INTRODUCTION




Figure 1: Karinear 36" Electric Cooktop Overview

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury to persons, or damage when using the appliance, follow basic precautions, including the following:

- **Professional Installation Required:** The 240V electric cooktop does not come with a plug and requires professional hardwiring. Ensure installation is performed by a qualified electrician in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.
- **Residual Heat Indicator:** The cooktop is equipped with a residual heat indicator. This light will remain on until the surface glass has cooled to a safe temperature, even after the burner has been turned off. Avoid touching the cooktop surface when this indicator is lit.
- **Overheating Protection:** The appliance features an over-temperature protection system that automatically powers off the cooktop if it overheats, preventing damage and ensuring safety.
- **Electromagnetic Radiation:** Unlike induction models, this radiant ceramic electric cooktop emits no electromagnetic radiation, providing a safe cooking environment for all users.
- **Cookware Compatibility:** Use only cookware suitable for electric radiant cooktops. Ensure pots and pans have flat bottoms to maximize heat transfer and stability.

- **Knob Controls:** Easy-to-use ergonomic knobs provide intuitive control over each burner, ideal for users of all ages, including seniors and those with limited vision.
- **9 Power Levels:** Each of the five radiant burners offers 9 adjustable heat settings, allowing precise temperature control for various cooking needs, from simmering to rapid boiling.
- **High Power Output:** With a total power output of 8400W, this cooktop heats up quickly, saving time and efficiently handling multi-person meals.
- **Durable Black Matte Glass:** The sleek black ceramic glass surface is heat-resistant, scratch-resistant, and easy to clean, complementing any kitchen decor.
- **Versatile Cookware Compatibility:** Works with almost all types of cookware, including aluminum, copper, cast iron, and stainless steel pots and pans.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Karinear electric cooktop is designed for built-in installation. Proper installation is crucial for safety and optimal performance. It must be hardwired by a qualified professional.

Electrical Requirements:

- **Electrical Supply:** 240V AC, 40 Amps
- **Wattage:** 8400 Watts
- **Wiring:** Hardwired connection required. No plug is included.

Dimensions and Cut-out Size:

- **Stovetop Size:** 35.43 inches (Width) x 20.47 inches (Depth)
- **Cut-out Size:** 34 inches (Width) x 19.3 inches (Depth) x 3 inches (Height)
- The cutout size of the cabinet needs to be slightly larger than the bottom size of the product and smaller than the size of the glass top to ensure proper installation.

The cooktop itself measures 35.43 inches in width, 20.47 inches in depth, and 3 inches in height. The required cut-out for the countertop is 34 inches in width and 19.3 inches in depth. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Karinear electric cooktop features intuitive knob controls for easy operation.

Using the Control Knobs:

- Each knob corresponds to a specific burner. Refer to the markings next to the knobs to identify which burner they control. The position corresponding to the dot next to the knob indicates the position of the burner.
- To activate a burner, push down and turn the corresponding knob to the desired power level (from Min to Max). There are 9 distinct power levels.
- To turn off a burner, turn the knob back to the "OFF" position.

Burner Operation Note:

The electric ceramic burner does not stay red continuously. It turns red cyclically to maintain the set temperature. The higher the power level, the more frequently it will turn red. This is normal operation and not a malfunction.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your cooktop.

Daily Cleaning:

- Always allow the cooktop surface to cool completely before cleaning. The residual heat indicator light will turn off when it is safe to touch.
- For light spills and daily cleaning, wipe the smooth glass surface with a damp cloth and mild dish soap.
- Dry the surface thoroughly with a clean, soft cloth to prevent water spots.

Stubborn Stains:

- For baked-on food or stubborn stains, use a ceramic cooktop cleaner and a non-abrasive cleaning pad or the provided scraper. Follow the cleaner manufacturer's instructions.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals, as these can scratch or damage the glass surface.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Karinear electric cooktop.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not stay red continuously.	Normal operation for ceramic radiant burners.	This is not a malfunction. The burner cycles on and off to maintain the set temperature. The frequency of cycling increases with higher power levels.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooktop not turning on.	No power supply; improper wiring; circuit breaker tripped.	Check if the circuit breaker has tripped. Ensure the cooktop is properly hardwired by a qualified electrician. If issues persist, contact a professional.
Cooktop surface is hot after turning off.	Residual heat from cooking.	This is normal. The residual heat indicator light will remain on until the surface has cooled down. Do not touch the surface until the light is off.
