INTRODUCTION

The Beats Solo 4 are wireless Bluetooth on-ear headphones designed for a premium audio experience. They offer compatibility with both Apple and Android devices, extended battery life, and advanced audio features like Personalized Spatial Audio. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Beats Solo 4 headphones.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your Beats Solo 4 headphones, verify that all the following components are included:

- Beats Solo 4 headphones
- Protective Case
- USB-C to USB-C cable for charging and audio (USB-C power adapter sold separately)
- 3.5 mm analog audio cable
- Quick Start Guide and Warranty Card

SETUP

1. Charging Your Headphones

Before initial use, ensure your Beats Solo 4 headphones are fully charged. Connect the provided USB-C to USB-C cable to the charging port on the headphones and to a compatible USB-C power adapter (sold separately) or a USB-C port on a computer.

- A 10-minute charge provides up to 5 hours of playback (Fast Fuel feature).
- A full charge provides up to 50 hours of battery life.

Up to 50 Hours of Battery Life

Plus endless listening via 3.5 mm audio cable, which requires zero battery power.



Testing conducted by Apple in March 2024 using preproduction Beats Solo 4 and software paired with iPhone 15 Pro units and pre-release software. The playlist consisted of 358 unique audio tracks purchased from the iTunes Store (256-Kbps AAC encoding). Volume was set to 50%. Testing consisted of full Beats Solo 4 battery discharge while playing audio until Beats Solo 4 stopped playback. Battery life depends on device settings, environment, usage, and many other factors.

2. Pairing with Your Device (Bluetooth)

The Beats Solo 4 headphones offer dual compatibility for one-touch pairing with both iOS and Android devices.

For iOS Devices (Apple):

1. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your iOS device.
2. Power on your Beats Solo 4 headphones.
3. Hold your Beats Solo 4 near your unlocked iOS device.
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to connect. This will automatically set up your headphones with all devices signed into your iCloud account.

For Android Devices:

1. Download the Beats app from the Google Play Store (optional, but recommended for full features).
2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your Android device.

3. Power on your Beats Solo 4 headphones.
4. Open the Beats app or go to your device's Bluetooth settings.
5. Select "Beats Solo 4" from the list of available devices to pair.

Apple and Android Compatibility

Enjoy seamless one-touch pairing, automatic account setup, and Find My or Find My Device.



Requires an iCloud account and a compatible Apple device running the latest operating system software or a compatible Android device running the latest operating system software with Google Play Services enabled.

OPERATING YOUR HEADPHONES

Controls

The Beats Solo 4 headphones feature intuitive on-ear controls for managing audio playback, calls, and voice assistant interaction.

- **Volume Control:** Use the dedicated volume buttons on the ear cup.
- **Playback Control:** Press the 'b' button for play/pause, double-press for next track, triple-press for previous track.
- **Call Management:** Press the 'b' button to answer/end calls.

- **Voice Assistant:** Press and hold the 'b' button to activate Siri or your device's voice assistant.

Audio Features

Personalized Spatial Audio

Experience immersive sound with dynamic head tracking. This feature creates a theater-like experience, making it sound as if audio is coming from all around you. Compatible hardware and software are required. For Apple devices, an iPhone with TrueDepth camera is needed to create a personal profile for Spatial Audio.

Personalized Spatial Audio

Like being surrounded by 64 speakers at once.



Compatible hardware and software required. Works with compatible content in supported apps. Not all content available in Dolby Atmos. iPhone with TrueDepth camera required to create a personal profile for Spatial Audio, which will sync across Apple devices running the latest operating system software, including iOS, iPadOS, macOS, and tvOS.

Lossless Audio

The Beats Solo 4 supports lossless audio playback via the included USB-C or 3.5 mm audio cables. This allows for high-fidelity audio transmission without compression, providing a richer listening experience. Compatible lossless content from supported apps/services is required.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the lifespan of your Beats Solo 4 headphones.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or sprays.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in the provided protective case to prevent scratches and damage. The foldable design makes them compact for storage.
- **Moisture:** The Beats Solo 4 are not water resistant. Avoid exposure to liquids, moisture, or extreme humidity.
- **Temperature:** Do not expose the headphones to extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Beats Solo 4 headphones, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Headphones not powering on	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to a power source using the USB-C cable.

Problem	Possible Solution
Cannot pair with device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. ○ Make sure headphones are in pairing mode (check quick start guide for specific button press). ○ Move headphones closer to the device. ○ Forget the device in your phone's Bluetooth settings and try pairing again. ○ Restart both the headphones and your device.
No sound or low volume	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Increase volume on both headphones and connected device. ○ Ensure headphones are properly connected via Bluetooth or 3.5mm cable. ○ Try playing audio from a different source or application.
Poor call quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ensure microphone is not obstructed. ○ Move to an area with less wireless interference. ○ Check network signal on your phone.
Headphones not responding	Perform a factory reset (refer to the Quick Start Guide for specific instructions on how to reset your Beats Solo 4).


