Display

Ports and Buttons

- **USB-C Port:** Located at the bottom for charging and data transfer. This port also serves as the headphone jack.

- **Power Button:** On the right side of the device, used to power on/off or wake/sleep the screen.
- **Volume Buttons:** Typically located above the power button, used to adjust media and call volume.
- **SIM Card Tray:** Located on the side, for inserting Nano SIM cards and a MicroSD card.

Camera System

SETUP

1. SIM Card and MicroSD Card Installation

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your phone.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM card(s) into the designated slots. Ensure the gold contacts face downwards.
4. If desired, insert a MicroSD card into its dedicated slot for expanded storage (up to 1 TB).
5. Carefully push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

2. Initial Power On

1. Press and hold the Power button on the right side of the device until the ZTE logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, Google account login, and security settings.

3. Charging the Battery

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the device. Use the provided USB cable and a compatible power adapter (not always included) to charge your phone via the USB-C port.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Navigation

- **Touch Gestures:** Tap to select, swipe to scroll, pinch to zoom.
- **Home Screen:** Access apps, widgets, and notifications.
- **Notification Panel:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to view notifications and quick settings.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to access all installed applications.

Making Calls and Sending Messages

- **Calls:** Open the Phone app, enter the number, and tap the call icon.
- **Messages:** Open the Messages app, tap the new message icon, enter the recipient and your message.

Camera Usage

To take photos or record videos:

1. Open the Camera app.
2. Select photo or video mode.
3. Tap the shutter button to capture.
4. Use the front/rear camera switch icon to change cameras.

Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi to connect to available networks.
- **Mobile Data (4G):** Ensure your SIM card is active and mobile data is enabled in Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network.

- **Bluetooth:** Pair with other devices via Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth.
- **Hotspot:** Share your phone's internet connection via Settings > Network & internet > Hotspot & tethering.

Storage Management

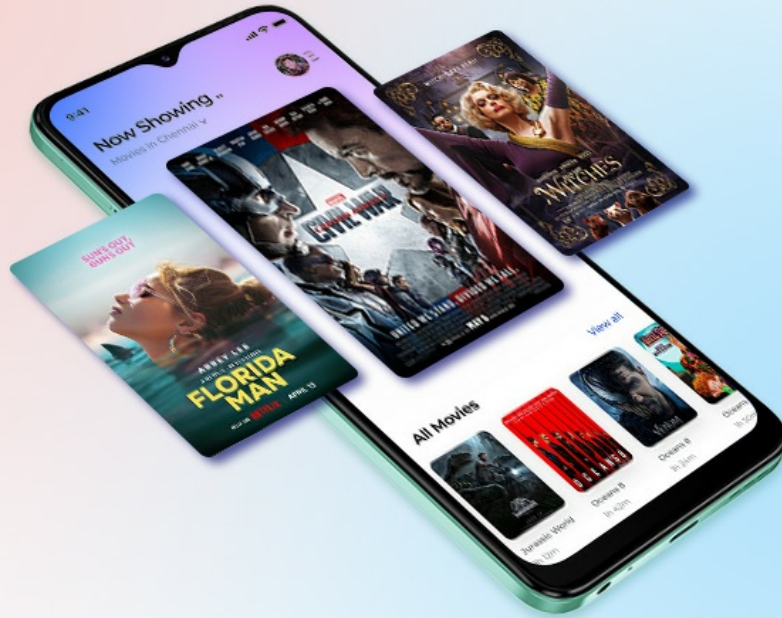

Your device comes with 64 GB of internal storage and 2 GB of RAM. You can expand storage using a MicroSD card. Regularly check storage usage in Settings > Storage to manage files and apps.

MAINTENANCE

- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures. Charge the battery before it completely drains and avoid overcharging.
- **Software Updates:** Keep your device's software updated to the latest version for improved performance and security. Check for updates in Settings > System > System update.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Data Backup:** Regularly back up your important data to a cloud service or computer to prevent loss.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ZTE Blade A35e, try the following solutions:

- **Device Not Turning On:** Ensure the battery is charged. If it still doesn't turn on, try holding the power button for 10-15 seconds for a forced restart.
- **Apps Crashing/Freezing:** Close and reopen the app. If the issue persists, clear the app's cache (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache).
- **Poor Battery Life:** Reduce screen brightness, close unused apps, disable unnecessary features like GPS or

Bluetooth when not in use.

- **No Network Connection:** Check if your SIM card is properly inserted. Ensure mobile data is enabled. Try restarting the device.
- **Slow Performance:** Clear unnecessary files and apps to free up storage. Restart the device regularly.
