## **1. INTRODUCTION**

---

Thank you for choosing the Babyletto Crosby 3-in-1 Convertible Crib. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your crib. The Crosby crib is designed to blend classic aesthetics with modern functionality, featuring a curved silhouette and whimsical ball feet. Crafted from sustainable materials, it converts from a crib to a toddler bed and a daybed, adapting to your child's growth. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

**WARNING:** Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Read all instructions before using the crib. Keep this manual for future reference.
- Do not use this crib if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact Babyletto for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. Do not substitute parts.
- The crib is designed for a child who cannot climb out and is less than 35 inches (89 cm) tall.
- To prevent falls, when the child is able to pull to a standing position, set the mattress to the lowest position.
- Check the crib regularly for loose hardware, worn parts, or sharp edges. Tighten all fasteners securely.
- Do not place the crib near windows where cords from blinds or drapes could strangle a child.
- Do not place items with a string or strap around a child's neck, such as pacifier clips or necklaces.
- Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.

- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers. They can cause suffocation.
- Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow, comforter, or extra padding.
- Always place infants on their backs to sleep.
- This crib is GREENGUARD Gold Certified, meaning it has been tested for over 10,000 chemical emissions and VOCs, contributing to cleaner indoor air.
- The product meets or exceeds ASTM International and U.S. CPSC safety standards.

### 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

### 3.1 Unpacking and Parts Identification

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Verify that all parts listed below are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support immediately.

### 3.2 Assembly Instructions

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your product. Ensure all bolts are tightened securely, but do not overtighten. Periodically check all fasteners to ensure they remain tight.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Adjustable Mattress Positions

The Babyletto Crosby Crib features 4 adjustable mattress positions to accommodate your child's growth. Adjust the

mattress height as your baby develops to ensure safety and ease of use.

- **Highest Position:** For newborns and infants who cannot push up on their hands and knees.
- **Mid-High Position:** For infants who are beginning to roll over.
- **Mid-Low Position:** For infants who can sit up unassisted.
- **Lowest Position:** For toddlers who can pull themselves to a standing position. This position helps prevent climbing out.

## 4.2 3-in-1 Convertibility

The Crosby crib is designed to convert into a toddler bed and a daybed, extending its usability as your child grows.

- **Crib:** Standard configuration for infants.
- **Toddler Bed:** Converts by removing one side rail and adding a toddler bed conversion kit (Model #M23799, sold separately). Recommended for children between 18 months and 3 years of age.
- **Daybed:** Converts from the toddler bed by removing the toddler rail when your child feels ready for an open bed.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning Instructions

To clean your Babyletto Crosby Crib, wipe surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or strong detergents, as these can damage the finish.

### 5.2 Regular Inspection

Periodically inspect the crib for any signs of wear, damage, or loose hardware. Ensure all bolts and screws are tight. Do

not use the crib if any part is broken or missing.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Crib feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.
Difficulty adjusting mattress height.	Mechanism obstructed or misaligned.	Ensure the mattress support is properly aligned with the adjustment holes. Clear any obstructions.
Scratches or dents appearing easily.	Wood material characteristics.	While the crib is made from durable New Zealand pine wood, wood can dent or scratch with impact. Handle with care. For minor scratches, touch-up pens may be available from the manufacturer.
