1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Horavie Single Serve Coffee Maker. This versatile machine is designed to provide a convenient and high-quality coffee experience, allowing you to brew both K-Cup pods and ground coffee. With multiple brew sizes and options for hot, strong, or iced coffee, it caters to various preferences. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure proper use, maintenance, and safety.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always unplug the coffee maker from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Use only cold, filtered water in the water reservoir.
- Do not open the brew head during the brewing process as hot water is under pressure.
- Ensure the drip tray is properly in place to catch any spills.
- This appliance is for household use only.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Components

- Main Unit with Control Panel
- 50 oz Removable Water Reservoir
- K-Cup Pod Holder
- Reusable Filter Basket for Ground Coffee
- Removable Drip Tray
- Power Cord

Control Panel Functions

- **ON/OFF Button:** Powers the machine on or off.
- **HOT BREW:** Standard coffee brewing mode.
- **STRONG:** Brews a bolder, more concentrated coffee.
- **OVER ICE:** Brews coffee specifically for iced beverages (dispenses 6/8 oz).

- **SIZE Button:** Adjusts the brew volume (6, 8, 10, 12, 14 oz).
- **Digital Display:** Shows selected brew size and status.

5 Brewing Sizes to Choose From

4. SETUP

Initial Setup and First Use

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and tape from the coffee maker.
2. **Clean Components:** Wash the removable water reservoir, K-Cup pod holder, reusable filter basket, and drip tray with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
3. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Fill the 50 oz removable water reservoir with fresh, cold, filtered water up to the MAX line. Ensure it is securely placed back on the machine.

4. First Rinse Cycle:

- Place a large mug (at least 14 oz) on the drip tray.
- Ensure no K-Cup pod or ground coffee is in the brew head.
- Plug in the coffee maker. Press the ON/OFF button.
- Select the 14 oz brew size using the SIZE button.
- Press the HOT BREW button to start a cleansing cycle.
- Discard the hot water. Repeat this process 2-3 times to thoroughly clean the internal components.

5. Your coffee maker is now ready for use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Brewing with K-Cup Pods

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled with fresh water.
2. Lift the brew head handle.
3. Insert a K-Cup pod into the K-Cup pod holder. Close the brew head handle firmly until it clicks.
4. Place your mug on the drip tray.

5. Press the ON/OFF button to power on the machine.
6. Select your desired brew size (6, 8, 10, 12, or 14 oz) using the SIZE button.
7. Choose your brewing style:
 - **HOT BREW:** For a standard cup of hot coffee.
 - **STRONG:** For a bolder, more intense flavor.
 - **OVER ICE:** For iced coffee (only 6 or 8 oz dispense; add ice to your cup first).

8. The machine will begin brewing. Brewing time is approximately 1 minute for 6 oz and 2 minutes for 14 oz.
9. Once brewing is complete, carefully lift the brew head handle and dispose of the used K-Cup pod.

Brewing with Ground Coffee

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled with fresh water.
2. Lift the brew head handle.
3. Insert the reusable filter basket into the brew head.
4. Add your desired amount of medium-coarse ground coffee into the reusable filter basket. Do not overfill.
5. Close the brew head handle firmly until it clicks.

6. Place your mug on the drip tray.
7. Press the ON/OFF button to power on the machine.
8. Select your desired brew size (6, 8, 10, 12, or 14 oz) using the SIZE button.
9. Choose your brewing style (HOT BREW, STRONG, or OVER ICE).

10. The machine will begin brewing.
11. Once brewing is complete, carefully lift the brew head handle and remove the reusable filter basket for cleaning.

Brewing Speed and Temperature

The Horavie coffee maker is designed for fast brewing, delivering 6 oz of coffee in as little as 1 minute and 14 oz in just 2 minutes, ensuring your coffee is consistently hot.

6. MAINTENANCE

Daily Cleaning

- **Drip Tray:** Remove and empty the drip tray after each use. Wash with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- **K-Cup Pod Holder/Reusable Filter Basket:** Remove and rinse after each use. The bottom of the K-Pod holder is removable for easier cleaning.
- **Water Reservoir:** Empty any remaining water and rinse the reservoir daily. Refill with fresh water before each use.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

Descaling

Regular descaling is essential to remove mineral buildup and ensure optimal performance and longevity of your coffee maker. The machine has a built-in descaling mode. Descal every 3-6 months, or more frequently if you have hard water.

1. **Prepare Descaling Solution:** Mix 10 oz of white vinegar with 10 oz of water, or use a commercially

available descaling solution according to its instructions.

2. **Empty Reservoir:** Ensure the water reservoir is empty.
3. **Fill Reservoir:** Pour the descaling solution into the water reservoir.
4. **Enter Descaling Mode:** With the machine powered on, press and hold both the **HOT BREW** and **OVER ICE** buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds to enter descaling mode. The display will indicate descaling.

5. **Run Descaling Cycle:** Place a large mug under the dispenser. The machine will automatically dispense the solution in intervals.
6. **Rinse Cycles:** After the descaling cycle is complete, empty and rinse the water reservoir. Fill it with fresh, clean water. Run 2-3 full brewing cycles with only water to rinse out any remaining descaling solution.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee not brewing.	No water in reservoir; brew head not fully closed; machine not powered on.	Fill reservoir; ensure brew head clicks shut; press ON/OFF button.
Water shortage alert (SIZE button flashes, machine beeps).	Insufficient water in the reservoir for selected brew size.	Refill the water reservoir to the MIN or desired level.
Coffee tastes weak or watery.	Too much water for coffee grounds/pod; coffee too coarse; machine needs descaling.	Use STRONG brew mode; use finer grind; descale the machine.
Coffee overflows from K-Cup pod/filter.	K-Cup pod/filter clogged; too much ground coffee; brew head not sealed.	Check for clogs; do not overfill ground coffee; ensure brew head is firmly closed.
Machine not heating water.	Power issue; internal malfunction.	Check power connection; if problem persists, contact customer support.
