HONOR 400 5G Smartphone User Manual

Model: Honor 400

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your HONOR 400 5G smartphone. Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the performance of your device.

The HONOR 400 is a powerful 5G smartphone featuring a 6.55-inch AMOLED display, a Qualcomm Snapdragon 7 Gen 3 processor, 12GB of RAM, and 512GB of internal storage. It operates on Android 15 and is equipped with a 5300mAh battery, a 200MP main camera, and dual-SIM capabilities.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your HONOR 400 smartphone, verify that all items are present:

- HONOR 400 5G Smartphone
- USB Cable
- *(Other accessories such as a charger, SIM ejector tool, or protective case may vary by region and package contents.)*

3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your HONOR 400 smartphone.

3.1 Front View

- **Display:** 6.55-inch AMOLED screen with 1264 x 2736 pixels resolution.
- **Front Camera:** 50 MP, f/2.0 (wide) for selfies and video calls.
- **Earpiece:** Located at the top edge of the display.

3.2 Rear View

5. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

5.1 Android 15 Operating System

Your HONOR 400 runs on Android 15, offering a user-friendly interface and access to a vast ecosystem of applications via the Google Play Store. Navigate using gestures or on-screen buttons, customize your home screen, and manage notifications.

5.2 Basic Functions

- **Making Calls:** Tap the Phone icon, enter the number, and tap the call button.
- **Sending Messages:** Use the Messaging app to send SMS/MMS.
- **Internet Browsing:** Open a web browser (e.g., Chrome) to access the internet via Wi-Fi or mobile data.
- **App Management:** Download, install, and uninstall apps from the Google Play Store.

5.3 Camera Usage

The HONOR 400 features a versatile camera system:

- **Rear Camera:** Utilize the 200 MP main sensor for high-resolution photos and the 12 MP ultrawide lens for expansive shots. Features include PDAF and Optical Image Stabilization (OIS).
- **Front Camera:** The 50 MP wide-angle front camera is ideal for selfies and video conferencing.
- **Video Recording:** Capture videos in up to 4K resolution at various frame rates (30, 60, 120 fps).

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Device Not Powering On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the phone to a charger for at least 15 minutes before attempting to power it on again.
- Try a forced restart by holding the Power button for an extended period (e.g., 10-15 seconds).

7.2 Network Connectivity Issues

- Check if your SIM card is properly inserted.
- Verify that mobile data is enabled in your phone's settings.
- Restart your device.
- Confirm with your service provider that your plan is active and there are no network outages in your area.
- Ensure your device is compatible with your network's frequencies (GSM only, no CDMA).

7.3 Apps Crashing or Freezing

- Close and reopen the app.
- Clear the app's cache and data in Settings > Apps.

- Ensure the app is updated to its latest version.
- Restart your phone.

7.4 Slow Performance

- Close unnecessary background apps.
- Clear cache and temporary files.
- Ensure you have sufficient free storage space (512GB internal storage).
- Restart your device regularly.
