INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Intex Dura-Beam Standard Prestige Air Mattress. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use, setup, operation, and maintenance of your air mattress. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Important: Always refer to the packaging for specific safety warnings and instructions. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Do not overinflate the air mattress.
- Keep away from sharp objects and heat sources.
- Ensure the area is clear of debris before inflation and use.
- This product is not a toy. Keep children supervised around the air mattress.
- Do not jump on the air mattress.

SETUP AND INITIAL INFLATION

Follow these steps for proper setup and initial inflation of your Intex Dura-Beam air mattress:

1. Unpack the air mattress and lay it flat on a clean, level surface, free from sharp objects.
2. Locate the built-in USB electric pump.
3. Connect the USB pump to a 5V USB-A power source rated 2 Amp or higher (e.g., phone charger, 12V USB car charger, or portable battery). *Note: Power source is not included.*

4. Turn the pump dial to the "Inflate" position. The mattress will begin to inflate.
5. Inflate until the mattress is firm to the touch. Do not overinflate.
6. Turn the pump dial to the "Off" position once inflated.

Important Note on Material Stretch: At first inflation, the material of the air mattress will stretch. This is a normal characteristic and is sometimes misinterpreted as a leak. You may sense a loss of pressure; this is simply the bed stretching. Simply re-inflate the bed again as needed. The bed will fully settle within 2-3 nights of use.

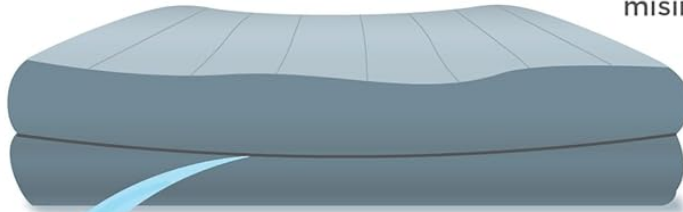

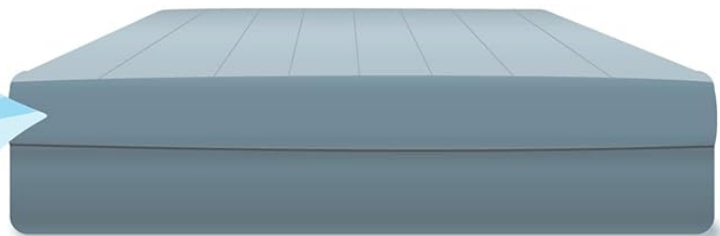

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Intex Dura-Beam air mattress is straightforward:

- **Inflation:** To inflate, connect the USB pump to a power source and turn the dial to "Inflate".
- **Deflation:** To deflate, turn the pump dial to the "Deflate" position. The pump will actively remove air from the

mattress.

- **Comfort Adjustment:** You can adjust the firmness of the mattress by adding or removing small amounts of air using the pump.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity of your air mattress:

- **Cleaning:** The velvety sleeping surface is easy to clean. Use a damp cloth and mild soap to wipe down the surface. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Drying:** Ensure the mattress is completely dry before folding and storing to prevent mold or mildew.
- **Storage:** Deflate the mattress completely. Fold or roll it neatly and store it in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keep it away from pets and rodents.
- **Puncture Prevention:** Avoid placing the mattress on rough or uneven surfaces. Keep sharp objects away from the mattress.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mattress seems to be losing air / feels soft after initial inflation.	Material stretching (normal for new airbeds).	Re-inflate the mattress. The material will settle within 2-3 nights of use. This is not a leak.
Pump not working.	No power or insufficient power source.	Ensure the USB power source is 5V USB-A rated 2 Amp or higher and is properly connected. Try a different power source.
Mattress is not firm enough.	Under-inflated.	Add more air using the built-in pump until desired firmness is achieved.
Mattress is too firm.	Over-inflated.	Slightly deflate the mattress using the pump until desired comfort is achieved.

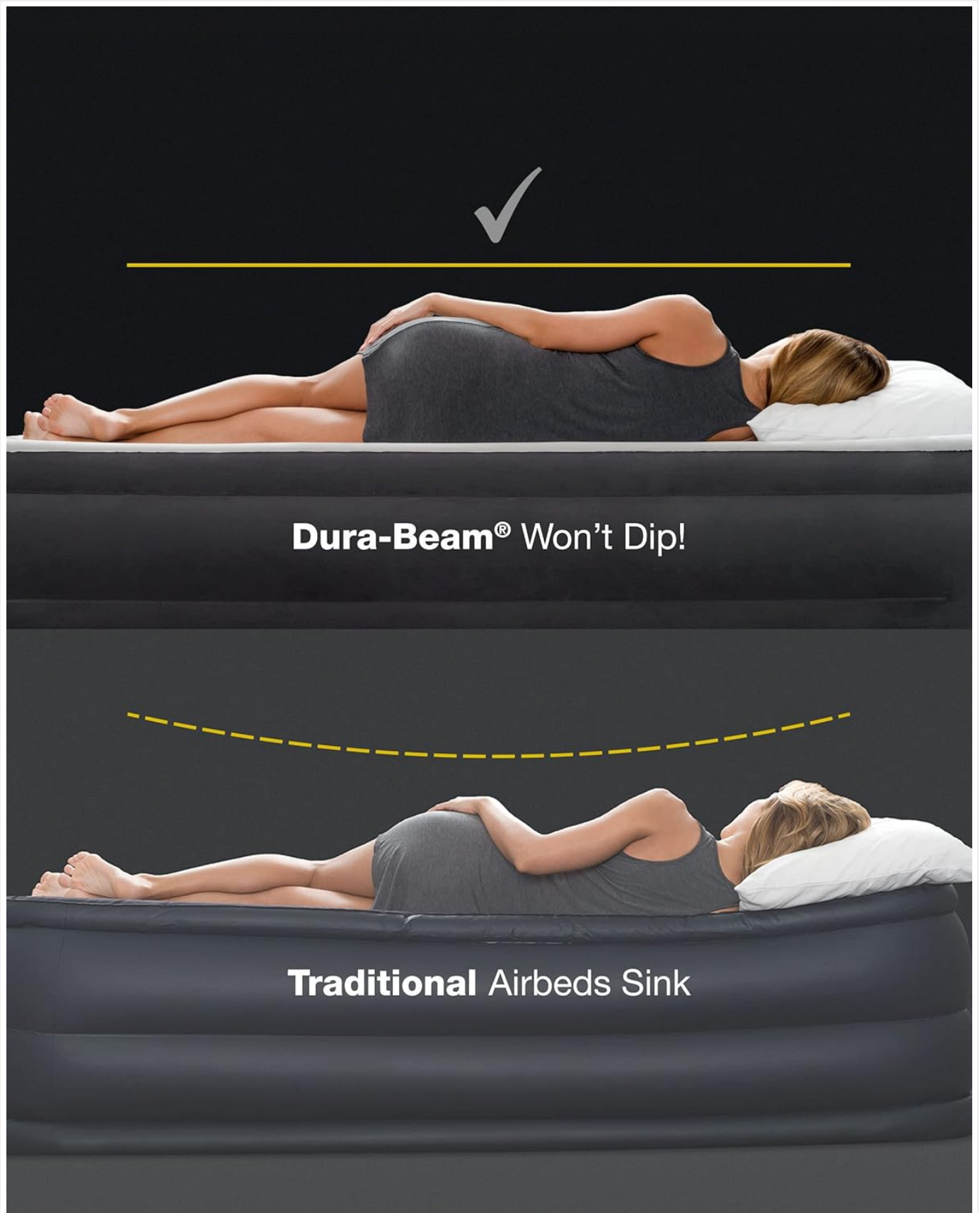


Image: Demonstrates how Dura-Beam construction prevents sagging compared to traditional airbeds.

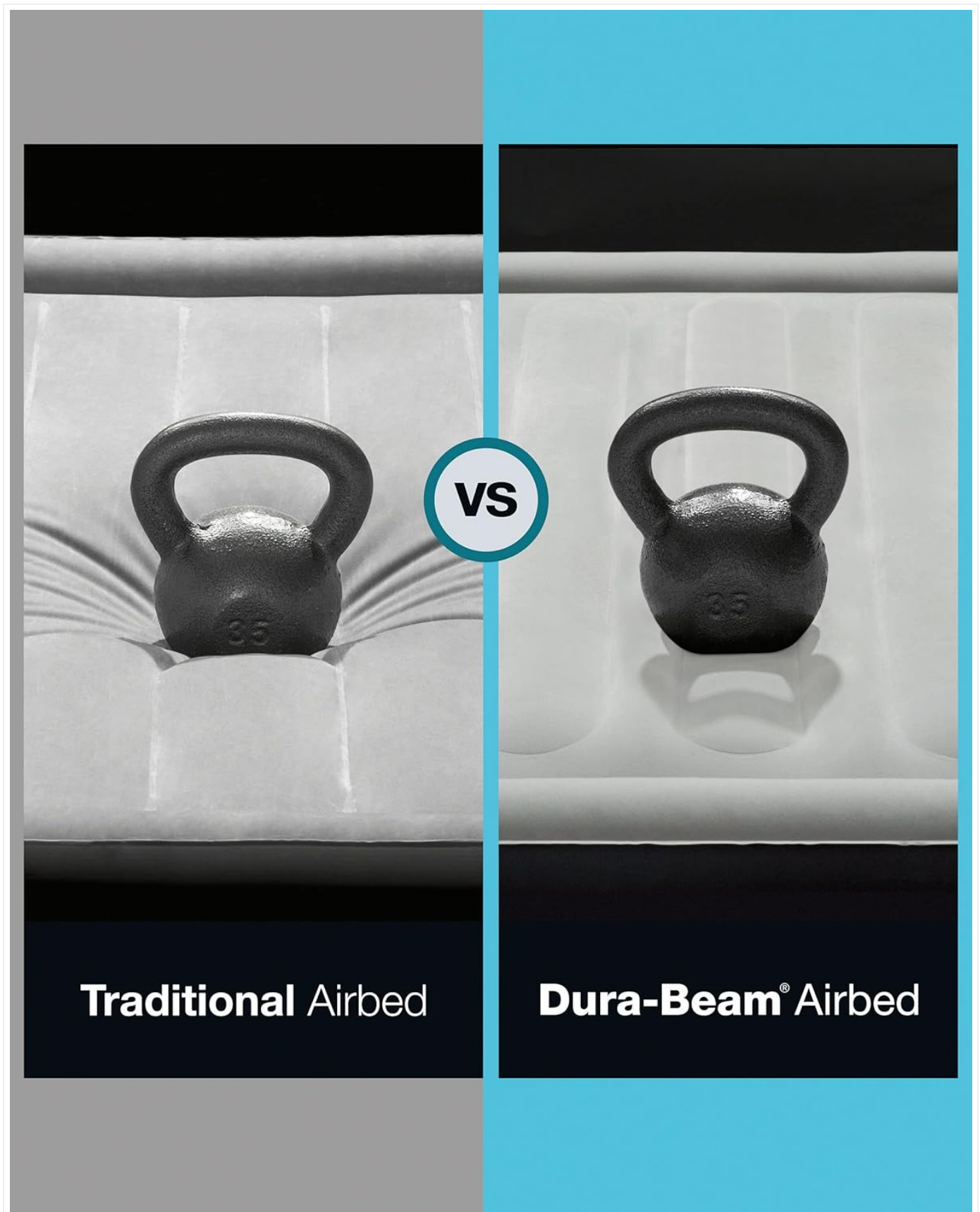


Image: Visual comparison of weight distribution and support between traditional and Dura-Beam airbeds.

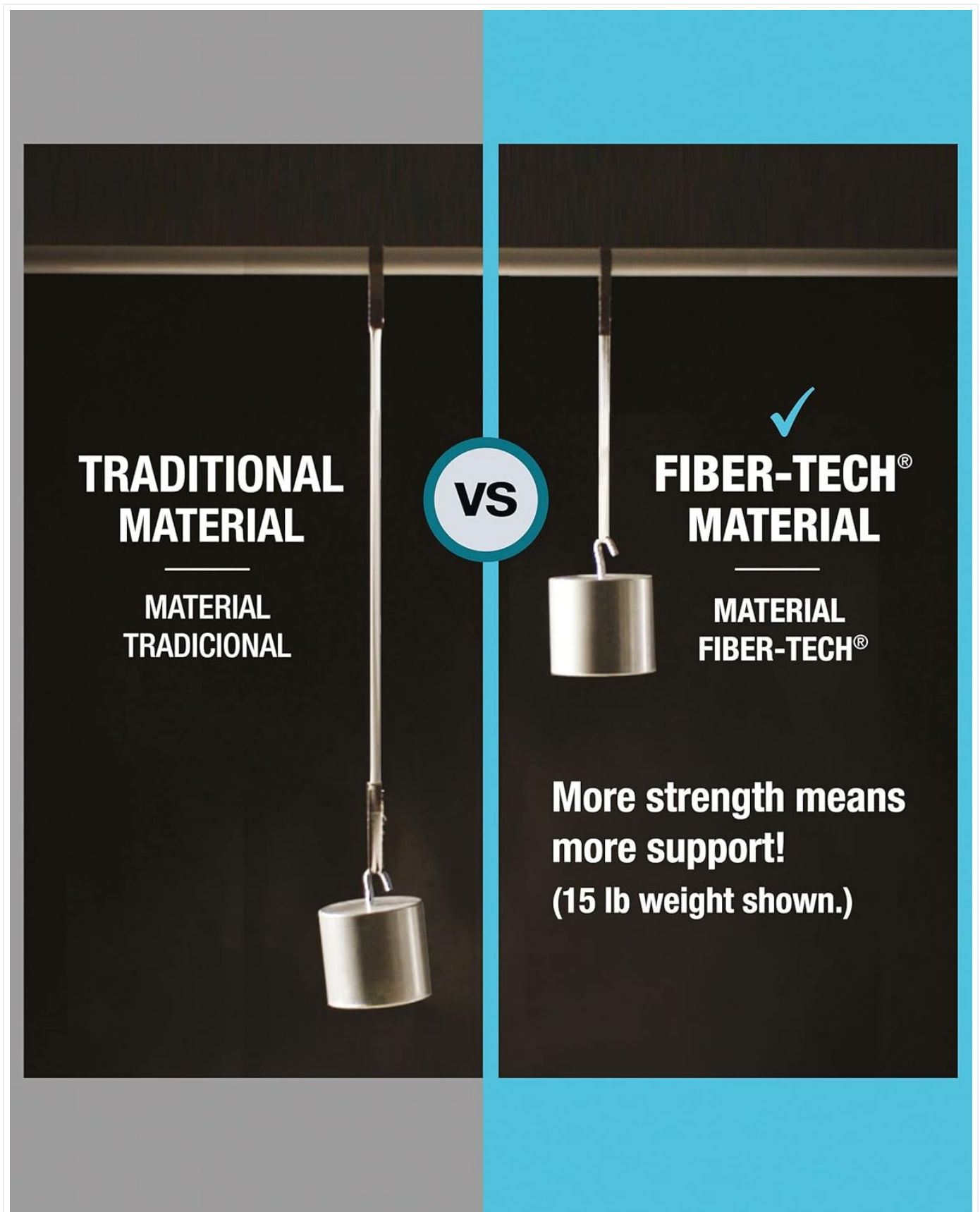


Image: Illustrates the superior strength and support of Fiber-Tech material compared to traditional materials.
