1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Lifezone Queen Size Storage Bed Frame. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

1.1 Safety Information

- Always assemble the bed frame with at least two adults.
- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use damaged parts.
- Tighten all fasteners securely, but do not overtighten. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Exercise caution when operating the hydraulic lift mechanism. Keep hands and fingers clear of pinch points.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 1000 pounds for the bed frame.
- Ensure the mattress is properly seated on the frame before operating the hydraulic lift.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components listed below are present in your package. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Headboard (Wingback, Upholstered)
- Footboard

- Side Rails (Left and Right)
- Hydraulic Lift Mechanism (Pre-assembled or requiring minor assembly)
- Wooden Slats (12 reinforced)
- Metal Legs
- Hardware Pack (Bolts, washers, nuts, Allen wrench, small wrench)
- Installation Manual

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically takes 90-120 minutes for two people. All necessary tools are included. Follow the numbered parts and clear diagrams provided in the separate installation manual for a secure build.

3.1 Preparation

1. Clear a spacious area for assembly.
2. Unpack all components and lay them out, matching them with the parts list.

3. Keep the included Allen wrench and small wrench handy.

3.2 Step-by-Step Assembly

Refer to the detailed diagrams in your separate installation manual for visual guidance.

1. **Attach Side Rails to Headboard:** Secure the side rails to the wingback headboard using the provided bolts and tools.
2. **Attach Side Rails to Footboard:** Connect the other end of the side rails to the footboard.
3. **Install Hydraulic Mechanism:** Follow the manual to correctly install the hydraulic lift arms and frame onto the bed structure. Ensure proper alignment for smooth operation.
4. **Place Wooden Slats:** Position the reinforced wooden slats across the bed frame. The slats are designed to provide strong support and eliminate the need for a box spring.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully go through and tighten all bolts and fasteners to ensure stability. Do not overtighten.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Using the Hydraulic Lift Storage

Your bed frame features an easy-lift hydraulic system for convenient access to the under-bed storage space.

1. **Prepare the Bed:** Ensure there are no items on the mattress that could fall off when lifted.
2. **Lift the Mattress:** Locate the hand lift strap, typically at the foot of the bed. Grasp the strap firmly and lift the mattress frame upwards. The hydraulic pistons will assist in lifting and holding the mattress in an open position.
3. **Access Storage:** Once the mattress is lifted, the spacious under-bed storage area is accessible. The available storage height is approximately 10.8 inches.
4. **Lower the Mattress:** To close, gently pull the mattress frame downwards. The hydraulic system will provide a controlled descent. Ensure hands and fingers are clear of the frame as it lowers.

4.2 Mattress Protection Device

A protective device is integrated into the frame to prevent the mattress from slipping during the lifting and lowering process. Ensure your mattress is properly aligned with this device.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

- For general cleaning of the upholstered surfaces, wipe with a dry cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the fabric.
- For spills, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth.

5.2 Fastener Checks

Periodically check all bolts and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain the bed frame's stability and prevent squeaking.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame squeaks	Loose fasteners; friction between parts.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure EVA anti-noise strips are correctly installed at contact points.
Hydraulic lift is difficult to operate or does not stay up	Incorrect installation of hydraulic pistons; mattress weight exceeds piston capacity; pistons require breaking in.	Review assembly instructions for hydraulic mechanism. Ensure mattress weight is within recommended range (8-14 inches). New pistons may require a few cycles of opening and closing to operate smoothly. If issues persist, contact customer support.
Mattress slides when lifting	Mattress protection device not engaged or installed incorrectly.	Ensure the mattress protection device (metal bar at the foot of the frame) is correctly installed and the mattress is seated against it.
