# Sharp SJ-UD135T2S-EU 135L Refrigerator User Manual

MODEL: SJ-UD135T2S-EU

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Sharp SJ-UD135T2S-EU 135L Refrigerator. Please read these instructions carefully before installation, operation, or maintenance. Keep this manual for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety and the safety of others are paramount. Follow all safety precautions to prevent injury or damage.

### General Safety

- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Do not allow children to play with the appliance. Supervision is necessary when children are near.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the appliance to prevent overheating.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- The appliance uses R600a refrigerant, which is flammable. Handle with care during transport and installation to avoid damage to the cooling circuit.

### Electrical Safety

- Connect the appliance to a properly grounded power outlet.
- Do not use extension cords or ungrounded adapters.
- Do not pull the power cord to disconnect the appliance. Always grasp the plug firmly.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Sharp refrigerator.

**Key Components:**

- **Adjustable Shelves:** For flexible storage of various food items.

- **Door Bins:** Ideal for bottles, jars, and smaller items.
- **Fruit and Vegetable Drawer:** Designed to maintain optimal humidity for produce.
- **Mechanical Temperature Control:** Dial for adjusting the internal temperature.
- **LED Interior Lighting:** Provides clear visibility of contents.

## **4. SETUP**

### **4.1 Unpacking**

- Remove all packaging materials, including foam and adhesive tape.
- Inspect the appliance for any transport damage. Report any damage to your retailer immediately.
- Keep packaging materials out of reach of children.

### **4.2 Placement**

- Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface.
- Ensure adequate air circulation around the appliance. Leave at least 10 cm (4 inches) of space at the back and sides, and 30 cm (12 inches) at the top.
- Avoid placing the refrigerator in direct sunlight or near heat sources such as stoves, radiators, or heaters.
- Do not install the appliance in areas with high humidity.

### **4.3 Leveling**

Adjust the leveling feet at the bottom front of the appliance to ensure it is stable and level. A level appliance operates more efficiently and prevents door alignment issues.

## 4.4 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator with a mild detergent and warm water. Wipe dry thoroughly.

## 4.5 Electrical Connection

- Allow the refrigerator to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
- Plug the appliance into a dedicated, grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not overload the circuit with other appliances.

# 5. OPERATING

---

## 5.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features a mechanical temperature control dial located inside the compartment. Turn the dial to adjust the cooling intensity:

- **'Min' setting:** Less cooling.
- **'Max' setting:** More cooling.

For general use, a medium setting is usually sufficient. Adjust as needed based on ambient temperature and the amount of food stored.

## 5.2 Food Storage Guidelines

- Store cooked foods and dairy products on upper shelves.
- Raw meat and fish should be stored on the lowest shelf to prevent dripping onto other foods.
- Use the fruit and vegetable drawer for fresh produce to maintain its freshness.
- Ensure all food is covered to prevent drying out and odor transfer.
- Do not place hot food directly into the refrigerator; allow it to cool down first.

## 5.3 LED Interior Lighting

The refrigerator is equipped with energy-efficient LED lighting that illuminates automatically when the door is opened.

# 6. MAINTENANCE

---

## 6.1 Cleaning

- **Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.**
- Clean the interior regularly with a solution of mild detergent and warm water. Rinse and dry thoroughly.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Clean the door seals with warm water to ensure they remain flexible and seal properly.
- Dust the condenser coils at the back of the appliance periodically (if accessible) to maintain efficiency.

## 6.2 Defrosting (Manual)

This refrigerator features a manual defrosting system. Frost buildup on the interior walls can reduce cooling efficiency. Defrost the appliance when the frost layer reaches approximately 5 mm (0.2 inches) thick.

1. Unplug the refrigerator from the power outlet.

- 2. Remove all food items and store them in a cool place.
- 3. Leave the door open to allow the frost to melt naturally. Place towels at the bottom to absorb water.
- 4. Once defrosted, clean and dry the interior thoroughly.
- 5. Plug the refrigerator back in and allow it to cool down before returning food.

6.3 Power Outage

In case of a power outage, keep the refrigerator door closed to maintain the internal temperature for as long as possible. Avoid opening the door unnecessarily.

6.4 Vacation Care

- **Short Vacations:** Leave the refrigerator operating.
- **Long Vacations:** Unplug the appliance, empty all food, clean the interior thoroughly, and leave the door slightly ajar to prevent odors and mold growth.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting service, check the following common issues and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator does not operate.	No power supply.	Check if the plug is properly inserted and the power outlet is working.
Temperature is not cold enough.	Temperature setting is too high; door opened too frequently; too much food stored; poor ventilation.	Adjust temperature control to a colder setting; avoid frequent door openings; ensure proper air circulation.
Unusual noises.	Appliance is not level; objects touching the back wall; normal operating sounds.	Adjust leveling feet; ensure nothing is touching the appliance; gurgling/humming sounds are normal for refrigerant circulation.
Water on the floor.	Drain hole blocked; drip tray overflowing during defrost.	Clear the drain hole; ensure drip tray is correctly positioned and emptied if full.

If the problem persists after checking these points, contact qualified service personnel.
