INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Trevi PJ 3030 Digital Projection Clock. Please read this manual carefully before using the device to ensure proper function and longevity.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Trevi PJ 3030 is a versatile digital clock designed to display time, date, and temperature, with the added feature of time projection. It includes a backlit display for clear readability and a programmable alarm function.

Components

- Digital Display
- Projection Lens
- Control Buttons (AL, UP, DOWN, SET, MODE)
- Battery Compartment

SETUP

Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the device (refer to Figure 2).

- 2. Open the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Insert 3 AAA batteries (not included) according to the polarity markings (+/-) inside the compartment.
- 4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Note: The device requires 3 AAA batteries for operation. Batteries are not included with the product.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Setting Time and Date

- 1. Press the **MODE** button repeatedly until the time display starts flashing.
- 2. Use the UP or DOWN buttons to adjust the hour.
- 3. Press **SET** to confirm the hour and move to minute adjustment.
- 4. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the minutes.
- 5. Press **SET** to confirm the minutes and move to year adjustment.
- 6. Continue this process, using **UP/DOWN** to adjust and **SET** to confirm, for setting the year, month, and day.
- 7. Once all settings are complete, press**MODE** to exit the setting mode.

Setting the Alarm

- 1. Press the **AL** button to enter alarm setting mode. The alarm time will flash.
- 2. Use the UP or DOWN buttons to adjust the alarm hour.
- 3. Press **SET** to confirm the alarm hour and move to minute adjustment.
- 4. Use the **UP** or **DOWN** buttons to adjust the alarm minutes.
- 5. Press **SET** to confirm the alarm minutes.
- 6. Press **AL** again to activate or deactivate the alarm. An alarm icon will appear on the display when activated.

Using the Projection Feature

The Trevi PJ 3030 can project the time onto a ceiling or wall.

- 1. Locate the projection lens on the right side of the clock (refer to Figure 1).
- 2. Press the red button located on top of the projection lens to activate the projection.
- 3. Adjust the angle of the projection lens manually to direct the time display to your desired surface.
- 4. The projection will remain active for a short period and then turn off automatically to conserve battery power.

Changing Temperature Unit (°C / °F)

The clock displays temperature in Celsius (°C) or Fahrenheit (°F).

1. In normal time display mode, press the DOWN button to toggle between Celsius and Fahrenheit.

MAINTENANCE

- Clean the clock's surface with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- · Keep the device away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.

• If the clock will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------------------------|--|--|
| Display is blank or dim. | Low or depleted batteries. | Replace with new AAA batteries. Ensure correct polarity. |
| Projection is not visible or dim. | Projection feature not activated; insufficient ambient darkness; projection lens obstructed. | Press the red projection button. Ensure the room is dark enough. Clean the projection lens if necessary. |
| Alarm does not sound. | Alarm not activated; incorrect alarm time set. | Ensure the alarm icon is visible on the display. Re-check alarm time settings. |
| Incorrect time/date displayed. | Time/date not set correctly after battery change or initial setup. | Follow the "Setting Time and Date" instructions to reset. |
