1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before beginning assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Anti-Tip Hardware:** This cabinet includes anti-tip hardware. It is crucial to install this hardware to secure the cabinet to a wall, especially in households with children or pets, to prevent tipping and potential injury.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 300 pounds for the top surface. Distribute weight evenly across shelves and drawers.
- **Assembly:** Assembly should be performed by at least two adults. Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use.
- **Placement:** Place the cabinet on a flat, level surface. Avoid placing it in areas with high humidity or direct sunlight to prevent damage to the engineered wood.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts and hardware are present. Refer to the visual manual included in your package for a detailed list of components. The product features pre-coded, scratch-proof packaging to protect components during transit.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The ONBRILL BSB-142-BR-120 sideboard buffet cabinet is designed for straightforward assembly with a visual manual provided. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

Key Assembly Steps:

- 1. Identify Components:** Lay out all parts and hardware. Match them with the labels in the visual manual.
- 2. Assemble Frame:** Follow the numbered steps in the manual to construct the main frame of the cabinet using the provided fasteners.
- 3. Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the drawer slides to the cabinet frame and the drawer boxes as instructed.

4. **Construct Drawers:** Assemble the two drawers, ensuring the bottom panels are correctly inserted and secured.
5. **Attach Doors:** Secure the three doors using the provided hinges. Adjust hinges as needed for proper alignment.
6. **Insert Adjustable Shelves:** Place the adjustable shelves into the desired positions within the cabinet compartments.
7. **Install Anti-Tip Kit:** Securely attach the anti-tip hardware to the back of the cabinet and to a wall stud using appropriate tools.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your ONBRILL sideboard is designed for versatile storage and ease of use.

Drawers:

- The two top drawers feature upgraded rails for smooth gliding. Pull gently to open and push firmly to close.
- Avoid overloading drawers to ensure smooth operation and prevent damage to the slides.

Doors and Adjustable Shelves:

- The three doors are equipped with soft-close hinges, preventing slamming and ensuring quiet operation.
- The interior features adjustable shelves. To adjust, remove the shelf, reposition the shelf pins to the desired height, and reinsert the shelf.
- Ensure items stored on shelves do not obstruct the closing of the doors.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your ONBRILL sideboard.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the engineered wood finish.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or water damage.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading or discoloration. Position the cabinet away from direct sun or use window coverings.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Wobbly Cabinet:** Ensure the cabinet is on a level surface. Check that all assembly screws are tightened. Adjust the anti-tip hardware if it feels loose.

- **Doors Not Aligning:** The hinges on the doors are adjustable. Refer to the visual manual for instructions on how to adjust the hinges to align the doors properly.
- **Drawers Sticking:** Check that the drawer slides are clean and free of debris. Ensure the drawer boxes are assembled correctly and not overloaded.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing or damaged upon arrival, contact customer support for prompt hardware replacement.
