INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Lenovo V15 (83CC0053IN) laptop. Please read this document thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the lifespan of your device.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that the following items are present:

- Lenovo V15 Laptop

- Power Adapter
- User Manual (this document)

2. Connecting to Power

Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power input port and then plug the adapter into a grounded electrical outlet. The battery will begin charging automatically.

3. Initial Boot

Press the power button located on the keyboard deck to turn on the laptop. Since the laptop comes with DOS, you will need to install an operating system (e.g., Windows, Linux) to utilize its full functionality. Follow the on-screen prompts or your chosen operating system's installation guide.

OPERATING THE LAPTOP

Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press the power button.
- **Power Off:** From your operating system, select the shutdown option. Alternatively, press and hold the power button for several seconds for a forced shutdown (use only when necessary).

Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features a 6-row, spill-resistant keyboard with multimedia Fn keys and a numeric keypad. The buttonless Mylar surface multi-touch touchpad supports Precision TouchPad gestures.

Connecting External Devices

The Lenovo V15 offers various ports for connecting peripherals:

- **USB Ports:** 1x USB 2.0, 1x USB 3.2 Gen 1, 1x USB-C 3.2 Gen 1 (supports data transfer, Power Delivery (20V only), and DisplayPort 1.2).
- **HDMI:** 1x HDMI 1.4b for connecting to external displays.
- **Ethernet:** 1x RJ-45 port for wired network connection.
- **Audio:** 1x Headphone/microphone combo jack (3.5mm).

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Laptop

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display.
- For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Ensure the laptop is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

Battery Care

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Store the laptop in a cool, dry place if not used for extended periods.
- Do not expose the battery to extreme temperatures.

Storage

When storing the laptop, especially for long durations, ensure it is turned off and disconnected from power. Protect it from dust and extreme environmental conditions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Lenovo V15 laptop.

No Power

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working electrical outlet.
- Verify the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- If the battery is completely drained, allow it to charge for a few minutes before attempting to power on.

Display Issues

- If the screen is blank, try adjusting the display brightness using the keyboard function keys.
- If an external monitor is connected, ensure the display output is correctly configured (e.g., duplicate, extend).
- Restart the laptop.

Peripheral Not Detected

- Ensure the peripheral is correctly plugged into the appropriate port.
- Try connecting the peripheral to a different port or another device to confirm its functionality.
- Restart the laptop.
