SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always assemble according to the provided manual.
- Do not exceed the maximum load of 50 kg (110 lbs) to maintain stability.
- Be cautious of sharp edges and potential pinch points during assembly and use.
- Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use and periodically check for tightness.
- Keep small parts out of reach of children during assembly.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

- Tabletop sections (main and extension leaves)
- Pedestal Base
- Assembly Hardware (screws, bolts, washers, etc.)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly requires two people for optimal safety and ease. Follow the steps below and refer to the diagrams for guidance.

- 1. Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify all parts are present against the package contents list.
- 2. Assemble Pedestal Base:** Attach the base components as per the included hardware instructions. Ensure all connections are secure. The pedestal base features non-slip foot pads for stability.
- 3. Attach Tabletop Sections:** Carefully align and attach the main tabletop sections to the pedestal base. Some users have noted that aligning the rounded tabletop sections can be challenging; ensure they fit perfectly into the grooves before securing.
- 4. Insert Extension Mechanism:** The table features a sliding mechanism for extension leaves. Ensure this mechanism is properly installed and moves smoothly.
- 5. Final Tightening:** Once all parts are assembled, gently tighten all screws and bolts. Do not overtighten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (EXTENSION MECHANISM)

The HOMCOM Extendable Dining Table features a convenient mechanism to expand its surface area.

1. To Extend the Table:

- **Step 1: Pull the sides apart.** Gently pull the two halves of the tabletop outwards from the center. The sliding rails will extend.
- **Step 2: Place extension boards.** Retrieve the hidden extension leaves stored under the tabletop. Carefully place them into the gap created by pulling the sides apart.
- **Step 3: Push inward to combine.** Push the two halves of the tabletop back together until they meet the extension leaves and form a continuous surface. Ensure the leaves are securely seated.

2. To Retract the Table:

- Gently pull the two halves of the tabletop apart.
- Remove the extension leaves and store them in their designated compartment under the tabletop.
- Push the two halves of the tabletop back together until they meet, forming the round configuration.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your dining table.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the table surface with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that may damage the wood finish.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately with a dry cloth to prevent staining or water damage.
- **Protection:** Use placemats or coasters to protect the surface from hot items, scratches, and spills.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid placing the table in direct sunlight or near heat sources, as this can cause warping or fading. Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check and retighten all assembly hardware to ensure the table remains stable.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HOMCOM Extendable Dining Table, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Table Wobbles:**

- Ensure all assembly screws and bolts are securely tightened.
- Check that the table is placed on a level surface. Adjust the non-slip foot pads if necessary.

- **Extension Leaves Do Not Fit Smoothly:**

- Verify that the main tabletop halves are pulled apart sufficiently to allow the leaves to be inserted without force.
- Ensure the leaves are oriented correctly and aligned with the sliding mechanism.
- Check for any obstructions in the sliding rails.

- **Difficulty Pulling/Pushing Table Halves:**

- Ensure the sliding mechanism is clean and free of debris.
- Apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the sliding rails if movement is stiff.
