1. OVERVIEW

The Colourbing A6 Retro Handheld Game Console offers a nostalgic gaming experience with over 1000 classic titles. It features a 3.2-inch screen, a mini TV-style design, and supports two-player mode with included wired controllers. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your console.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Not suitable for children under 14 years old.
- The joystick is highly sensitive and requires gentle handling to ensure precise control during gameplay.
- Avoid inserting controllers during gameplay. Insert controllers before turning on the console or press RESET to activate them.
- Once controllers are inserted, console buttons will be disabled. Use the controllers for all operations.
- Insert P1 controller first, then P2. Only P1 can select games.
- Before connecting to TV with the included AV cable, ensure your TV is set to AV mode.

- Charging Cable (1 unit)
- User Manual (1 unit)
- Game Controllers (2 units)
- TV AV Cable (1 unit)

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Console

The A6 console features a high-density rechargeable battery. To charge, simply plug the included USB-C cable into the console's charging port and connect it to a compatible power source (DC port = 5V2A). A full charge typically takes about one hour.

4.2 Connecting Controllers

For two-player mode, connect the wired controllers to the console. It is crucial to insert the controllers before turning on the console or pressing the RESET button to ensure they are properly activated. Insert the P1 controller into its designated port first, followed by the P2 controller. Note that only the P1 controller can select games.

4.3 Connecting to a Television

To enjoy games on a larger screen, use the provided AV cable. Before connecting, ensure your television is set to AV input mode. Plug the yellow, white, and red connectors into their corresponding ports on your TV, and the other end into the console's AV interface.

The A6 Retro Handheld Game Console comes pre-loaded with 185 legendary titles and includes a 912-game TF card, offering a total of over 1000 classic games. The console supports an upgraded online module for multiplayer challenges and features a 2-player mode with the included wired controllers.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid completely draining the battery frequently. Recharge the console using the provided USB-C cable when the battery indicator is low. Store the console in a cool, dry place when not in use.

7.2 General Cleaning

Wipe the console and controllers with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the surface or internal components.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Console Freezes:** If the console freezes on a black screen or during gameplay, press the RESET button located next to the power button to restart the device. This action does not delete saved games.
- **Controllers Not Responding:** Ensure both controllers are securely inserted into their respective ports before powering on the console. If they were inserted during gameplay, press the RESET button to activate them. Remember, console buttons are disabled when external controllers are connected.
- **No Display on TV:** Verify that your television's input source is set to AV mode before connecting the console with the AV cable. Check all cable connections for security.
- **Game Selection Issues:** In 2-player mode, ensure the P1 controller is inserted first, as only the P1 controller can select games.
