INTRODUCTION

Equipped with Bluetooth 5.0 technology, it ensures a fast, stable connection with lower power consumption, offering total freedom of movement. With high-definition stereo sound, you can listen to your music, podcasts, and calls with clarity and prominent bass.

In addition to the wireless connection, the Model 951 features an auxiliary input (P2), an SD card reader, and an integrated FM radio, offering various options to enjoy your sound wherever you are, even without relying on other devices. Its design is modern and resistant, with adjustable stainless steel rods that provide comfort and durability. The headphone comes with a practical transport bag for protection and mobility, as well as a USB charging cable.

SETUP

Initial Charging

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your BT951 Headphone. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the headphone's charging port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The charging indicator light will typically show red while charging and turn off or change color when fully charged.

Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the indicator light flashes.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3-5 seconds until the indicator light turns off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphone is powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light flashes blue and red alternately, indicating it is in pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "BT951" or "Model 951" from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will typically flash blue slowly or remain solid blue.

Using Auxiliary Input (P2)

To use the headphone with a wired connection, simply connect a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) from your audio source to the headphone's auxiliary (P2) input port. The headphone will automatically switch to auxiliary mode.

Using SD Card

Insert a microSD card (not included) with your favorite music files into the designated SD card slot on the headphone. The headphone will automatically detect the card and begin playing music. Use the control buttons on the headphone to navigate tracks and adjust volume.

FM Radio

To activate the FM radio function, press the Mode button until you hear the FM radio. Use the volume buttons to scan for stations or adjust the frequency. For better reception, ensure you are in an open area.

Charging the Headphone

When the battery is low, the headphone may emit an audible warning or the indicator light may change. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the headphone's charging port and a USB power source. A full charge typically takes a few hours. Avoid using the headphone while it is charging for optimal battery life.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphone. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphone in the provided transport bag to protect it from dust and scratches.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid exposing the headphone to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge it regularly, even if not used for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|------------------------------------|---|--|
| Headphone does not power on. | Low battery. | Charge the headphone fully. |
| No sound from headphone. | Volume too low; incorrect mode; not connected. | Increase volume on headphone and device. Ensure correct mode (Bluetooth, Aux, SD, FM). Reconnect Bluetooth or check Aux cable. |
| Cannot pair with Bluetooth device. | Headphone not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far. | Ensure headphone is in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move headphone closer to device. |
| Poor sound quality / Static. | Interference; low battery; source quality. | Move away from other electronic devices. Charge headphone. Try a different audio source. |
