
1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This product is a replacement ice maker module designed for specific Frigidaire refrigerator models. It is crucial to verify compatibility before installation.

3. COMPATIBILITY

This replacement ice maker (Model: Fricpart-023796) is specifically designed for the Frigidaire Refrigerator Model LFHB2751TF5. Appliance parts can appear similar, so always confirm your refrigerator's model number before proceeding with installation to ensure proper fit and function.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of this replacement ice maker requires basic tools and mechanical aptitude. If you are uncomfortable performing this repair, please seek professional assistance.

Preliminary Steps:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Unplug the refrigerator from the electrical outlet or turn off the circuit breaker supplying power to the refrigerator.
2. **Access Ice Maker:** Locate the existing ice maker compartment inside your freezer. This typically involves removing the ice bucket and any cover panels.
3. **Remove Old Ice Maker:** Carefully disconnect any wiring harnesses and water lines from the old ice maker. Unscrew or unclip the old ice maker from its mounting brackets. Note the orientation and connections for reassembly.

Installation Steps:

4. **Install New Ice Maker:** Position the new Fricpart-023796 ice maker in the same location and orientation as the old unit. Secure it with the original screws or clips.
5. **Connect Wiring and Water Line:** Reconnect the wiring harness(es) to the new ice maker. Ensure all connections are secure. Reattach the water fill tube, if applicable.
6. **Replace Covers:** Reinstall any cover panels and the ice bucket.

7. **Restore Power:** Plug the refrigerator back into the electrical outlet or turn on the circuit breaker.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

After installation, the ice maker will begin its cycle automatically. It may take several hours for the first batch of ice to be produced, and up to 24 hours for full ice production to stabilize.

- **Initial Fill:** The ice maker will fill with water and then freeze it. You may hear water filling sounds.
- **First Batches:** Discard the first two to three batches of ice to ensure any air or impurities from the new installation are flushed out.
- **Ice Production:** The ice maker will continue to produce ice until the ice bucket is full, at which point the shut-off arm or sensor will stop production.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure optimal performance and longevity of your ice maker.

- **Clean Ice Bucket:** Periodically empty and wash the ice bucket with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Check Water Filter:** If your refrigerator has a water filter, ensure it is replaced according to the manufacturer's recommendations to prevent mineral buildup in the ice maker.
- **Inspect Water Line:** Occasionally check the water supply line for kinks or leaks.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ice maker, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No ice production	Refrigerator not connected to water supply; water valve off; clogged water filter; ice maker switch off; freezer temperature too high.	Ensure water supply is connected and valve is open. Replace water filter. Check if ice maker power switch is ON. Verify freezer temperature is set to 0°F (-18°C) or lower.
Small or hollow ice cubes	Low water pressure; clogged water filter; partially frozen fill tube.	Check water supply pressure. Replace water filter. Thaw fill tube if frozen (disconnect power first).
Ice tastes bad or has odor	Old ice; dirty ice bucket; strong odors in freezer; old water filter.	Discard old ice. Clean ice bucket. Remove strong-smelling foods or seal them properly. Replace water filter.
