INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Karl home Metal Chicken Coop. Designed to offer a secure and spacious enclosure for poultry and small animals, this coop features a durable galvanized steel frame, hexagonal wire mesh, and a waterproof cover. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper installation and safe operation.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires assembly by at least two adults.
- **Wear Protective Gear:** Always wear gloves during assembly to protect hands from sharp edges.
- **Clear Assembly Area:** Ensure the assembly area is clear of obstructions and hazards.
- **Secure Installation:** The coop must be securely anchored to the ground to prevent tipping or movement, especially in windy conditions.
- **Inspect Regularly:** Periodically check all connections, mesh, and the cover for damage or wear. Replace damaged parts immediately.
- **Animal Safety:** Ensure the enclosure is free of any sharp objects or hazards that could harm animals.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have at least two people for this process.

1. **Prepare the Site:** Choose a level, stable area for the coop. Ensure adequate drainage and clear any debris. Consider the overall dimensions for placement.

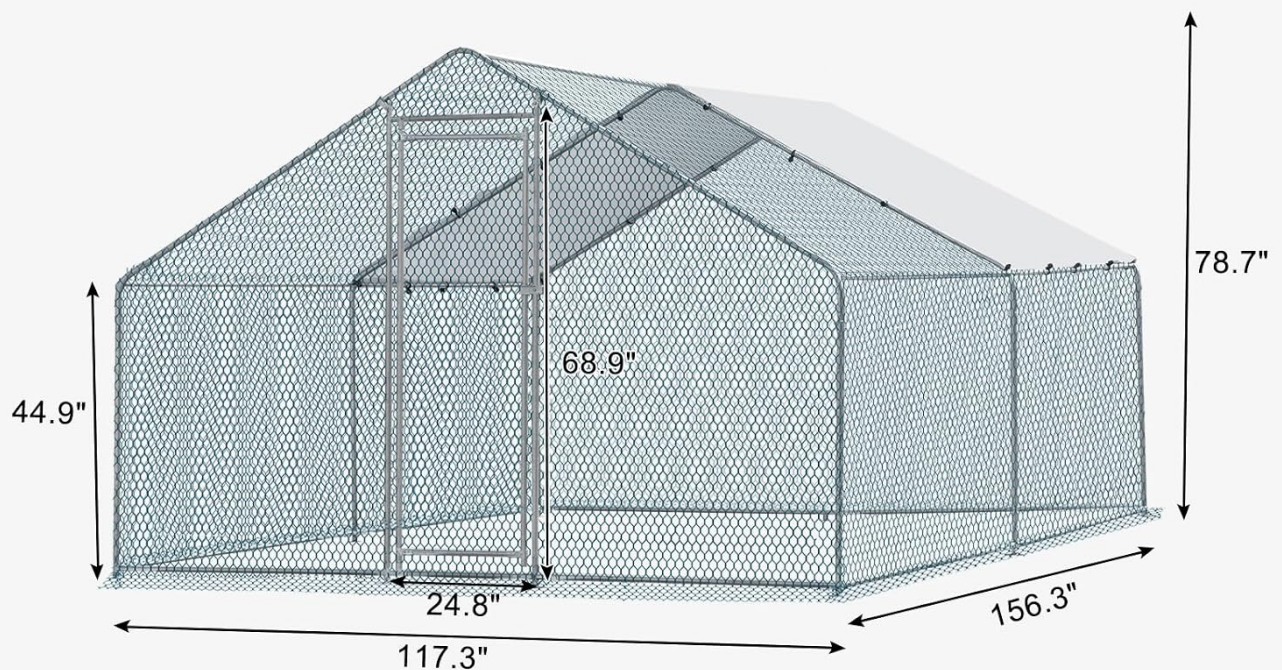


Image: Overall dimensions of the Karl home Metal Chicken Coop.

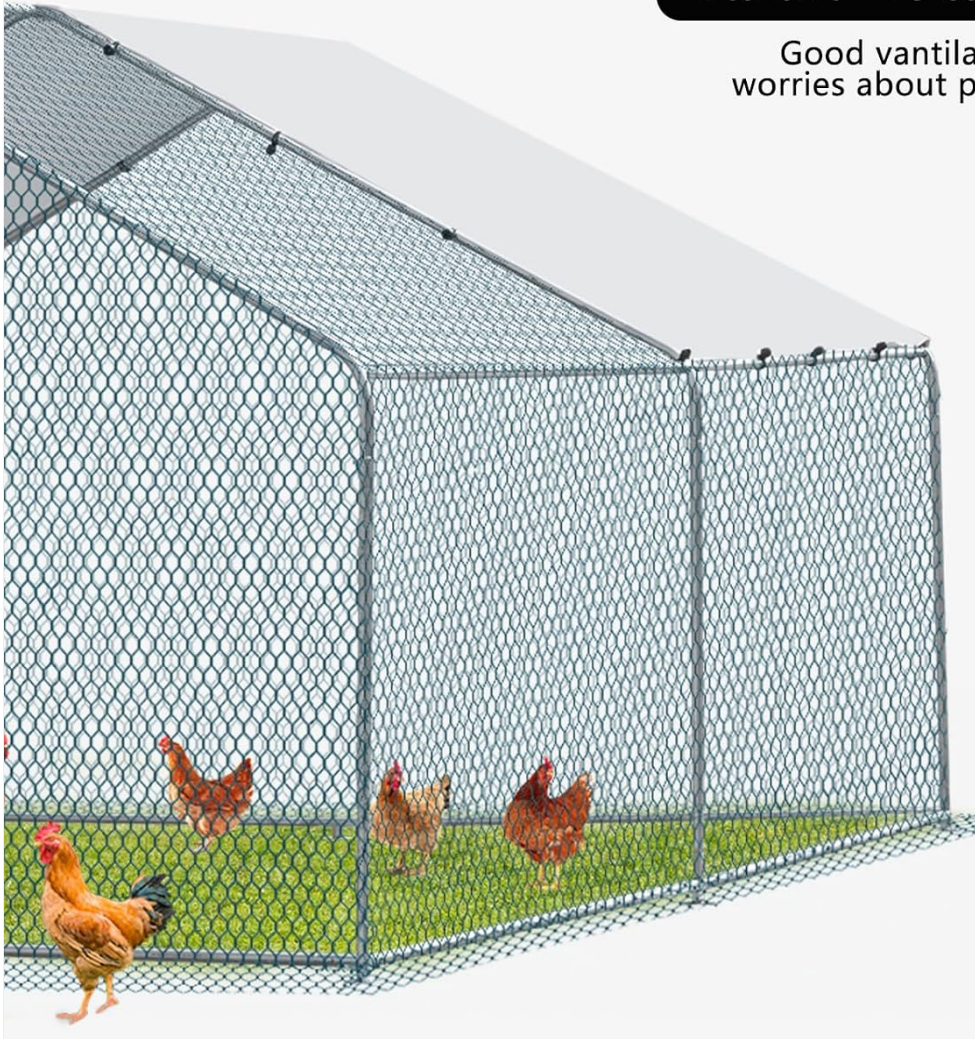
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel frame tubes according to the included diagrams. The quick-connect frame design allows for straightforward assembly. Ensure all connections are secure.

3. **Attach the Wire Mesh:** Unroll the hexagonal wire mesh and attach it to the assembled frame using the provided clips or zip ties. Ensure the mesh is taut and covers all open sides of the frame, leaving no gaps that animals could escape through or predators could enter.

CONVENIENT GATE

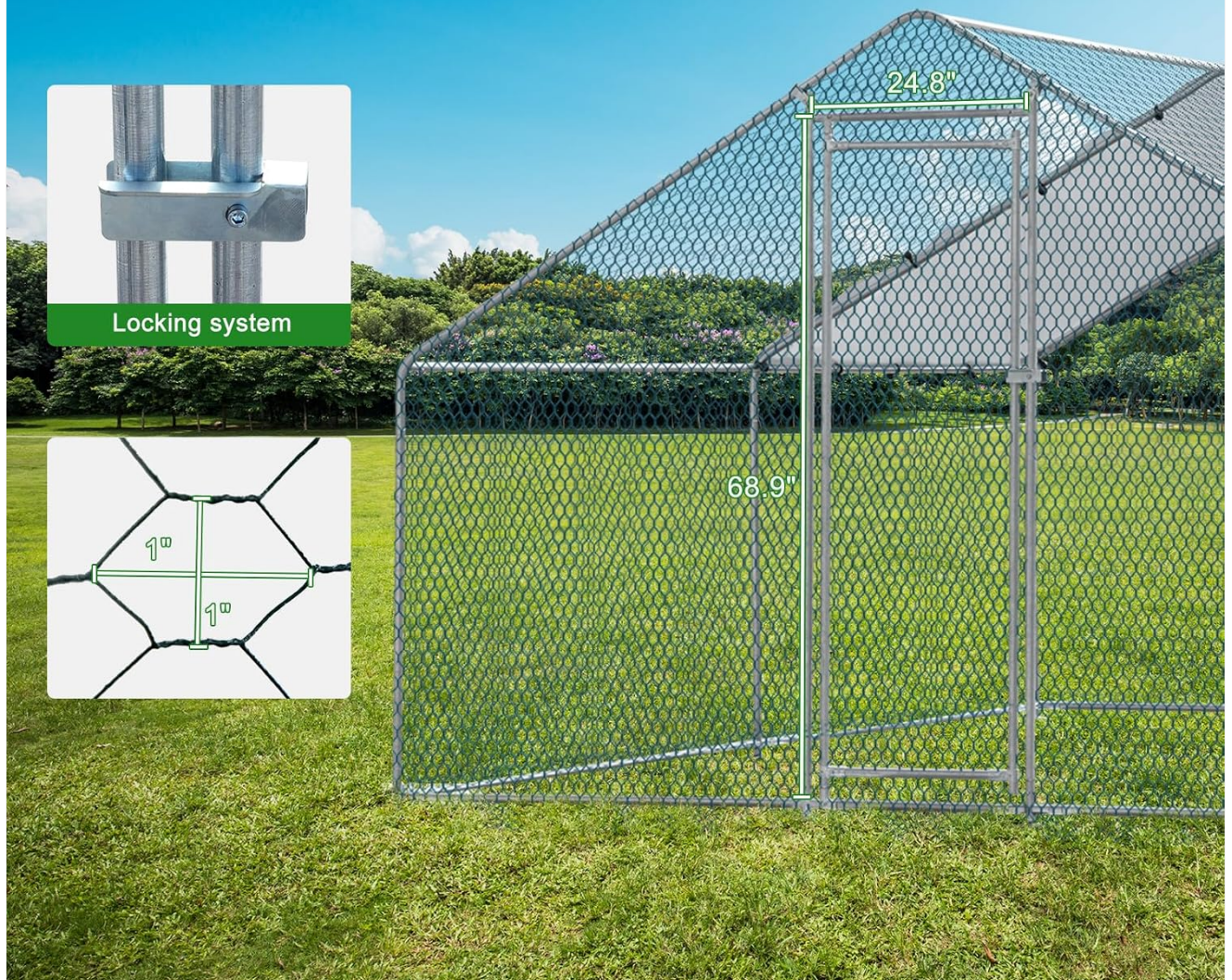


Image: Detail of the gate and mesh attachment, showing the locking system and mesh size.

4. **Install the Door:** Integrate the door assembly into the designated opening in the frame. Ensure the hinges operate smoothly and the security latch functions correctly to keep animals safely inside.

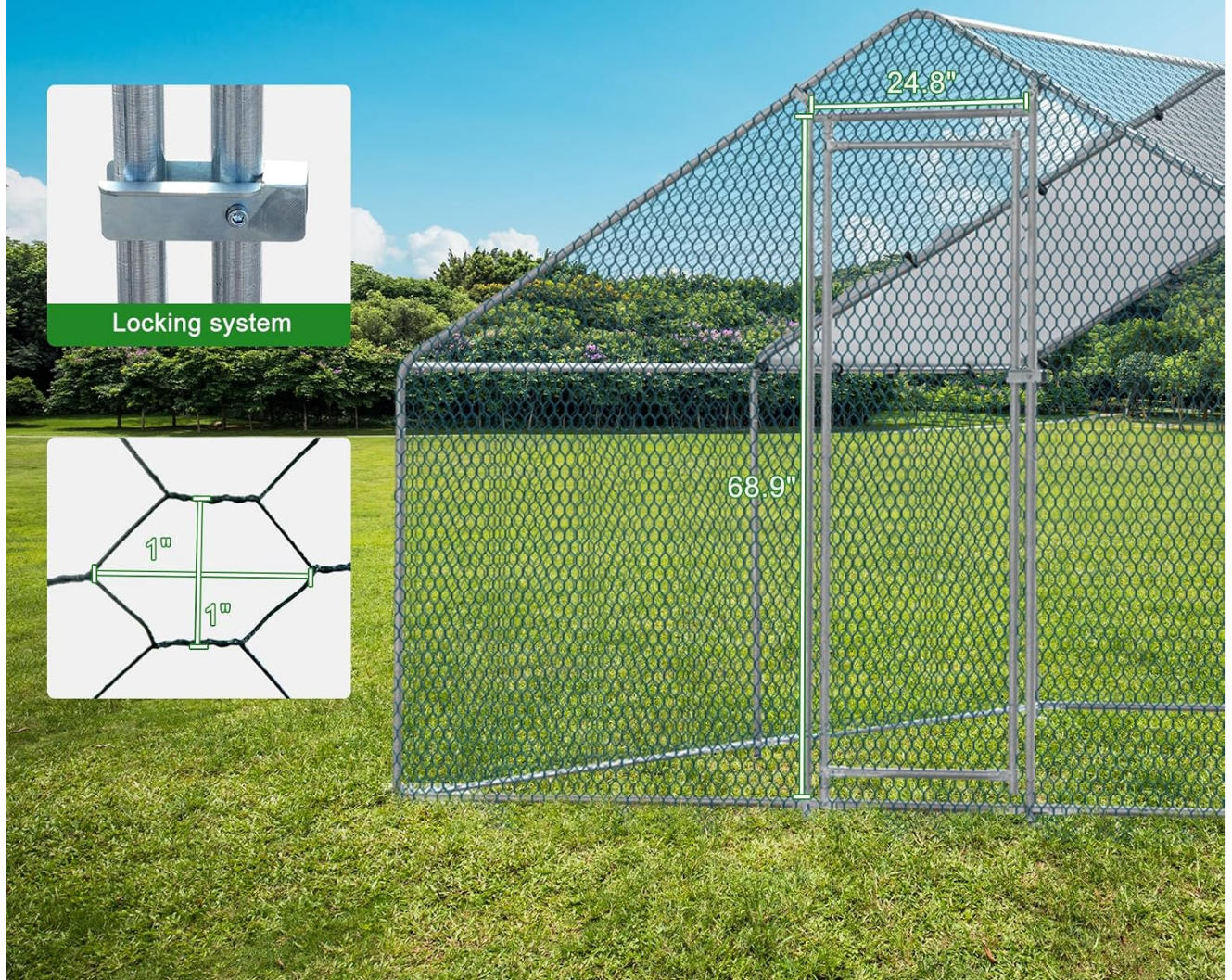


Image: Detail of the gate and mesh attachment, showing the locking system and mesh size.

5. **Secure to the Ground:** Use the provided fixable metal feet and ground anchors to firmly secure the coop to the ground. This prevents movement and enhances stability against wind.

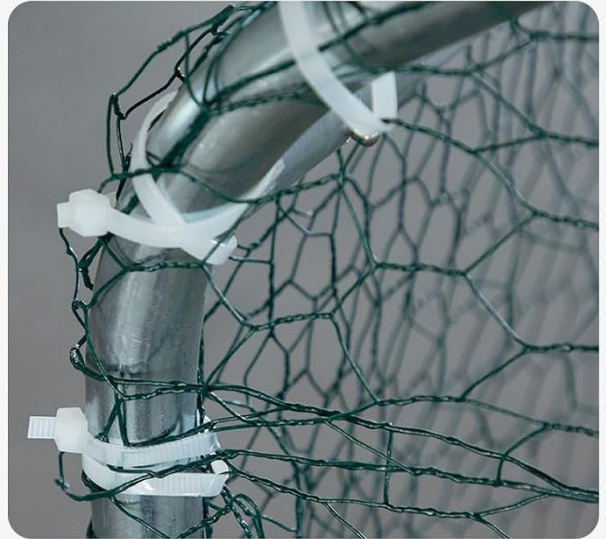


Image: Details of the fixable metal foot for ground anchoring and frame connection.

6. **Install the Waterproof Cover:** Drape the 180g PE waterproof cover over the roof section of the coop. Secure it firmly to the frame using the integrated fasteners or additional ties to protect animals from sun and rain.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Animal Placement:** Gently introduce your poultry or small animals into the coop. Ensure they have access to food, water, and adequate shelter within the enclosure.
- **Using the Gate:** The gate is designed for easy access. Use the security latch to open and close the gate. Always ensure the latch is securely fastened when animals are inside to prevent escapes and protect against predators.
- **Monitoring:** Regularly observe your animals to ensure they are comfortable and safe within the coop.

MAINTENANCE

- **Regular Cleaning:** Clean the coop regularly to maintain a hygienic environment for your animals. Remove waste and soiled bedding as needed.
- **Frame Inspection:** Periodically check the galvanized steel frame for any signs of rust, bending, or damage. Tighten any loose connections.
- **Mesh Inspection:** Inspect the hexagonal wire mesh for any tears, holes, or loose sections. Repair or reinforce as necessary.

- **Cover Care:** Clean the waterproof cover with mild soap and water. Inspect it for tears or degradation due to prolonged sun exposure. Replace the cover if it becomes significantly damaged to ensure continued weather protection.
- **Ground Anchors:** Verify that the ground anchors remain firmly in place, especially after heavy winds or rain.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Coop Instability:** If the coop feels unstable, ensure all frame connections are fully tightened and that the ground anchors are deeply and securely set into the ground. Consider adding additional anchoring points in very windy areas.
- **Water Accumulation on Cover:** Ensure the cover is taut and properly angled to allow water runoff. Adjust its position or add support if sagging occurs.
- **Animals Escaping:** Check the entire mesh for any small gaps or holes. Ensure the gate latch is fully engaged when closed. Reinforce any weak points in the mesh.
- **Difficulty with Gate Operation:** Lubricate hinges if the gate is stiff. Check for any debris obstructing the latch mechanism.
