## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Electro-Voice Evolve 70 Column Loudspeaker System is a powerful and portable audio solution designed for professional users. It delivers impeccable audio quality and high output, suitable for larger events and venues. The system features advanced materials and ergonomic design for maximum portability and rapid deployment.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE Box

Upon unboxing your Electro-Voice Evolve 70 system, ensure all components are present and in good condition. The standard package includes:

- EVOLVE70-SB-US Subwoofer
- Power Cord

- Column Array (top speaker section)
- Distance Pole (for connecting subwoofer and column array)
- Carrying Case for the array and distance pole

### 3. SETUP

The EVOLVE 70 system is designed for quick and easy assembly, following a 3-2-1 approach: three pieces fit together in two clicks to form one system.

#### 3.1 Physical Assembly

1. Place the EVOLVE70-SB-US Subwoofer on a stable, flat surface.
2. Insert the aluminum distance pole into the top receptacle of the subwoofer. The magnetic locking mechanism will secure it.
3. Attach the column array (top speaker section) onto the top of the distance pole. Ensure it clicks securely into place.

### 3.2 Connections

The rear panel of the subwoofer features various input and output options:

- **XLR/TRS Combo Mic-Line Inputs:** For microphones or line-level audio sources.
- **RCA Line Level Inputs:** For consumer audio devices.
- **Digital AES/EBU Input:** For professional digital audio signals.
- **XLR Mix Out:** To send the mixed audio signal to another speaker or mixer.
- **Power Cord:** Connect the included power cord to the AC input and a power outlet.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Evolve 70 offers intuitive controls and advanced features for optimal audio performance.

## 4.1 Power On/Off

- Ensure all connections are secure before powering on.
- Flip the POWER switch on the rear panel of the subwoofer to the 'ON' position.
- To power off, flip the POWER switch to the 'OFF' position.

## 4.2 Input Level Adjustment

- Each input channel (Input 1, Input 2, Input 3) has a dedicated level control knob.
- Adjust these knobs to achieve the desired volume for each connected audio source.
- The Master Volume knob controls the overall output level of the system.

## 4.3 Bluetooth Connectivity

- Activate Bluetooth on your compatible device.
- On the Evolve 70 control panel, press the Bluetooth pairing button. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash.
- Select 'EVOLVE70' from your device's Bluetooth menu. The indicator light will turn solid when paired.
- For stereo operation, use the QuickSmart Mobile App to link two Evolve 70 systems via Bluetooth Stereo.

## 4.4 QuickSmart Mobile App

The Evolve 70 is integrated into the QuickSmart Mobile App ecosystem. Download the app to control your speaker system remotely, including:

- Adjusting all audio functions.
- Configuring DSP presets.
- Monitoring system status.
- Linking multiple Bluetooth-enabled EV portable speakers.

## 4.5 DSP Modes

The Digital Signal Processing (DSP) modes optimize the system's sound for different applications. Use the DSP Mode selector on the control panel or via the QuickSmart App to choose from:

- **Normal:** Standard full-range sound.
- **Monitor:** Optimized for stage monitoring.
- **Playback/DJ:** Enhanced bass and treble for music playback and DJ sets.
- **Speech:** Optimized for vocal clarity.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Evolve 70 system.

### 5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals.
- Keep grilles free of dust and debris to maintain airflow and sound quality.

## 5.2 Storage and Transport

- Always disassemble the system and store the column array and distance pole in their dedicated carrying case.
- Store the subwoofer in a dry, temperature-controlled environment.
- When transporting, ensure all components are securely packed to prevent damage.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Evolve 70 system, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the subwoofer and a working power outlet. Check the power switch position.
- **No Sound:** Verify all audio cables are correctly connected to the appropriate inputs and outputs. Check input level knobs and master volume. Ensure the correct DSP mode is selected.
- **Distorted Sound:** Reduce input levels or master volume to prevent clipping. Check cable integrity.
- **Bluetooth Connection Issues:** Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing indicator). Forget the device on your Bluetooth source and try pairing again. Ensure no other devices are interfering.
- **System Link Issues:** For QuickSmart Link, ensure both speakers are within range and correctly configured via the app.
