1. Introduction

2. Setup and Installation

The Hart Crevice Tool is designed for easy attachment to your compatible vacuum cleaner hose or wand.

1. **Ensure Vacuum is Off:** Before attaching or detaching any accessories, always ensure your vacuum cleaner is turned off and unplugged from the power source to prevent accidental operation.
2. **Locate Attachment Point:** Identify the end of your vacuum's hose or wand where accessories are typically connected.
3. **Align and Insert:** Align the opening of the crevice tool with the attachment point on your vacuum. Gently push the crevice tool onto the hose or wand until it fits snugly. A secure connection is essential for optimal suction.
4. **Verify Connection:** Lightly tug on the crevice tool to ensure it is firmly attached and will not detach during use.

3. Operating Instructions

The crevice tool is ideal for cleaning hard-to-reach areas where standard vacuum heads cannot fit.

- **Target Areas:** Use the crevice tool for cleaning corners, edges, between couch cushions, car interiors, along baseboards, and other narrow gaps.
- **Angle of Approach:** Position the narrow end of the tool directly into the crevice or tight space. Move the tool slowly to allow the vacuum to effectively draw in dust and debris.
- **Persistent Debris:** For stubborn debris, a gentle back-and-forth or sweeping motion may be necessary.
- **Avoid Obstructions:** Be mindful of small objects that could be accidentally suctioned into the vacuum, potentially causing blockages or damage.

4. Maintenance and Care

Regular cleaning of your crevice tool will ensure its longevity and optimal performance.

1. **Detachment:** Turn off and unplug the vacuum. Carefully detach the crevice tool from the vacuum hose or wand.
2. **Inspect for Blockages:** Look inside the tool for any accumulated debris, lint, or larger objects that might be obstructing airflow.
3. **Clear Blockages:** If a blockage is present, use a thin, non-sharp object (like a straightened coat hanger or a long brush) to gently push the obstruction out. *Do not use sharp objects that could damage the tool.*
4. **Washing:** The crevice tool can be washed with mild soap and lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
5. **Drying:** Allow the tool to air dry completely before reattaching it to the vacuum or storing it. Ensure no moisture remains inside.
6. **Storage:** Store the crevice tool in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.

5. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Suction	Tool not securely attached; Blockage in tool or vacuum hose.	Ensure tool is firmly attached. Inspect and clear any blockages in the tool or vacuum hose. Check vacuum's dustbin/bag and filters.
Tool Falls Off During Use	Improper attachment; Worn attachment point.	Reattach the tool firmly. If the attachment point is worn, consider replacing the tool or consulting your vacuum's manual for alternative attachment methods.
