DERCASS Full Over Full Bunk Bed Instruction Manual

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembling and using this bunk bed. Retain this manual for future reference.

- **Weight Capacity:** The maximum weight capacity for both the upper and lower beds is 600 lbs each. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Mattress Thickness:** The recommended mattress thickness for the upper bed is 6 inches, and for the lower bed is 8 inches. Ensure the mattress on the upper bunk is at least 5 inches below the top of the guardrails.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on the upper bunk. Ensure they are securely fastened.
- **Ladder Safety:** Use the ladder for entry and exit from the upper bunk. Do not jump on the bed.
- **Assembly:** This product requires assembly. Ensure all parts are present and correctly assembled before use.
- **Children:** Children under 6 years of age should not use the upper bunk.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Bed Frame Components (Headboards, Footboards, Side Rails, Ladder, Guardrails)
- Wooden Slats for Mattress Support
- Hardware Pack (Screws, Bolts, Washers, Allen Key)

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (SETUP)

Assembly typically requires two adults. Follow the steps carefully to ensure proper and safe construction.

3.1 Tools Required

- Included Allen Key
- Phillips Head Screwdriver (not included)

3.2 Step-by-Step Assembly

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Refer to the parts

list in your included assembly guide to identify each piece.

2. **Assemble Bed Ends:** Attach the headboards and footboards to the vertical posts using the provided hardware. Do not fully tighten bolts until the entire frame is assembled.
3. **Attach Side Rails:** Connect the side rails to the assembled bed ends for both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure the connections are secure.
4. **Install Ladder:** Securely attach the ladder to the designated side of the bunk bed frame. Verify that all ladder steps are firmly in place.
5. **Install Guardrails:** Attach the guardrails to the upper bunk frame. These are crucial for safety and must be installed correctly.
6. **Place Slats:** Lay the wooden slats across the support beams for both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure they are evenly spaced and secured if fasteners are provided. The slats provide direct support for the mattress, eliminating the need for a box spring.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, systematically tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

4. OPERATION

This bunk bed is designed for safe and comfortable use when proper guidelines are followed.

- **Upper Bunk Access:** Always use the provided ladder to access or exit the upper bunk. Do not climb on the frame or guardrails.
- **Guardrail Integrity:** Regularly check that the guardrails on the upper bunk are securely attached and free from damage.
- **Mattress Placement:** Ensure mattresses are properly seated on the slats and do not extend beyond the bed frame.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit jumping or rough play on or around the bunk bed to prevent falls and injuries.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Keep the bed in a dry environment. Prolonged exposure to moisture can damage the wood.
- **Moving the Bed:** When moving the bed, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent stress on the joints and damage to flooring.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking often indicates loose hardware. Carefully inspect all bolts and screws and tighten them. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.

- **Damaged Parts:** If any part is damaged during assembly or use, discontinue use immediately and contact customer support for replacement parts. Do not attempt to repair damaged structural components yourself.

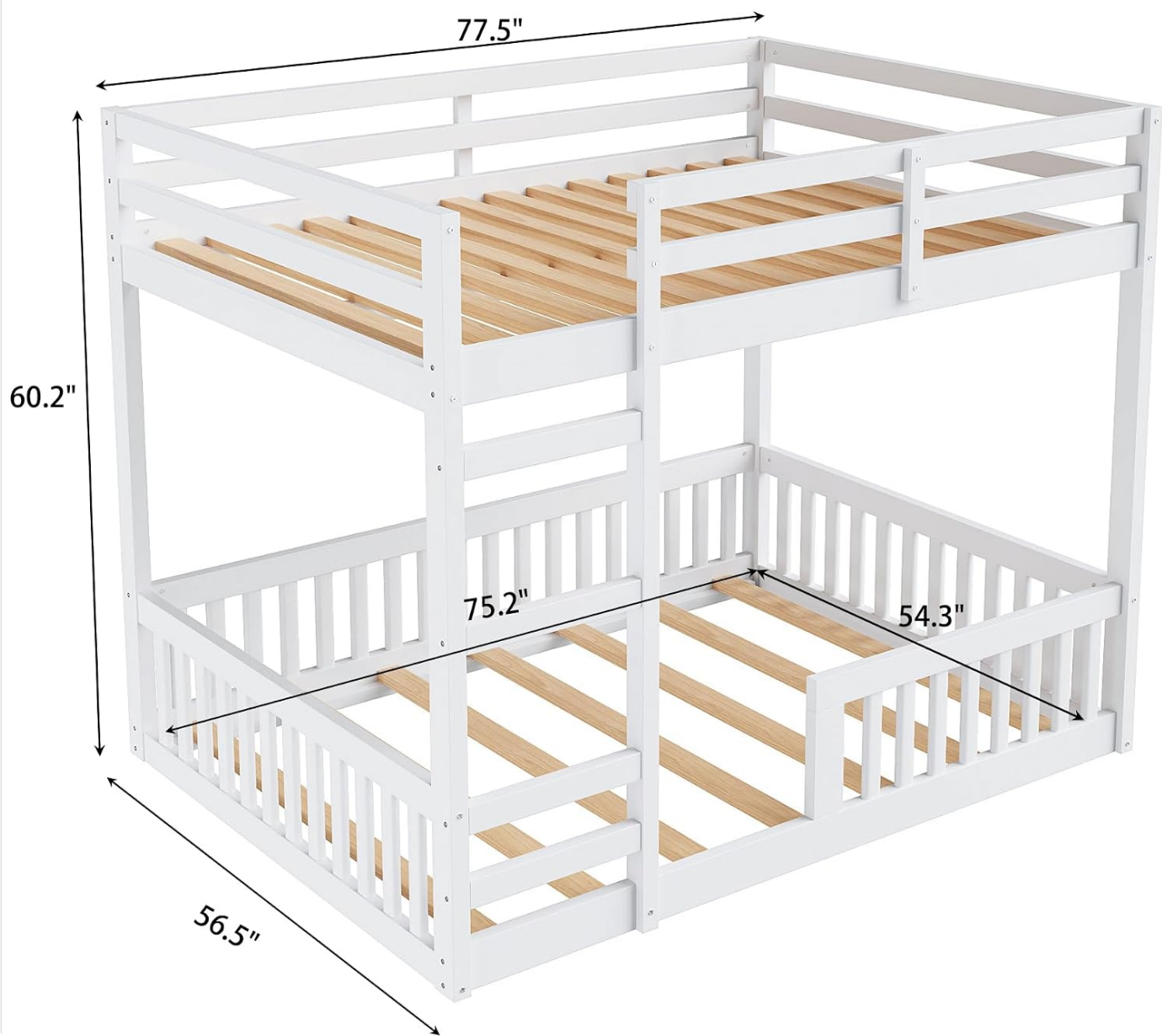


Image 7.1: A technical diagram illustrating the overall dimensions of the DERCASS Full Over Full Bunk Bed, including length, width, and height measurements.
