INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your headphones. Connect the magnetic charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.


- A full charge takes approximately 1.5-2 hours.
- The LED indicator will show charging status (e.g., red for charging, blue for fully charged).

2. Bluetooth Pairing (Wireless Mode)

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power/Multi-function button until the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for "BDAMX-7FXH" or similar.
4. Select the headphones from the list to connect. Once connected, the LED will flash blue slowly.

3. MP3 Mode Setup (For Underwater Use)

The headphones feature 32GB of built-in storage for MP3 mode, essential for underwater listening as Bluetooth signals do not transmit through water.

1. Connect the headphones to your computer using the provided charging cable.
2. The headphones will appear as a removable disk drive.
3. Drag and drop your desired MP3 audio files into the headphone's storage folder.
4. Safely eject the headphones from your computer once files are transferred.

Important: Always switch to MP3 mode when swimming or engaging in other underwater activities.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Controls Overview

The headphones feature intuitive button controls for various functions.

Power/Multi-function Button (Short Press)	Play/Pause Music, Answer/End Call
Volume Up (+) (Short Press)	Increase Volume
Volume Up (+) (Long Press)	Next Track
Volume Down (-) (Short Press)	Decrease Volume
Volume Down (-) (Long Press)	Previous Track
Mode Switch Button (if present, or specific button combination)	Switch between Bluetooth and MP3 Mode

Note: Specific button locations and exact functions may vary slightly. Refer to the physical product for precise button identification.

Wearing the Headphones

Position the bone conduction transducers on your cheekbones, just in front of your ears. The band should rest comfortably behind your head. Adjust for a secure and comfortable fit.

Making and Receiving Calls

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the Power/Multi-function button.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Power/Multi-function button.
- **Voice Assistant:** Double-press the Power/Multi-function button (functionality depends on connected device).

The Environmental Noise Cancellation (ENC) technology helps ensure clear calls even in noisy environments.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the headphones with a soft, damp cloth after each use, especially after swimming or intense workouts.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the charging port is dry before connecting the charging cable.

Storage

- Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the headphones to prevent damage to the flexible frame.

Waterproofing Notes

- The headphones are rated IPX8, meaning they can be submerged in water up to two meters deep for one hour.
- For optimal performance and to prevent damage, always use MP3 mode when underwater. Bluetooth signals cannot transmit effectively in water.
- Rinse with fresh water after use in chlorinated or saltwater environments.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Headphones won't turn on.	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to the charger and check the LED indicator.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red and blue).◦ Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.◦ Move headphones closer to your device.◦ Forget the device in your phone's Bluetooth settings and try pairing again.
No sound in MP3 mode.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure you have uploaded MP3 files to the headphones.◦ Check the volume level.◦ Confirm the headphones are in MP3 mode.
Sound quality is poor or distorted.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Adjust the position of the transducers on your cheekbones.◦ Ensure the volume is not too high, causing distortion.◦ For Bluetooth, reduce distance to the paired device and minimize interference.
Headphones not recognized by computer.	Try a different USB port or cable. Ensure the cable is securely connected.
