Canopy Nursery Humidifier 2.0 Instruction Manual

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INTRODUCTION

The Canopy Nursery Humidifier 2.0 is designed to optimize your living space by maintaining ideal humidity levels. This device features an updated proprietary filter, a quieter fan system, white noise settings, sleep and reading lights, and enhanced aroma diffusion. It is engineered to hydrate skin, alleviate symptoms of dryness, and provide a calming environment. The humidifier utilizes an evaporative technology with a multi-stage filter to ensure clean, mist-free moisture without leaving residue.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Verify that all components are present in the packaging:

- Canopy Nursery Humidifier 2.0 Unit
- Proprietary Filter
- Power Cable and Adapter
- Aroma Diffusion Puck (may include initial aroma oil)

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Canopy Nursery Humidifier 2.0:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging.
2. **Place the Humidifier:** Position the humidifier on a flat, stable surface in the desired room. Ensure it is not directly against a wall or on a surface that could be damaged by moisture.
3. **Remove Water Tank:** Gently lift the water tank from the base of the humidifier.
4. **Fill Water Tank:** Unscrew the cap from the bottom of the water tank. Fill the tank with tap water. Distilled water is not required as the humidifier's filter system handles impurities. Securely screw the cap back on.
5. **Insert Filter:** Place the proprietary filter into the designated slot in the humidifier base. Ensure it is seated correctly.
6. **Reattach Water Tank:** Place the filled water tank back onto the base, ensuring it aligns properly.
7. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the humidifier and then into a wall outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the humidifier's controls for optimal use:

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button (usually indicated by a circle with a vertical line) to turn the humidifier on or off.
2. **Adjust Fan Speed:** Cycle through fan speeds (Low, Medium, High) by pressing the fan speed button. An 'Auto'

mode is also available, which adjusts output based on ambient light.

3. **Night Light Function:** Activate the night light feature by pressing the light button. You can cycle through different light shades and dimness levels.
4. **White Noise Feature:** Select a white noise setting by pressing the dedicated white noise button. Multiple volume levels are available.
5. **Aroma Diffusion:** Place a few drops of essential oil onto the aroma diffusion puck located on the top of the unit. The fan will gently circulate the scent throughout the room.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and filter replacement are crucial for optimal performance and hygiene:

1. **Dishwasher Safe Parts:** The water tank, tray, grill, spacer, and cap are dishwasher safe. Place them on the top rack for easy cleaning.
2. **Manual Cleaning:** For parts not suitable for the dishwasher, wipe them down with a damp cloth. The large tank opening allows for easy manual cleaning of the interior.
3. **Filter Replacement:** The proprietary filter should be replaced every 6-8 weeks, or when the filter indicator light illuminates. The best way to tell if your filter needs changing is by looking or feeling it; if it's turned crunchy or hardened, it's time for a new one.
4. **Dry Run Cycle:** Allow the humidifier to run until completely dry between refills to prevent unwanted build-up and maintain cleanliness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to these common issues and solutions:

- **No Mist Coming from the Unit:** The Canopy Humidifier uses evaporative technology, which disperses mist-free vapor into the air. Unlike ultrasonic humidifiers, it does not produce a visible mist. This is normal operation.
- **Filter Change Indicator Light:** The light labeled 'Filter' on the top of your humidifier will illuminate when it's time to replace your filter. Hold the 'On/Off' button for 30 seconds after inserting a new filter to reset the indicator light.
- **Low Water Indicator:** If the water refill indicator light is on, the water tank is empty. Refill the tank as per the setup instructions.
