DEVAISE AWJG030ZXW 2-Drawer Lateral File Cabinet User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your DEVAISE AWJG030ZXW 2-Drawer Lateral File Cabinet. Designed for home office use, this cabinet features two spacious drawers, a built-in charging station, and a locking mechanism for secure storage. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep all small parts and packaging materials away from children.
- Ensure all connections for the charging station are secure and properly grounded. Do not overload the outlets.
- Do not stand or sit on the cabinet.
- Always open only one drawer at a time to prevent tipping, especially when drawers are heavily loaded. The cabinet is equipped with an interlock safety mechanism for this purpose.
- Place the cabinet on a flat, stable surface.
- Maximum weight capacity for the top surface is 44 lbs (20 kg). Each drawer holds up to 22 lbs (10 kg).

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

- Cabinet Panels (various sizes)
- Drawer Components (fronts, sides, backs, bottoms)
- Drawer Slides (fully extendable)

- Hardware Pack (screws, cam locks, dowels, handles, keys)
- Charging Station Unit (2 AC outlets, 2 USB ports)
- Hanging Rods for files
- Anti-Tip Buckle
- Instruction Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this product. It is recommended to have two people for assembly. Clear a spacious area and lay out all components before starting. Follow the numbered steps in the included instruction manual carefully. A Phillips head screwdriver and a hammer (optional, for dowels) are typically required.

1. **Prepare Components:** Unpack all parts and identify them using the parts list. Separate hardware into labeled groups to avoid confusion.
2. **Assemble Cabinet Frame:** Connect the side panels to the base and top panel using the provided cam locks and dowels. Ensure all connections are tight and secure.
3. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the cabinet-side drawer slides to the interior panels of the cabinet. Pay close attention to the orientation (left/right, front/back).
4. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct each drawer by attaching the sides, back, and bottom to the drawer front. Install the drawer-side slides onto the assembled drawers.
5. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully align the drawer slides and push the assembled drawers into the cabinet frame until they click into place. If drawers are difficult to insert, ensure slides are properly aligned and lubricated.
6. **Attach Handles:** Secure the vintage-style handles to the drawer fronts.
7. **Install Charging Station:** Place the charging station unit into the designated cutout on the top surface of the cabinet. Ensure the power cord is routed safely.
8. **Install Hanging Rods:** Insert the hanging rods into the designated slots within the drawers for file organization.
9. **Secure Lock Mechanism:** Ensure the lock mechanism on the lower drawer is correctly installed and functional. Test with the provided keys.
10. **Attach Anti-Tip Buckle:** For safety, attach the anti-tip buckle to the back of the cabinet and secure it to a wall stud using appropriate hardware (not always included, but recommended).



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Drawer Operation

The drawers are equipped with fully extendable, smooth slides for easy access. To open a drawer, gently pull the handle. To close, push the drawer firmly until it is fully seated. Remember the interlock safety

mechanism: only one drawer can be opened at a time to prevent the cabinet from tipping.

Locking Mechanism

The lower drawer is fitted with a high-quality lock. Inserting the key and turning it will lock both drawers simultaneously, securing your documents and personal items. Ensure the drawers are fully closed before attempting to lock them. Always remove the key after locking for security.

Charging Station

The integrated charging station includes 2 AC outlets (125V/12A) and 2 USB charging ports (5V/2A). Plug the cabinet's power cord into a standard wall outlet. You can then connect your electronic devices to the outlets or USB ports for power and charging. Avoid exceeding the maximum electrical load.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cabinet surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Drawer Slides:** Periodically check drawer slides for smooth operation. If they become stiff, a small amount of silicone lubricant can be applied.
- **Hardware:** Occasionally check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Charging Station:** Keep the charging ports free of dust and debris. Do not expose the charging station to liquids.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers are difficult to open/close.	Misaligned slides, overloaded drawer, lack of lubrication.	Check slide alignment. Reduce drawer load. Apply silicone lubricant to slides.
Drawers do not lock.	Drawers not fully closed, lock mechanism misaligned.	Ensure both drawers are completely closed. Check if the lock mechanism is properly installed and aligned.
Charging station not working.	Power cord not plugged in, wall outlet not active, overloaded circuit.	Verify the cabinet's power cord is securely plugged into a live wall outlet. Test the wall outlet with another device. Reduce the number of devices connected to the charging station.
Cabinet feels unstable.	Uneven floor, loose fasteners, anti-tip not installed.	Ensure the cabinet is on a level surface. Tighten all assembly fasteners. Install the anti-tip buckle to a wall stud.




Image: A diagram detailing the product dimensions (width, depth, height) and individual drawer dimensions, along with the maximum load capacities for the top surface and each drawer.
