1. INTRODUCTION

Adjust your seat for optimal driving position, ensuring you can comfortably reach the pedals and steering wheel. Lumbar support and seat height adjustments are available on certain models. Always adjust seats when the vehicle is stationary.

3.4. Steering Wheel Adjustment

The steering wheel can be adjusted for tilt and telescopic position. Adjust it to a comfortable position that allows clear visibility of the instrument cluster. Ensure it is locked in place before driving.

4. OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

4.1. Starting and Stopping the Engine

For push-button start models, ensure the brake pedal is depressed before pressing the START/STOP button. For key ignition models, insert the key and turn to the START position. Follow the specific instructions in your manual for cold weather starting procedures.

4.2. Driving Modes

Your Tucson may feature various driving modes (e.g., Normal, Sport, Eco, Smart, Snow). Select the appropriate mode based on driving conditions and desired performance. Each mode adjusts engine, transmission, and steering characteristics.

4.3. Infotainment System

The infotainment system provides access to radio, media, navigation, and vehicle settings. Connect your smartphone via Apple CarPlay or Android Auto for integrated functionality. Refer to the separate infotainment manual for detailed instructions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine will not start	Dead battery, empty fuel tank, faulty starter.	Check battery terminals, add fuel, or contact roadside assistance.
Warning light illuminated	System malfunction, low fluid level.	Consult the manual for specific light meaning; check fluid levels. If persistent, seek professional service.
Tires losing pressure	Puncture, valve stem leak, temperature changes.	Inspect tires for damage, reinflate to correct pressure. Repair or replace damaged tires.
Brakes squealing	Worn brake pads, rust on rotors, foreign object.	Have brakes inspected by a qualified technician.
