Introduction

Safety Information

Package Contents

Verify that all components are present and undamaged upon opening the package:

- 1x Rear Trigger Assembly
- 1x Lock Button

Installation Instructions

This section outlines the general steps for replacing the rear trigger and lock button assembly. Specific procedures may vary slightly depending on your trimmer model. Refer to your trimmer's original service manual for detailed disassembly and reassembly instructions if needed.

1. **Prepare the Trimmer:** Ensure the trimmer is turned off and the power source is disconnected (e.g., remove battery, disconnect spark plug wire). Place the trimmer on a stable, clean surface.
2. **Access the Handle Assembly:** Locate the screws or fasteners that secure the handle or housing where the trigger and lock button are situated. Carefully remove these fasteners.
3. **Remove Old Components:** Gently separate the housing halves to expose the internal trigger and lock button mechanism. Note the orientation and placement of the existing trigger, spring (if present), and lock button. Carefully remove the old trigger and lock button.
4. **Install New Lock Button:** Place the new lock button into its designated slot within the housing. Ensure it moves freely and engages correctly.
5. **Install New Trigger:** Position the new rear trigger assembly into its place. Ensure any associated springs or pivot points are correctly seated. The trigger should move smoothly when pressed.
6. **Reassemble Housing:** Carefully bring the housing halves back together, ensuring no wires or components are pinched. Secure the housing with the previously removed screws or fasteners. Do not overtighten.
7. **Test Functionality:** Reconnect the power source. Test the trigger and lock button to ensure they operate correctly and safely before using the trimmer. The lock button should prevent accidental trigger engagement, and the trigger should return to its original position when released.

Operation

The rear trigger and lock button assembly functions as follows:

- **Lock Button:** The lock button is a safety feature designed to prevent accidental activation of the trimmer. It must be depressed or moved out of the way before the main trigger can be engaged.
- **Trigger:** Once the lock button is disengaged, pressing the trigger activates the trimmer's motor. Releasing the trigger will stop the motor.

Always ensure the lock button is functioning correctly before operating your trimmer. Never attempt to bypass or disable safety features.

Care and Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and reliable performance of your RATION Rear Trigger & Lock Button Assembly:

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically inspect the trigger and lock button for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. Ensure they move freely and return to their original positions.

- **Cleaning:** Keep the area around the trigger and lock button free from dirt, debris, and grass clippings. Use a soft brush or compressed air to clean if necessary. Avoid using harsh chemicals that could damage the plastic.
- **Lubrication:** If the trigger mechanism feels stiff, a small amount of silicone-based lubricant can be applied to the pivot points, ensuring it does not interfere with electrical contacts.
- **Storage:** Store your trimmer in a clean, dry environment to prevent corrosion and material degradation.

Troubleshooting Guide

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with the trigger and lock button assembly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Trigger does not move freely.	Debris accumulation, incorrect installation, damaged spring.	Clean the mechanism. Recheck installation for proper seating. Inspect for damage.
Lock button does not engage/disengage.	Incorrect installation, debris, worn component.	Verify correct placement during installation. Clean the area. Replace if worn.
Trimmer does not start when trigger is pressed.	Lock button not fully disengaged, electrical connection issue, trimmer power issue.	Ensure lock button is fully disengaged. Check trimmer's power source and other electrical connections. This part is mechanical; if the trigger moves but the trimmer doesn't start, the issue may be elsewhere.
