Thickened Tube Frame

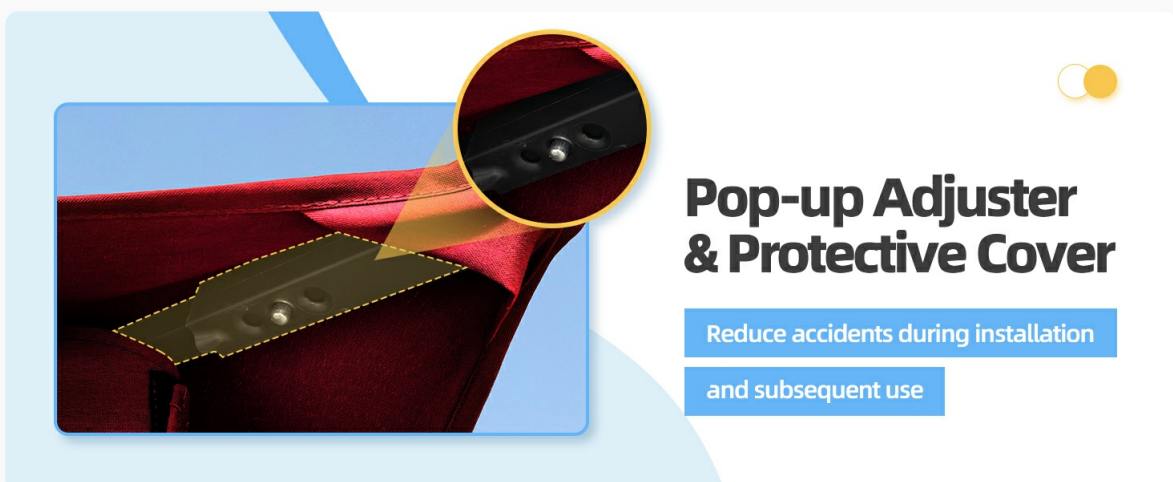


Larger area of connection to the ground

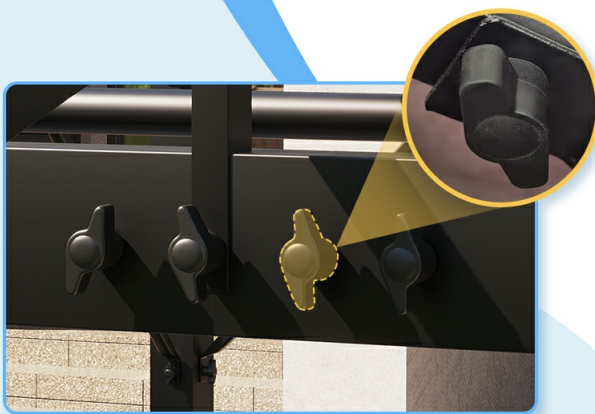

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your MELLCOM Gazebo.

- **Cleaning Fabric:** Use a mild soap and water solution with a soft brush or cloth to clean the canopy and curtains. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to air dry completely before storing or folding. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Cleaning Frame:** Wipe the metal frame with a damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a mild detergent. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.
- **Seasonal Storage:** In areas with heavy snow or strong winds, it is recommended to remove the canopy and curtains and store them indoors during the off-season to prevent damage.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary. Check fabric for any tears or damage and repair promptly.
- **Wind Resistance:** While designed with wind-resistant ropes, always secure the gazebo properly to the ground using the provided expansion bolts or other suitable anchoring methods, especially in windy conditions.

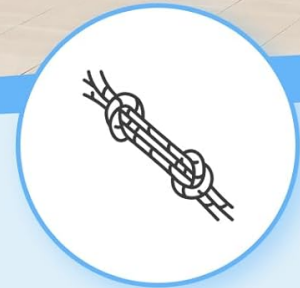


Image: The gazebo secured with wind-resistant ropes, demonstrating a key feature for stability.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your gazebo.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose connections; uneven ground; insufficient anchoring.	Ensure all bolts and screws are tightened. Relocate to a level surface. Use expansion bolts or additional weights to secure the legs to the ground.
Water pooling on the canopy.	Improper canopy installation; heavy rainfall exceeding drainage capacity.	Verify the canopy is stretched taut and correctly installed to allow water runoff. Clear any debris from the roof. In heavy rain, consider temporarily removing the canopy.
Curtains/Nettings do not slide smoothly.	Debris in tracks; bent tracks; fabric snagging.	Clean the dual tracks of any dirt or debris. Inspect tracks for damage and gently straighten if bent. Ensure fabric is not caught.
Fabric fading or tearing prematurely.	Prolonged exposure to harsh elements; improper storage; sharp objects.	Ensure the gazebo is stored indoors during extreme weather. Avoid contact with sharp objects. While the fabric is fading-resistant, extreme UV exposure over time can still cause wear.
