INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use and maintenance of your CASIO GBA-950 G-SHOCK watch. Designed for urban sports and daily training, this analog-digital timepiece features Bluetooth connectivity, a stopwatch, countdown timer, dual time, and an alarm function. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

SETUP

1. Initial Time Setting

Your GBA-950 watch can be set manually or synchronized via Bluetooth with your smartphone for accurate timekeeping. For initial setup, it is recommended to use the Bluetooth connection.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Download the official G-SHOCK Connected app on your smartphone.

2. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone.
3. On the watch, press and hold the **MODE** button (usually bottom left) until the Bluetooth indicator appears on the digital display.
4. Open the G-SHOCK Connected app and follow the on-screen instructions to pair your watch.
5. Once paired, the watch will automatically adjust its time and date settings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mode Navigation

Press the **MODE** button (bottom left) to cycle through different functions: Timekeeping, Stopwatch, Countdown Timer, Alarm, Dual Time, and Step Tracker.

2. Timekeeping Mode

- The analog hands display the current time.
- The digital display shows the date, day of the week, and seconds.
- To adjust time manually, refer to the detailed instructions in the full user manual available online.

3. Stopwatch Function

- Navigate to the Stopwatch mode using the **MODE** button.
- Press the **START** button (bottom right) to begin timing.
- Press **START** again to stop.
- Press the **LAP** button (top right) to record lap times.

4. Step Tracker

The GBA-950 includes a step tracker to monitor your daily activity. The digital display will show your current step count. An indicator on the watch face (often marked MAX/MIN) may show your progress towards a daily step goal.

5. Illumination

Press the **LIGHT** button (top left, often labeled DISP) to illuminate the watch face for visibility in low-light conditions. The analog hands and hour markers feature a luminous coating for enhanced readability.

MAINTENANCE

1. Water Resistance

The GBA-950 is water-resistant up to 20 bars (200 meters). This means it is suitable for showering, swimming, and shallow diving. **Do not operate buttons while the watch is submerged in water.** Avoid exposing the watch to hot water or steam, as this can compromise the seals.

2. Cleaning

Wipe the watch regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and moisture. For stubborn grime, use a mild soap solution and a soft brush, then rinse thoroughly with fresh water and dry completely. Avoid using chemical cleaners or solvents.

3. Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement, requiring a specific watch battery. When the battery runs low, the display may dim or functions may become erratic. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by an authorized CASIO service center to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bluetooth Synchronization Issues:** If the watch fails to sync with your smartphone, ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices and the G-SHOCK Connected app is running. Try restarting both the watch (by removing and reinserting the battery, if accessible, or performing a factory reset if available) and your phone. Re-pair the devices if necessary.
- **Digital Display Readability:** The negative digital display on this model can be challenging to read in certain lighting conditions, particularly indoors. Ensure adequate lighting when attempting to read the digital display. The analog hands and luminous markers are designed for primary time reading.
- **Incorrect Time/Date:** If the time or date is incorrect, attempt to re-sync with the G-SHOCK Connected app. If the issue persists, manually adjust the time and date settings as per the full user manual.
