## 3. SETUP

---

### 3.1 Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the KOKODI Talking Pen.
2. Using a small screwdriver, carefully unscrew the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 2 AAA batteries (not included) into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw. This safety feature prevents young children from accessing the batteries.

### **3.2 Power On/Off**

- To power on the pen, press and hold the power button (usually a circular button) until you hear a greeting sound.
- To power off, press and hold the power button again until the pen indicates it is shutting down.

### **3.3 Volume Control**

- Use the volume buttons (usually marked '+' and '-') on the pen to adjust the sound level to a comfortable listening volume.

## **4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The KOKODI Talking Pen is designed for intuitive interaction with the provided books. Each book is equipped with special technology that allows the pen to recognize specific areas on the page.
