1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MAHANCRIIS Guitar Stand. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new guitar rack holder. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

This product is designed to securely hold multiple string instruments, including acoustic guitars, electric guitars, bass guitars, ukuleles, banjos, and mandolins. It features a sturdy frame and protective padding to ensure the safety of your instruments.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Regularly check for loose screws or damaged parts and address them promptly.
- Utilize the provided anti-tip kit if placing the stand against a wall, especially in households with children or pets.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (SETUP)

Follow these steps to assemble your MAHANCRIIS Guitar Stand. It is recommended to assemble on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and verify against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Base Frame:** Connect the base frame pieces using the provided screws. Ensure all connections are snug but do not overtighten initially.
3. **Attach Vertical Supports:** Secure the vertical support bars to the base frame.
4. **Install Instrument Supports:** Attach the EVA-padded instrument supports to the frame at the designated heights. These supports are crucial for protecting your instruments.
5. **Place Top Shelf:** Position the engineered wood top shelf onto the upper frame, securing it with screws if applicable.
6. **Adjust Feet:** If not pre-installed, screw in the adjustable feet at the bottom of the stand. Adjust them to ensure the stand is level and stable on your floor.
7. **Secure with Anti-Tip Kit (Optional but Recommended):** If placing the stand against a wall, use the anti-tip kit to secure it, especially for the taller stand.
8. **Final Tightening:** Once fully assembled, go back and gently tighten all screws to ensure maximum stability.

5. USAGE (OPERATING)

The MAHANCRIS Guitar Stand is designed for versatile use, accommodating a wide range of string instruments. It comes as a set of two stands, offering different capacities and configurations.

5.1 Instrument Placement

- Gently place your instrument into the designated slots, ensuring the neck rests securely on the EVA-padded supports.
- The stand is compatible with acoustic guitars, electric guitars, bass guitars, banjos, mandolins, and ukuleles.
- For optimal stability, distribute instruments evenly across the stand.

5.2 Top Shelf Functionality

The integrated top shelf provides additional utility, suitable for placing small accessories such as tuners, picks, capos, or even a small amplifier or record player, as shown in the images.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame and wood surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Padding Care:** Inspect the EVA padding periodically for wear and tear. Ensure it remains intact to protect your instruments.
- **Hardware Check:** Every few months, check all screws and connections to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Store the stand in a stable environment, avoiding extreme temperature changes or high humidity, which can affect the wood and metal components.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stand is wobbly or unstable.	Loose screws; uneven floor; adjustable feet not properly set.	Tighten all assembly screws. Adjust the leveling feet until the stand is stable. Ensure the stand is on a flat surface.
Instruments slide or scratch.	Damaged or missing EVA padding; incorrect instrument placement.	Inspect EVA padding for damage; replace if necessary. Ensure instruments are placed correctly within the padded supports.
Difficulty assembling.	Missing parts; unclear instructions.	Refer to the "Package Contents" section to verify all parts are present. Review the "Assembly Instructions" carefully. Contact customer support if parts are missing or instructions are unclear.

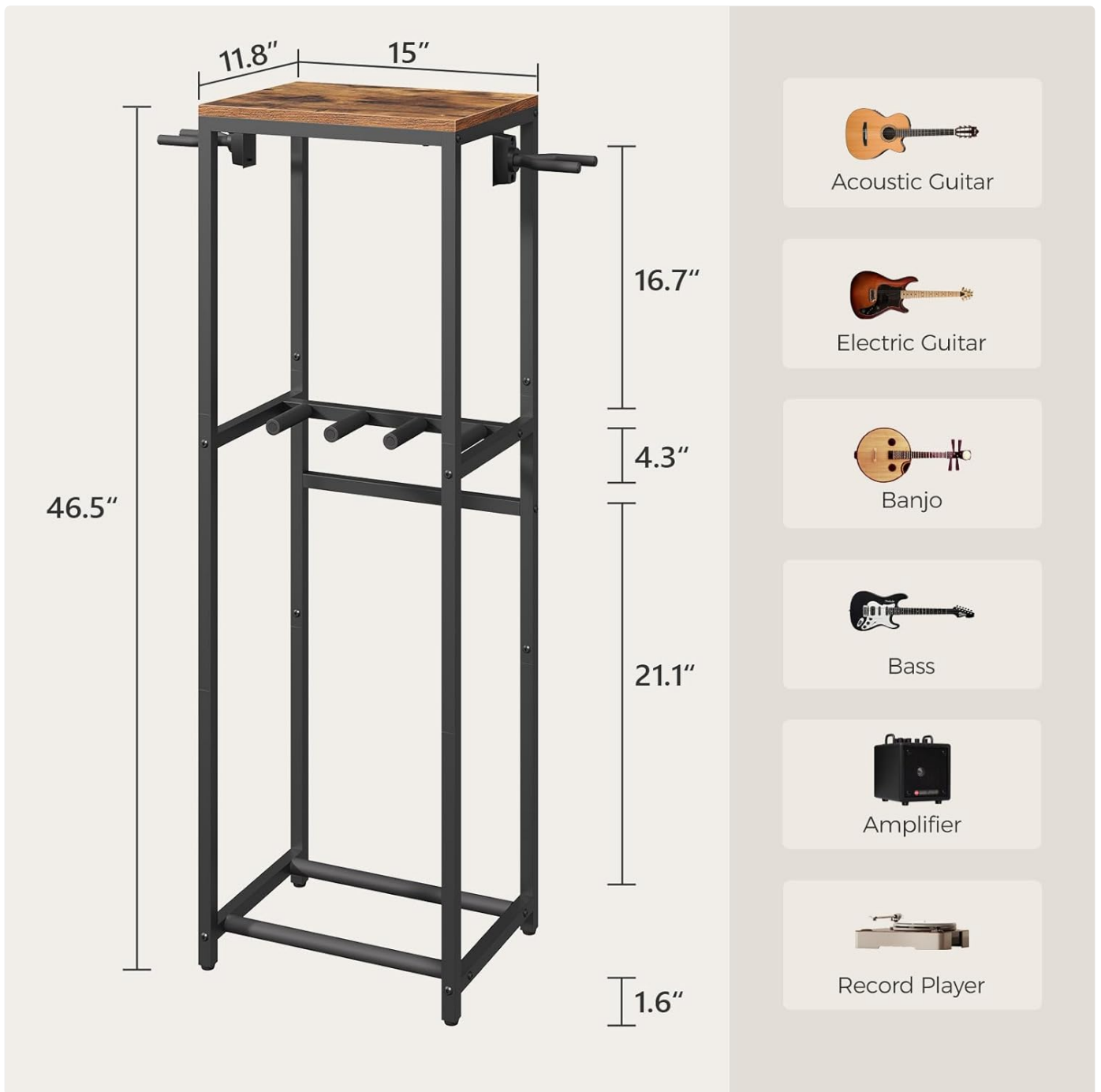


Image 8.1: Dimensions of the Smaller Guitar Stand.

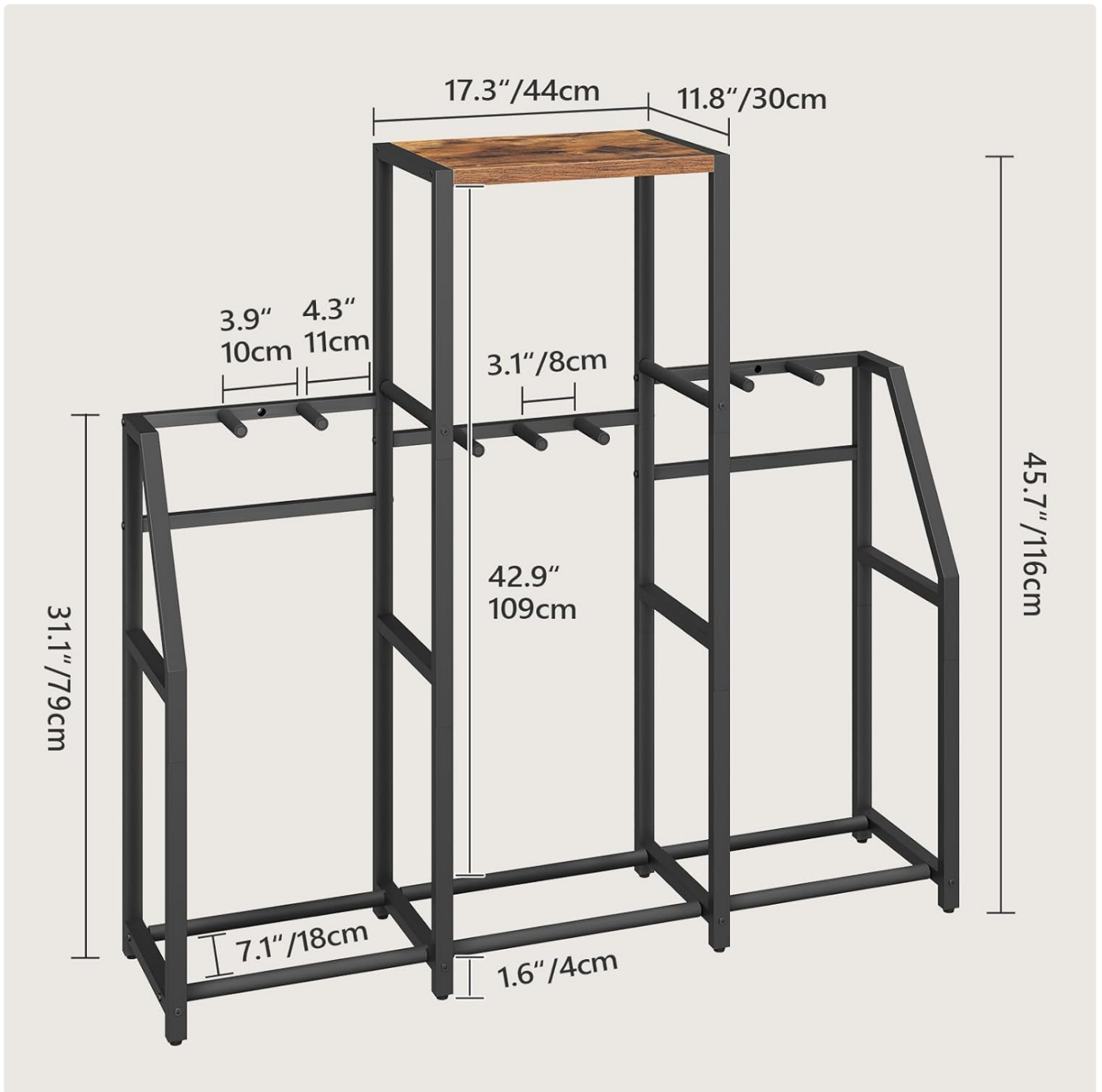


Image 8.2: Dimensions of the Larger Guitar Stand.
