## 4. PRODUCT FEATURES

---

Your Portable Language Translator Device is equipped with advanced functionalities to facilitate communication:

- **Extensive Language Support:** Supports mutual dialect translation in over 138 online languages and 14 offline languages.
- **High-Definition Touchscreen:** Features a 2.4-inch HD touchscreen for real-time voice and text display.
- **Photo Translation:** Integrated 5-megapixel camera with Optical Character Recognition (OCR) for translating text from images in over 47 languages.
- **Recorded Translation:** Ability to record audio and translate it.
- **Connectivity:** Supports WiFi and mobile hotspot connections for online translation.
- **Offline Translation:** Downloadable language packs for translation without an internet connection.
- **Two-Way Instant Translation:** Provides real-time bidirectional translation.
- **Intelligent Noise Reduction:** Dual microphone design ensures clear audio capture even in noisy environments.
- **Long Battery Life:** Equipped with a 1265 mAh battery, offering up to 40 hours of standby time.
- **High Accuracy:** Achieves up to 99% translation accuracy.

## 5. SETUP

### 5.1 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the device. Connect the USB charging cable to the device's charging port and plug the other end into a standard USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The charging indicator will show the charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 3.5 hours.

### 5.2 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (usually located on the side) for a few seconds until the screen lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a power-off menu appears on the screen. Select "Power Off" or slide the toggle to confirm.

### 5.3 Network Connection (WiFi/Hotspot)

For online translation features, the device requires an internet connection:

1. From the main screen, tap the "Settings" icon.
2. Select "WLAN" or "WiFi".
3. Toggle WiFi to "On". The device will scan for available networks.
4. Select your desired WiFi network from the list.
5. Enter the network password if prompted and tap "Connect".
6. Once connected, the WiFi icon will appear in the status bar.

You can also connect to a mobile hotspot from your smartphone by following similar steps.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1 Voice Translation

This feature allows for real-time bidirectional voice translation:

1. From the main screen, tap the "Translate" icon.
2. Select the source language (your language) and target language (the language you want to translate to) using the on-screen options.
3. Press and hold the designated voice input button (usually marked with a microphone icon or a specific color, e.g., red for language A, blue for language B).
4. Speak clearly into the device's microphone. Release the button when you finish speaking.
5. The device will process your speech and display the translated text on the screen, then play the audio translation.

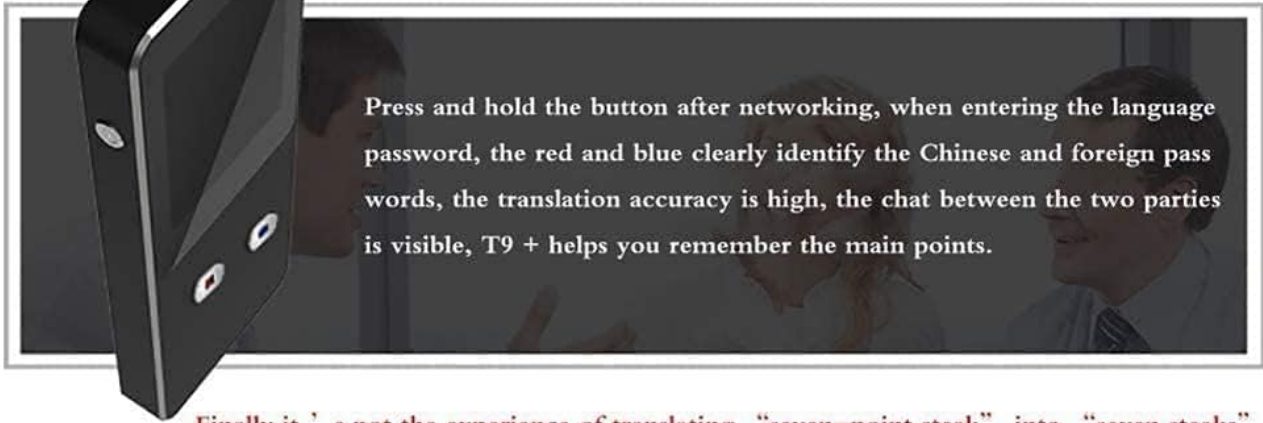

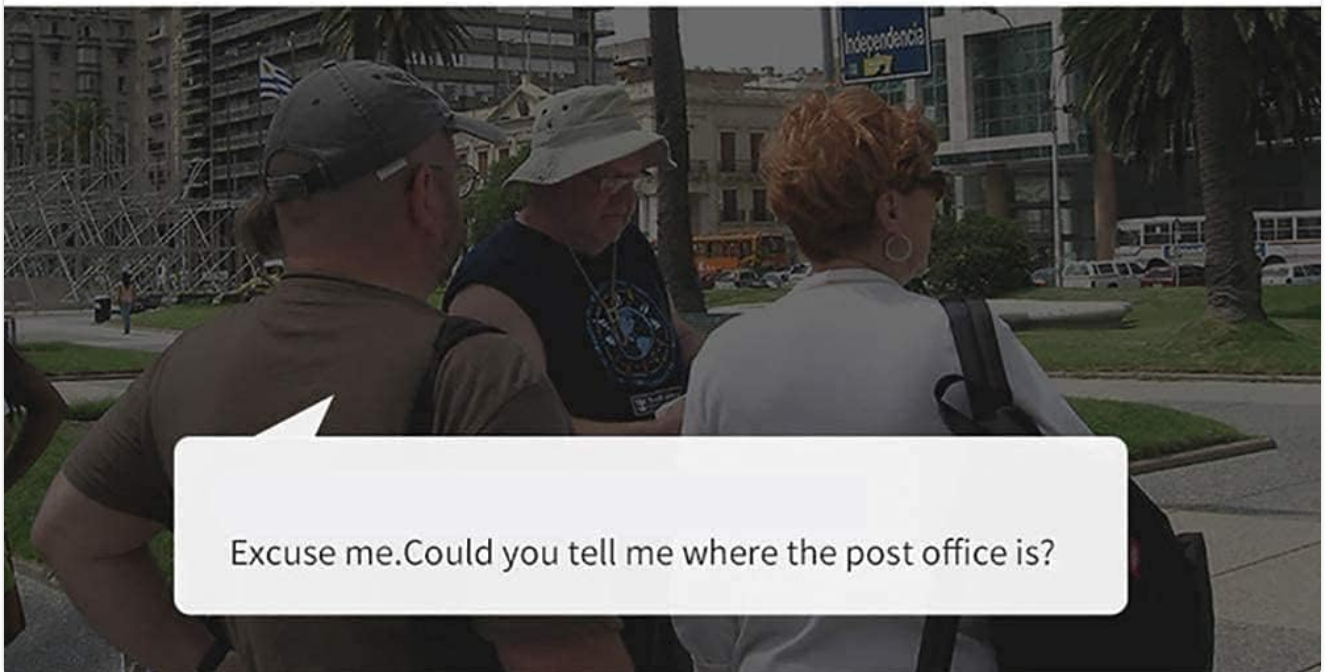


Figure 4: Seamless interlingual translation for natural conversations.

### 6.2 Photo Translation

Translate text from signs, menus, or documents using the built-in camera:

1. From the main screen, tap the "Photo" or "Camera" icon.
2. Position the device's camera over the text you wish to translate, ensuring the text is clear and well-lit within the frame.
3. Tap the capture button on the screen.
4. The device will scan the text and display the translation. You may need to select the source and target languages if not automatically detected.

### 6.3 Offline Translation

For situations without internet access, you can use pre-downloaded language packs:

1. Ensure the device is connected to WiFi.
2. Go to "Settings" and find "Offline Languages" or "Language Download".
3. Select the language pairs you wish to download for offline use.
4. Once downloaded, these languages will be available for translation even without an internet connection.

### 6.4 Recorded Translation

The device can record conversations and translate them:

1. From the main screen, tap the "Record" icon.
2. Tap the record button to start recording.
3. Once finished, tap the stop button. The recording will be saved.
4. You can then select the recording and choose the desired translation language to view or listen to the translated text.

## 6.5 Language Selection

To change the active translation languages:

- On the main translation screen, tap on the language displayed for the source or target language.
- A list of available languages will appear. Scroll and select your desired language.
- Confirm your selection.

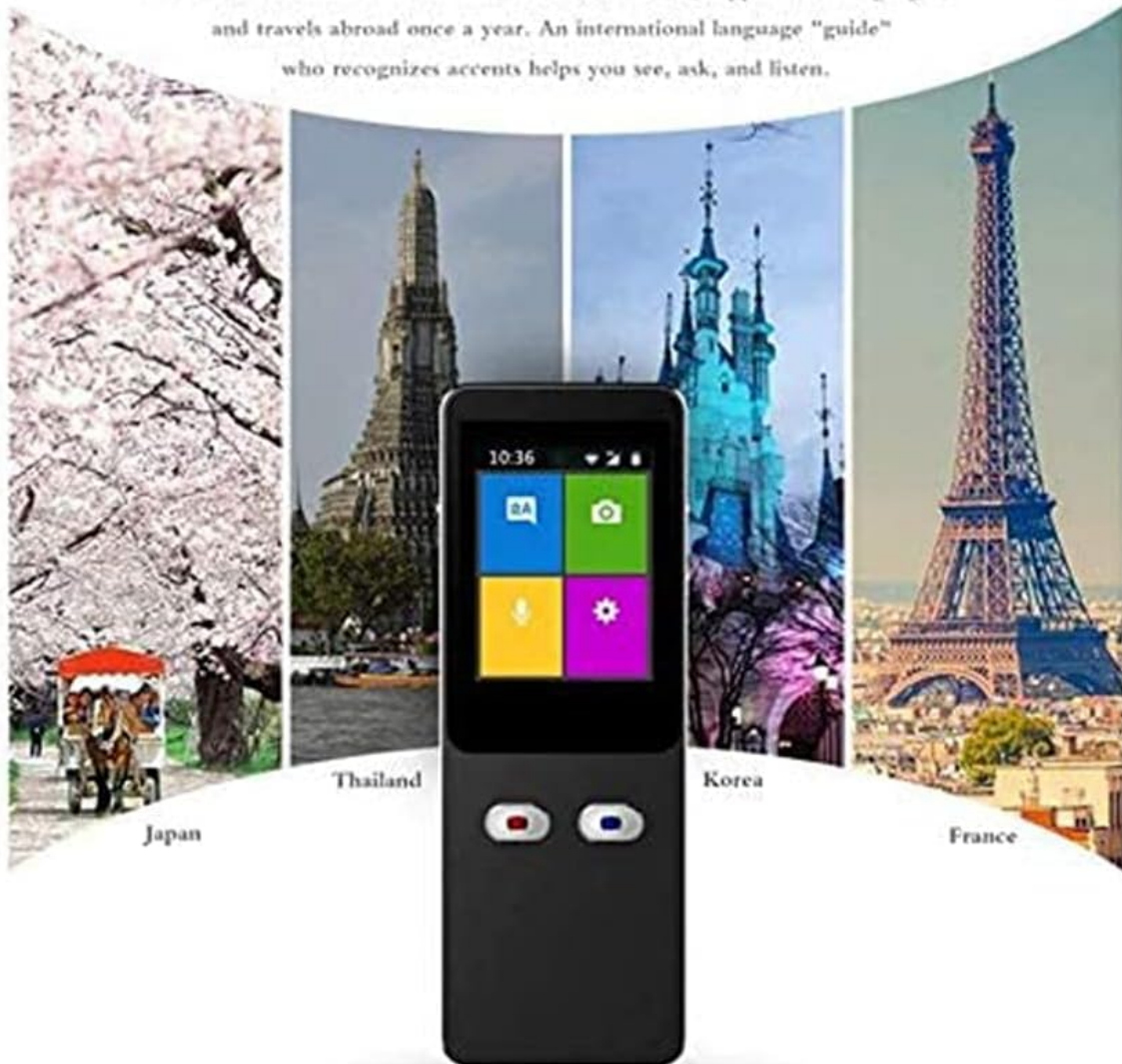


Figure 7: The device facilitates communication for global travelers.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

### 7.1 Cleaning

To clean the device, gently wipe the screen and body with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the surface.

### 7.2 Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. It is recommended to charge the device to about 50% before long-term storage to preserve battery health.

### 7.3 Battery Care

To maximize battery life:

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Do not leave the device plugged in for excessively long periods after it is fully charged.
- Charge the device regularly, even if not in frequent use.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on again.
Cannot connect to WiFi.	Incorrect password; network out of range; router issue.	Verify password; move closer to router; restart router; try another network.
Translation is inaccurate or slow.	Poor internet connection; noisy environment; unclear speech.	Ensure stable internet; speak clearly and closer to microphone; reduce background noise.
Photo translation not working.	Poor lighting; blurry image; unsupported language for OCR.	Ensure good lighting; hold device steady; check if language is supported for photo translation.
Device freezes or becomes unresponsive.	Software glitch.	Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
