INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Logitech M196 Bluetooth Wireless Mouse. The M196 is a compact and portable mouse designed for seamless Bluetooth connectivity with laptops, tablets, and other compatible devices.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your Logitech M196 mouse, verify that all components are present:

- Logitech M196 Wireless Mouse
- 1 AA Battery (pre-installed)
- User Documentation

SETUP

1. Powering On and Battery Check

The Logitech M196 mouse comes with one AA battery pre-installed. To activate the mouse:

- 1. Locate the ON/OFF switch on the bottom of the mouse.
- 2. Slide the switch to the 'ON' position.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

The M196 connects wirelessly via Bluetooth, requiring no USB receiver.

1. Ensure the mouse is powered on.

- 2. On the bottom of the mouse, locate the Bluetooth pairing button (often indicated by a Bluetooth symbol).
- 3. Press and hold the pairing button for a few seconds until the LED indicator on the mouse begins to blink, signifying it is in pairing mode.
- 4. On your computer, tablet, or smartphone, navigate to the Bluetooth settings.
- 5. Search for new devices. The mouse should appear as 'Logitech M196'.
- 6. Select 'Logitech M196' to complete the pairing process. The LED on the mouse will stop blinking and remain solid for a moment, then turn off, indicating a successful connection.




Image: The Logitech M196 mouse positioned on a wooden desk, highlighting its Bluetooth connectivity feature for easy pairing.

OPERATING THE MOUSE

The Logitech M196 mouse offers standard three-button functionality with a scroll wheel for navigation.

- Left Click: Primary selection and interaction.
- Right Click: Accesses contextual menus.
- **Scroll Wheel:** Scrolls vertically through documents and web pages. The scroll wheel also functions as a middle click button.

The optical tracking technology provides smooth and accurate cursor control on various surfaces.




Image: A hand operating the Logitech M196 mouse on a wooden desk, demonstrating its comfortable design and ease of use for navigation.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement

The Logitech M196 mouse is designed for a 12-month battery life under typical usage conditions. When the mouse performance degrades or it stops responding, it's time to replace the battery.

- 1. Turn the mouse OFF using the switch on the bottom.
- 2. Locate the battery compartment cover on the bottom of the mouse.
- 3. Slide or lift the cover to open the compartment.
- 4. Remove the old AA battery.
- 5. Insert a new AA battery, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 6. Replace the battery compartment cover.
- 7. Turn the mouse ON.




Image: The Logitech M196 mouse positioned beside a laptop, highlighting its extended 12-month battery life for reliable use.

Cleaning

To maintain optimal performance and hygiene, clean your mouse periodically:

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or an alcohol-based cleaner.
- · Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Gently wipe the exterior of the mouse.
- For the optical sensor, use a dry cotton swab to carefully remove any dust or debris.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Mouse Not Connecting or Responding

- Check Power: Ensure the mouse is turned ON.
- Check Battery: Replace the AA battery if the mouse is unresponsive.
- **Re-pair Bluetooth:** Go to your device's Bluetooth settings, remove the 'Logitech M196' if listed, and then re-initiate the pairing process as described in the Setup section.
- Device Bluetooth: Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your computer or device.

• Interference: Move the mouse closer to your device and away from other wireless devices that might cause interference.

Erratic Cursor Movement

- Clean Sensor: Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse.
- **Surface:** Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface. Avoid glass or highly reflective surfaces.
- Battery Level: A low battery can sometimes cause erratic behavior. Replace the battery.
