1. INTRODUCTION

Components:

The quick changer consists of a main body with a lever mechanism and a securing pin for attachment to the sewing machine's presser foot bar.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly install the quick changer onto your sewing machine.

1. **Prepare Your Machine:** Ensure your sewing machine is turned off and unplugged for safety. Raise the presser foot lever to its highest position.
2. **Remove Existing Presser Foot (if any):** Loosen the screw that holds the current presser foot in place and carefully remove it.
3. **Attach the Quick Changer:** Align the top slot of the quick changer with the presser foot bar of your sewing machine. Slide it onto the bar and secure it by tightening the screw on the quick changer. Ensure it is firmly attached and does not wobble.
4. **Test Stability:** Gently lower and raise the presser foot lever to confirm the quick changer moves smoothly and is securely mounted.




Figure 4.3: Visual guide for installing the quick changer onto the sewing machine.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the quick changer is installed, follow these steps to efficiently change your presser feet:

1. **Raise the Presser Foot:** Use your machine's presser foot lever to lift the presser foot to its highest position.
2. **Engage the Quick Changer Lever:** Locate the lever on the quick changer. Push this lever to release the currently attached presser foot. The foot should drop free.
3. **Attach a New Presser Foot:** Position the new presser foot directly under the quick changer's attachment point. Ensure the pin on the presser foot aligns with the slot on the quick changer.
4. **Secure the New Foot:** Gently lower the presser foot lever. The quick changer will automatically snap onto the pin of the new presser foot, securing it in place. You should hear a click.
5. **Verify Attachment:** Before sewing, gently tug on the presser foot to ensure it is firmly attached and does not move independently.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Difficulty Releasing Presser Foot:**

- Ensure the presser foot is raised to its highest position before engaging the quick changer lever.
- Apply firm, but not excessive, pressure to the quick changer lever.

- **Excessive Vibration During Sewing:**

- Confirm that both the quick changer and the presser foot are securely attached and not loose.
- Check if the presser foot itself is compatible and properly seated.
