1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires adult assembly. Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children during assembly.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limit for a full-size bed frame. Refer to the specifications section for details.
- **Secure All Fasteners:** Ensure all bolts, screws, and connectors are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as necessary.
- **Level Surface:** Place the bed frame on a flat, level surface to prevent wobbling and ensure stability.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Hardware Pack (Bolts, Screws, Washers, Allen Wrench)
- Assembly Guide (Included)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your Wekuku Full Size House Bed Frame. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a spacious area for assembly. Lay out all components and hardware.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:**
 - Connect the side rails to the headboard and footboard sections using the provided bolts and an

Allen wrench. Ensure all connections are snug but do not overtighten initially.

- Confirm the base frame is square and stable.

3. Attach the Roof Frame Supports:

- Attach the vertical posts for the house structure to the corners of the base frame.
- Connect the horizontal beams that form the top of the house structure.

4. Install the Roof Peak:

- Assemble the angled roof beams and attach them to the top horizontal beams, forming the house peak.
- Ensure all connections are secure.

5. Place the Slats:

- Evenly space and secure the wooden slats across the base frame. Some slats may require screwing into place.
- These slats provide support for your mattress.

6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, go back and securely tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten to avoid stripping threads or damaging wood.

7. **Inspect:** Before placing a mattress, inspect the assembled bed frame to ensure all parts are correctly installed and the structure is stable.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wood surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Product Care:** The product care instructions state "Hand Wash Only". This likely refers to any fabric components that might be sold separately or implied for general care. For the wood frame, use a damp cloth.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as needed to maintain stability and safety.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Protect the wood from excessive moisture and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame is wobbly or unstable.	Loose fasteners; uneven floor.	Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Move the bed to a level surface or use shims if necessary.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; manufacturing defect.	Double-check the assembly guide for correct part orientation. If parts are defective, contact customer support.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections; friction between wood parts.	Re-tighten all fasteners. Apply a small amount of furniture wax or silicone spray to contact points if squeaking persists.
