INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Rockville SR3 Low Profile Speaker Riser Stands. These stands are designed to optimize the acoustic performance of your desktop speakers or studio monitors by providing a stable, elevated, and angled platform. The 16-degree upward tilt helps direct sound towards your listening position, while the de-coupling foam pads and anti-slip feet minimize unwanted vibrations, ensuring a clearer and more accurate audio experience. Please read this manual carefully for proper setup and usage.

FEATURES

- **Optimized Sound Projection:** 16-degree upward tilt enhances audio clarity and dispersion, ideal for desktop speakers or studio monitors with 4" woofers or smaller.
- **Stable Vibration Control:** Anti-slip rubber feet and speaker de-coupling pads minimize vibrations, delivering pristine sound quality for an immersive listening experience.
- **Durable Steel Construction:** Built from 3mm thick steel, each stand supports up to 25 pounds, ensuring stability for speakers up to 7" deep and 6" wide.
- **Low-profile Aesthetic:** Sleek, compact design (4" W x 5.25" D x 1.75" H) creates a floating effect, enhancing the look of your audio setup.
- **Broad Compatibility:** Fits a wide range of small speakers, perfect for home studios, offices, or gaming setups, ensuring versatile audio enhancement.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack the Stands:** Carefully remove the Rockville SR3 speaker stands and de-coupling foam pads from their packaging.

2. **Attach De-coupling Foam Pads:** Place one de-coupling foam pad onto the top surface of each SR3 stand. Ensure the pad is centered and sits securely. These pads help isolate your speakers from the stand, reducing unwanted vibrations.

3. **Position the Stands:** Place the SR3 stands on your desktop or studio surface where you intend to position

your speakers. Ensure the surface is flat and stable. The stands are designed to tilt your speakers upwards by 16 degrees.

4. **Place Speakers on Stands:** Carefully place your desktop speakers or studio monitors onto the de-coupling foam pads on the SR3 stands. Ensure the speakers are centered and stable on the pads. The stands are suitable for speakers up to 7 inches deep and 6 inches wide, and weighing up to 25 pounds.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (PLACEMENT & USAGE)

The Rockville SR3 stands are designed to improve your listening experience by correctly positioning your speakers.

- **Optimal Listening Angle:** The 16-degree upward tilt ensures that the sound from your speakers is directed towards your ears, especially when speakers are placed on a desk below ear level. This improves stereo imaging and overall sound clarity.
- **Vibration Isolation:** The de-coupling foam pads and anti-slip rubber feet work together to minimize vibrations transferred from the speakers to your desk surface. This reduces unwanted resonance and coloration, resulting in a cleaner, more accurate sound reproduction.
- **Stable Support:** Ensure your speakers are centered on the stands to maintain stability. Avoid placing speakers that exceed the recommended dimensions (7" deep, 6" wide) or weight (25 lbs) to prevent tipping.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the stands with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the stands for any signs of damage or wear. Ensure the anti-slip feet are intact and the de-coupling foam pads are not degraded.
- **Storage:** If storing the stands, keep them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with speaker stands are related to placement or compatibility.

- **Speakers feel unstable:**
 - Ensure the stands are on a flat, level surface.
 - Verify that your speakers are centered on the de-coupling foam pads.
 - Check that your speakers do not exceed the maximum recommended dimensions (7" deep, 6" wide) or weight (25 lbs).
- **Vibrations still present:**
 - Confirm the de-coupling foam pads are correctly placed between the speaker and the stand.
 - Ensure the anti-slip rubber feet on the bottom of the stands are intact and making full contact with the surface.
 - Check if the desk or surface itself is vibrating; consider adding additional isolation under the stands if necessary.
- **Sound not improving:**
 - Ensure the stands are oriented correctly so the speakers are tilting upwards towards your listening position.
 - Adjust your listening position to be directly in line with the speaker's tweeters for optimal high-frequency response.
 - Consider room acoustics; speaker stands address mechanical coupling but cannot fully compensate for poor room treatment.
