverse) function for a few seconds to clear the

blockage. Then return to 'ON'.

- Cut harder or fibrous ingredients (e.g., celery, ginger) into smaller pieces before feeding.
- Feed ingredients slowly and allow the auger to process them completely before adding more.

- **Low Juice Yield / Wet Pulp:**

- Ensure ingredients are fresh and firm. Overripe or soft produce may yield less juice.
- Some ingredients naturally have lower juice content.
- For maximum extraction, you may re-process the pulp, though results may vary.

- **Unusual Noise or Vibration:**

- Ensure the juicer is placed on a stable, flat, and level surface.
- Check for any foreign objects or large, unprocessed pieces of produce stuck in the juicing chamber.
- Verify that all components are correctly assembled and securely locked.
