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1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Gvyugke Captain 780 Wireless Gaming Headset. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and to prevent damage.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items listed below are included in your package:

- 1 x Gvyugke Captain 780 Wireless Gaming Headset
- 1 x 2.4GHz USB Transmitter
- 1 x USB Charging Cable (Type-C)
- 1 x 3.5mm Audio Cable

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gvyugke Captain 780 is a versatile gaming headset designed for multiple platforms, offering 2.4GHz wireless, Bluetooth 5.3, and wired connectivity. It features 50mm speakers for surround sound, a noise-canceling microphone, and

comfortable protein leather ear pads with memory foam. The headset also includes blue LED lighting and a long-lasting 1200mAh battery providing up to 70 hours of playtime.

Key Features:

- **4-in-1 Connectivity:** 2.4GHz USB, Bluetooth 5.3, and 3.5mm wired connection.
- **Immersive Audio:** 50mm speakers with 7.1 surround sound capability.
- **Clear Communication:** Rotating noise-canceling microphone.
- **Comfort:** Protein leather ear pads with memory foam and adjustable headband.
- **Long Battery Life:** Up to 70 hours of playtime with a 1200mAh battery.
- **Quick Charge:** 5 minutes of charging provides 2 hours of use.
- **Design:** Foldable design with blue LED lighting.

Controls and Ports:

4. SETUP & CONNECTION

4.1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset. Connect the USB Type-C charging cable to the headset's charging port and the other end to a USB power source. A full charge takes approximately 2-3 hours.

4.2. Connecting to PC (2.4GHz Wireless Mode)

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Set the headset to "2.4G" mode using the mode switch. The indicator light will flash white when not connected.
3. Plug the 2.4GHz USB transmitter into an available USB port on your PC.
4. Once connected successfully, the transmitter light will stay solid blue, and the headset light will stay solid white.

4.3. Connecting to PC (Bluetooth Mode)

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Set the headset to "BT" (Bluetooth) mode using the mode switch. The indicator light will flash blue when not connected.
3. On your PC, open "Settings" and navigate to "Bluetooth & devices".
4. Click "Add device" and select "Bluetooth".
5. Select "Captain 780" from the list of available devices to connect. (If not found, switch to 2.4G mode then back to BT mode).
6. Once connected, the headset indicator light will stay solid blue.

4.4. Connecting to PS5 (2.4GHz Wireless Mode)

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Set the headset to "2.4G" mode using the mode switch. The indicator light will flash white when not connected.
3. Plug the 2.4GHz USB transmitter into an available USB port on your PS5 (front or back).
4. Once connected successfully, the transmitter light will stay solid blue, and the headset light will stay solid white.
5. On your PS5, go to "Settings" > "Sound".
6. Under "Microphone", ensure "Input Device" is set to "USB Headset (Captain 780)".
7. Under "Audio Output", ensure "Output Device" is set to "USB Headset (Captain 780)".
8. Adjust volume levels as needed.

4.5. Connecting to PS5 (Wired Mode)

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Plug the 3.5mm audio cable into the PS5 controller and the USB-C end into the headset.
3. In wired mode, the headset lights will be off, and the headset mute button will not function. Mute via your device if needed.
4. On your PS5, go to "Settings" > "Sound".
5. Under "Microphone", ensure "Input Device" is set to "USB Headset (Captain 780)".
6. Under "Audio Output", ensure "Output Device" is set to "USB Headset (Captain 780)".
7. Adjust volume levels as needed.

4.6. Connecting to Nintendo Switch (2.4GHz Wireless Mode)

The Gvyugke Captain 780 headset is compatible with Nintendo Switch in 2.4GHz wireless mode. Note that the microphone functionality is limited on the Switch platform due to system limitations.

1. Turn on the headset and set it to "2.4G" mode.
2. Plug the 2.4GHz USB transmitter into the Nintendo Switch dock's USB port.
3. The headset should automatically connect.

Important Note: The microphone is not usable on the Nintendo Switch platform. This is a limitation of the Switch system, not a defect of the headset.

4.7. Connecting to Xbox (Wired Mode)

The Gvyugke Captain 780 headset can be used with Xbox consoles via a wired connection.

1. Turn on the headset.
2. Plug the 3.5mm audio cable into the Xbox controller and the USB-C end into the headset.
3. In wired mode, the headset lights will be off, and the headset mute button will not function. Mute via your device if needed.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Power On/Off

Press and hold the Power/Mute button for 3 seconds to turn the headset on or off.

5.2. Volume Control

Use the volume wheel on the headset to adjust the audio output level.

5.3. Microphone Mute

Press the Power/Mute button once to mute or unmute the microphone. (Note: This function is not available in wired mode).

5.4. Mode Switching

Use the BT/2.4G mode switch button to toggle between 2.4GHz wireless mode and Bluetooth mode.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the headset clean by wiping it with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the headset to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the headset yourself, as this will void the warranty.
- Store the headset in a cool, dry place when not in use. The foldable design allows for compact storage.

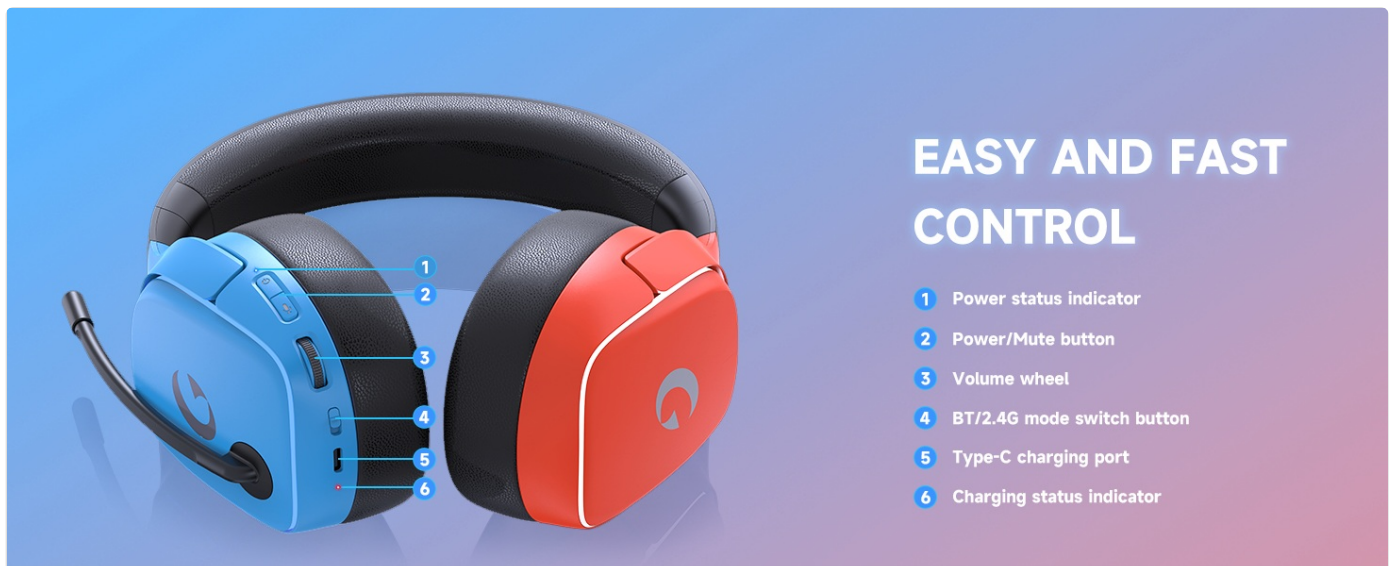


Image: The Gvyugke Captain 780 headset demonstrating its compact foldable design for easy storage and portability.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1. No Sound or Low Volume

- Ensure the headset is powered on and properly connected (2.4GHz, Bluetooth, or wired).
- Check the volume wheel on the headset and your device's audio settings.
- For PC, verify that "Captain 780" is selected as the output device in your sound settings.
- For PS5, ensure "USB Headset (Captain 780)" is selected as the output device in "Settings" > "Sound" > "Audio Output".

7.2. Microphone Not Working or Teammates Can't Hear Me

- Ensure the microphone is not muted (press the Power/Mute button).
- For PC, verify that "Captain 780" is selected as the input device in your sound settings and adjust the microphone level.
- For PS5, ensure "USB Headset (Captain 780)" is selected as the input device in "Settings" > "Sound" > "Microphone".
- Remember, the microphone is not functional when connected to Nintendo Switch.

7.3. Microphone Echo

- If you experience an echo, ensure the monitoring function for the microphone is turned off in your device's sound settings.

7.4. Connectivity Issues

- If the headset fails to connect in 2.4GHz or Bluetooth mode, try switching between modes (e.g., 2.4G to BT, then back to 2.4G) to reset the connection.
- Ensure the transmitter is securely plugged into the device.

- Restart your device and the headset.
