1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your YASHE XQB60-2010A Portable Washing Machine. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

The YASHE XQB60-2010A is a full-automatic portable compact washer designed for convenience in various living spaces such as apartments, homes, RVs, and dormitories. It features a 17.6Lbs capacity, 10 washing programs, 8 water levels, and an LED display.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your appliance, follow basic precautions, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not wash articles that have been previously cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances, as they emit vapors that could ignite or explode.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance. Close supervision of children is necessary when the appliance is used near children.
- Before the appliance is removed from service or discarded, remove the door to the washing compartment.
- Do not reach into the appliance if the tub or agitator is moving.
- Do not install or store this appliance where it will be exposed to the weather.
- Do not tamper with controls.
- Do not repair or replace any part of the appliance or attempt any servicing unless specifically recommended in the user-maintenance instructions or in published user-repair instructions that you understand and have the skills to carry out.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or performing any maintenance.

• Ensure the appliance is placed on a flat, stable surface to prevent instability and excessive movement.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the washing machine for any damage during transit. This washing machine requires no assembly for seamless operation.

3.2 Placement

Place the washing machine on a flat, stable surface. It is recommended to let the machine sit on a flat surface for approximately 24 hours before initial use. The compact design (20" W x 20" D x 34" H) makes it suitable for limited spaces in apartments, dorms, RVs, and camping sites.

3.3 Water Connection

Connect the inlet hose to a water source. The machine includes an inlet pipe and an adapter for connection. Ensure the 'straight' pipe end connects to the faucet or adapter. Remember to insert the extra O-ring into the 'straight' pipe end when using the adapter to prevent leaks.

3.4 Drain Hose

The washing machine features a built-in drain pump and an extended drain hose for smooth water drainage from both high and low positions.



4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The washing machine is equipped with a push-button control console and an LED display that shows the required time and program status.

4.2 Loading Laundry

The machine has a 17.6Lbs capacity. For optimal washing performance, do not overload the machine. As a guide, it can accommodate approximately 18 T-shirts, 10 pairs of pants, 15 shirts, or 2 sets of sheets.

4.3 Adding Detergent and Selecting Water Level

Add appropriate detergent based on the load size and soil level. The machine offers 8 water levels, allowing for precise water usage. Refer to the detergent manufacturer's recommendations for dosage.

4.4 Selecting a Program

The washing machine features 10 washing programs to cater to various laundry needs:

- Standard: For daily laundry.
- Soft: For delicate items.
- Quick: For lightly soiled items or small loads.
- Heavy: For heavily soiled or bulky items.
- Soak: For pre-soaking heavily soiled items.
- Wash Only: Performs only the wash cycle.
- Spin Only: Performs only the spin cycle.
- Tub Clean: For cleaning the washing machine tub.
- Tub Air Dry: For drying the inside of the tub.
- Water Recycle: For specific water-saving applications.

4.5 Special Features

- **Delay Start:** The machine offers a delay start option, allowing you to set the wash cycle to begin at a later time, up to 24 hours.
- **Child Lock:** For family safety, the machine is equipped with a child lock function to prevent accidental operation.
- Auto Unbalance Detection (AUD): To prevent instability, the washer automatically redistributes the load by adjusting water levels. If an imbalance persists, the machine will alert the user to avoid leaks or excessive movement.
- 360° Tumbling Wash Technology: This technology, combined with an impeller that forms a butterfly water flow, provides a deep clean while reducing wear and tear on clothes.




Image: An illustration of the washing machine's impeller creating a butterfly water flow, designed to lift clothes for washing and reduce wear and tear, mimicking hand washing.




Image: A graphic illustrating the child lock protection feature and the 24-hour delay start function, emphasizing safety and convenience.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Tub

Regularly use the 'Tub Clean' program to maintain the cleanliness and hygiene of the washing machine's inner tub. The stainless steel inner tub is designed to resist rust and corrosion.

5.2 Lint Filter

The washing machine is equipped with a lint filter. Regularly clean the lint filter to ensure optimal washing performance and prevent lint buildup on clothes.

5.3 Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the machine with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the reinforced PP washer body.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Machine not starting:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in and the power button has been pressed. Check if the lid is properly closed.
- Excessive vibration or noise: Verify that the machine is placed on a flat, stable surface. The Auto
 Unbalance Detection (AUD) system will attempt to redistribute the load. If the issue persists, manually
 redistribute the laundry inside the tub. The shock-absorbing base and anti-vibration design help provide
 stability.
- Water not draining: Check if the drain hose is properly positioned and not kinked or blocked. Ensure the built-in drain pump is functioning correctly.
- Water leakage: Ensure all hose connections (inlet and drain) are secure and free from damage. Check the O-ring installation for the inlet hose.
- Error codes on LED display: Refer to the specific error code in the included manual for detailed troubleshooting steps.


