- Toggle Wi-Fi: Turn Wi-Fi off and on again from Quick Settings.
- Restart Router: Power cycle your Wi-Fi router.
- Forget Network: Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi, tap on your network, and select "Forget". Then reconnect.
