4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Device

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port at the bottom of the main grooming unit.
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port.
- 3. The LED display will indicate the charging status. Ensure the device is fully charged before first use for optimal performance.

4.2 Attaching and Detaching Blades

To change the grooming head:

- 1. Ensure the device is turned off.
- 2. To remove a blade, gently push the blade head upwards or to the side (depending on the specific attachment design) until it detaches from the main unit.
- 3. To attach a new blade, align the new head with the main unit and push it down or into place until it clicks securely.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 General Grooming Tips

- Before grooming, ensure your pet's fur is clean, dry, and free of tangles. Brush thoroughly to remove loose hair.
- Start with a low speed setting to acclimate your pet to the sound and sensation.
- Always groom in the direction of hair growth to prevent irritation.
- Take breaks as needed to keep your pet comfortable and calm.

5.2 Using the Trimmer Attachments

- 1. Select the appropriate blade (curved for body, detailing for face/paws) and comb guide for the desired hair length.
- 2. Press the power button to turn on the device. Use the up/down buttons to adjust the speed as needed.
- 3. Gently glide the trimmer over your pet's fur, maintaining even pressure.

5.3 Using the Nail Grinder Attachment

- 1. Attach the nail grinder head to the main unit.
- 2. Gently hold your pet's paw and isolate one nail.
- 3. Turn on the grinder and lightly touch the spinning head to the tip of the nail. Grind for a few seconds, then check progress.
- 4. Avoid grinding too much at once to prevent overheating the nail or reaching the quick.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Blades

- 1. After each use, turn off the device and detach the blade.
- 2. Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any trapped hair from the blade and the main unit.
- 3. Since the device is waterproof, you can rinse the blade under running water. Ensure it is completely dry before reattaching or storing.

6.2 Oiling the Blades

Regular oiling helps maintain blade sharpness and extends the life of your trimmer.

- After cleaning and drying the blade, apply 1-2 drops of the provided lubricating oil to the teeth of the blade.
- 2. Turn on the trimmer for a few seconds to distribute the oil evenly.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Device not turning on: Ensure the device is fully charged. If the battery is low, connect it to the charger.
- Blades pulling hair: This often indicates dull blades or insufficient lubrication. Clean the blades

thoroughly and apply lubricating oil. If the issue persists, consider replacing the blade.

• **Reduced performance:** Check for tangled hair in the blade mechanism. Clean and oil the blades. Ensure the battery is adequately charged.
