1. INTRODUCTION

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND FEATURES

- **Integrated Android 11.0 System:** Allows direct access to streaming apps without external devices.
- **270° Rotatable Stand:** Offers flexible projection angles, including ceiling projection.
- **Automatic Keystone Correction:** Features 4D and 4P keystone correction for quick image alignment.
- **Dual-Band WiFi 6:** Ensures fast and stable wireless connectivity.
- **Bluetooth 5.0:** For convenient connection to external audio devices.
- **Eye Protection:** Equipped with optical glass lenses to filter harmful blue light.

3. GETTING STARTED: INITIAL SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all items listed in the product contents are present.

3.2 Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a suitable electrical outlet (220V).

3.3 Placement and Adjustment

Position the projector on a stable, flat surface. The BGP45 features a 270° rotatable stand, allowing you to project images onto walls, screens, or even the ceiling for versatile viewing experiences.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the device on or off.

4.2 Navigation

Utilize the remote control to navigate the Android 11.0 operating system interface. Select apps, adjust settings, and control media playback.

4.3 Focus and Keystone Correction

Adjust the manual focus ring on the projector lens until the image is sharp. The projector features automatic 4D and 4P keystone correction to automatically square the projected image. If manual adjustment is needed, refer to the on-screen display settings.

4.4 Projection Size and Distance

The projector can display images from 40 to 130 inches. The optimal projection distance for a clear image is approximately 5 feet, achieving a 1.29:1 projection ratio.

5. CONNECTIVITY

5.1 Wi-Fi Connection

The projector supports dual-band WiFi 6 (2.4G/5G) for high-speed internet access. Navigate to the network settings in the Android system, select your Wi-Fi network, and enter the password to connect.

5.2 Bluetooth Audio

Connect external Bluetooth speakers or headphones using Bluetooth 5.0 for enhanced audio. Go to Bluetooth settings, enable Bluetooth, and pair with your desired device.

5.3 HDMI and USB Inputs

Use the HDMI port to connect devices such as TV sticks, gaming consoles (e.g., PS5), or laptops. The USB port allows for playback of media files directly from USB storage devices.

5.4 Screen Mirroring

The projector supports Miracast, Airplay, and DLNA for screen mirroring from compatible smartphones and tablets. Ensure your device and the projector are connected to the same Wi-Fi network, then select the appropriate mirroring function.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Lens Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently clean the projector lens. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Dust Removal:** Regularly clean the projector's vents to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance and lead to overheating. Use a soft brush or compressed air.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the projector in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Power Off Properly:** Always power off the projector using the designated power button and allow it to cool down before unplugging or moving.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your projector, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Power cable disconnected; power outlet issue.	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Test the outlet with another device.
No Image	Input source incorrect; device not connected; lens cap on.	Select correct input source. Check HDMI/USB connections. Remove lens cap.
Blurred Image	Focus not adjusted; keystone issue.	Adjust the manual focus ring. Check keystone correction settings.
No Sound	Volume too low; external speaker not connected; audio format unsupported.	Increase projector volume. Check Bluetooth connection to external speakers. Ensure media audio format is supported.
Remote Not Responding	Batteries low/dead; obstruction; remote sensor blocked.	Replace remote batteries. Ensure no obstructions between remote and projector. Clean remote sensor area.
Wi-Fi Connection Issues	Incorrect password; network interference; router too far.	Verify Wi-Fi password. Move projector closer to router or reduce interference. Restart router and projector.
